Your request for records under the Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act has been processed. This letter constitutes a reply from the Executive Office for United States Attorneys, the official recordkeeper for all records located in this office and the various United States Attorneys' offices. To provide the greatest degree of access authorized by the Freedom of Information Act and the Privacy Act, we have considered your request in light of the provisions of both statutes.

- Pages originated with another government component. These records were found in the U.S. Attorney's Office files and may or may not be responsive to your request. These records will be sent to the Drug Enforcement Administration. By making a FOIA request, you agreed to pay search and/or copying costs. A \$154.00 review fee is being assessed for these records. We received a check from you in the amount of \$1000. We are sending the check back to you and asking that you send a check in the amount of \$154.00. The Drug Enforcement Administration will respond directly to you regarding your request. Please send a check or money order for \$154.00 payable to the Treasury of the United States. Payment should be mailed to the Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act Staff, 600 E Street, N.W., Room 7300, Washington, D.C. 20530. If payment is not received, any future requests for records will be rejected until payment is received.
- [] This office is withholding exempt records which include grand jury materials, court sealed documents, and patient medical records.
- [] There are public records which may be obtained from the clerk of the court or this office, upon specific request. If you wish to obtain a copy of these records, you must submit a new request. These records will be provided to you subject to copying fees.

You may appeal this determination by writing within 60 days from the date of this letter to the Office of Information and Privacy, United States Department of Justice, Flag Building, Suite 570, Washington, D.C. 20530

This is the final action this office will take concerning your request.
