Recently the North Carolina Department of Labor Occupational Safety and Health Division received a complaint alleging health and/or safety hazards related to **coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)**, **which is the illness caused by coronavirus**, at your establishment at 510 N Oak Forest Rd, Goldsboro, NC 27530. The specific nature of the complaint is described in detail on the attached page.

We have not determined whether the hazards, as alleged, exist at your workplace; and we are not conducting an inspection, at this time. However, since allegations of violations have been made, you should investigate the alleged conditions and make any necessary corrections or modifications. Within 7 working days of your receipt of this letter, please advise us, in writing, by certified mail, or submitting electronically of your finds and the action you have taken. Your response should be detailed stating specifically what action you have taken to correct each hazard. You should enclose any supporting documentation, such as monitoring results, equipment purchases, photographs etc.

The complainant has been advised of this preliminary response to the complaint and furnished a copy of this letter. An un-redacted employer response will be forwarded to the complainant. Please focus on providing documentation on the alleged conditions and do not include any comments or information about the person(s) that you believe filed the complaint. You should be aware that North Carolina General Statute 95-241 provides that "no person shall discriminate or take any retaliatory action against an employee because the employee in good faith does or threatens to file a claim or complaint, initiate any inquiry, investigation, proceeding or other action, or testify or provide information to any person with

This letter is not a citation nor is it a notification of proposed penalty, which according to the Occupational Safety and Health Act, may be issued only after an inspection or investigation of the workplace. Dear Neesia Hill:

In response to your letter of May 8, 2020 reference the above Complaint Number, we first bring your attention to the fact that Butterball, LLC does not have a location at 510 N. Oak Forest Road, Goldsboro, NC. However, Butterball, LLC does have an office and warehouse location at 501 N. Oak Forest Road, Goldsboro, NC. We will respond on the assumption that the address was transposed.

We confirm to you that Butterball, LLC is committed to the health and safety of its employees at all times and most acutely during this current COVID-19 pandemic.

At 501 N. Oak Forest Road, Butterball, LLC maintains accounting office functions, as well as certain human resources and accounting functions which support the business and operations of live turkey production and processing. In the review of the complaint, it specifically outlines two separate hazard descriptions which are outlined below.

Hazard Description #1:

"The plant is continuing to operate after confirmed COVIC-19 cases and the employer did not inform other employees until 4 days later".

Response to #1:

At the time of this reply, there have been <u>no</u> cases of COVID-19 reported from Butterball employee(s) working at the 501 N. Oak Forest Road, Goldsboro location.



Likewise, the company has not received any notification from the County Health Department notifying of any such positive testing result from an employee working at that location. It is however important to understand that Butterball, LLC has a robust and well documented COVID-19 employee communication and notification protocol which contains very detailed guidelines should such be required

Hazard Description #2:

"The employer is not addressing employees which have been exposed".

Response to #2:

As outlined in hazard description #1, there have been <u>no</u> cases of COVID-19 reported from Butterball employee(s) working at the 501 N. Oak Forest Road, Goldsboro location. Likewise, the company has not received any notification from the County Health Department notifying of any such positive testing result from an employee working at that location. As such, in the absence of any positive COVID-19 testing result(s) at this location, the need to communicate to employees' reference exposure does not exist. It is however important to understand that Butterball, LLC has a robust and well documented COVID-19 employee communication strategy should such be required.

Further, as a food manufacturing company, the business is deemed an essential business and is remaining in operation to provide essential services to the State. Further, on April 28, 2020, President Trump issued an Executive Order deeming beef, pork and poultry plants as critical under the Defense Production Act. Again, the functions being performed at the 501 N. Oak Forest Road office supports an essential and critical business.

In this regard, we actively monitor and seek to implement the guidance being issued by the CDC and OSHA as well as other regulatory bodies to promote the safety and health of our employees.

As recognized in current guidance, our mitigation efforts at the 501 N. Oak Forest Road, Goldsboro office location consists of the following:

Social distancing whereas only essential staff are working at that facility and others (approx. 90%) are telecommuting. Employees are working in hard wall confined offices and in cubicle spaces with considerable space cushioning far in excess of the 6'ft separation as recommended by CDC and OSHA;



- A supply of surgical masks are provided to our employees as part of the daily PPE and required use in the facility. Sanitizing hand-washing stations are located at all employee entrance locations, bathrooms and scattered throughout the facility;
- Employees are actively encouraged to stay at home should they experience any of the signs and symptoms being associated with COVID-19 as per CDC/OSHA guidance.

