DECLARATION OF ALEXANDRA NOBREGAS

1. I am over the age of eighteen and am competent and fully qualified to make this declaration.
2. This declaration is based on my personal knowledge and is made in support of the Plaintiffs' Emergency Complaint for Declaratory Relief and Injunctive Relief with Incorporated Memorandum of Law.
3. I have one minor child who are enrolled in the Indian River County Schools.
4. I affirm that all allegations contained in the Verified Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief are true and correct.
5. Affiant believes that compelled facemask wear is not her child's best emotional, physical and psychological interest. Affiant values her children's health and believes that wearing masks represents a threat to her minor children's physical health and emotional wellbeing. Affiant does not want her children to be compelled to wear mask in school because she feels that wearing a mask provide will not provide proper protection. 

1. I am over the age of eighteen and am competent and fully qualified to make this declaration.
2. This declaration is based on my personal knowledge and is made in support of the Plaintiffs' Emergency Complaint for Declaratory Relief and Injunctive Relief with Incorporated Memorandum of Law.
3. I have one minor child who is enrolled in the Indian River County Schools.
4. I affirm that all allegations contained in the Verified Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief are true and correct.
5. Affiant's daughter is constantly harassed when she is socially distanced to put her mask on. Affiant's daughter grades have suffered as direct result to the actions of school official enforcing face mask rules that have no relationship to the policy. Affiant's child is not receiving and adequate education due to not having a teacher or any instruction whatsoever. The policy is causing affiant's daughter to miss activities because of problems with the school related to being compelled to quarantine when she is not COVID-19 positive due to the actions of the School Board. The minor child has been compelled to miss tumbling classes (gymnastics); miss 4-H Club; miss her first homecoming game and homecoming week as a freshman and football games and school activities.