If there are any other steps that you think we should consider, we would value your suggestions.



This letter is in response to your complaint concerning employee safety and/or health hazard(s) related to coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) at Butterball, LLC.

Your complaint has been reviewed and evaluated by a representative from the Compliance Bureau of the Occupational Safety & Health (OSH) Division. While your concern is understandable, it was determined the alleged hazard is not covered by an OSHA standard, nor would it meet the criteria for a General Duty Clause citation under NCGS 95-129(I) of the OSH Act of North Carolina. We have sent a letter to the employer requesting they investigate your allegation and take any action necessary to ensure their COVID-19 policies and procedures are in accordance with the most current guidelines from Federal or State agencies, such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), OSHA, and the NC Governor's Office. We have included a copy of that letter with this correspondence.

The OSH Act of North Carolina provides that no person shall discharge or discriminate against any employee because that employee has filed a complaint.

The form has been completed in every respect. However, if you are aware of new or additional information that you think might be important, please add it to a separate sheet of paper and submit it with the form. It is important that you do not write on the form, except where required in paragraph one. Please mail the signed "Complaint" form in the return addressed envelope provided for your use.

The North Carolina Occupational Safety and Health Act provides that the confidentiality of the complainant be maintained. In response to your letter of April 22, 2020 reference the above Complaint Number, we confirm to you that Butterball, LLC is committed to the health and safety of its employees at all times and most acutely during this current COVID-19 pandemic. The complaint was as follows:

"Employees' health could be seriously harmed due to exposure to CoVID-19 which, now they have 17 cases in the workforce, appears to be getting transmitted at workplace. There is a concern that the virus is spreading due to employees working very close to each other"

As you may know, the operations of Butterball, LLC at the Mt. Olive facility include the processing of turkeys and production of food products. As a food manufacturing facility, the business is deemed an essential business and is remaining in operation to provide essential services to the State.

As previously advised, we actively monitor and meet or exceed the guidance issued by the CDC and OSHA as well as other regulatory bodies to promote the safety and health of our employees. Just this week:

- 1. A delivery of 16,000 surgical masks were received and as of April 20, 2020, these masks are being provided to our employees as part of the daily PPE and required in the facility.
- 2. We anticipate delivery of 4000 face shields and erection of separation barriers in the near future as best suited for each work area.

Continued actions to address concern:

- 1. We continue to conduct 24-hour daily temperature screening of all associates as they enter our operations.
- 2. We have hired additional cleaning crews to cover all bathroom and common areas. This crew continues to clean all touch surfaces 24 hours a day.

- 3. We have reduced touch surfaces in our operations by putting common doors on sensors which open when the associate enters the area.
- 4. We have rented a large tent (40' X 60') to expand the cafeteria eating areas to increase social distancing. We monitor the area frequently to encourage social distancing.
- 5. We are also in frequent, if not daily contact with the various county health departments.

If there are any other steps that you think that we should consider, we would value your suggestions.





Recently the North Carolina Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Division received a complaint alleging health and/or safety hazards related to **coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)**, which is the illness caused by coronavirus, at your establishment at 1628 Garner Chapel Rd, Mount Olive, NC 28365. The specific nature of the complaint is described in detail below:

1. There have been cases of COVID-19 in the plant. One employee was taken out due to being sick. The employer has known for over a week. The employer is exposing employees to the virus and still wanting them to come to work.

We have evaluated the alleged hazard and determined it is not covered by an OSHA standard, nor would it likely meet the criteria for a General Duty Clause citation under the OSH Act of North Carolina due to the constantly changing guidance during the COVID-19 pandemic. However, since a complaint has been received, we are asking you to investigate the allegations and ensure your COVID-19 policies and procedures are consistent with the current guidelines published by OSHA, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the NC Governor's Office, and other agencies as applicable to your industry and establishment. been furnished a copy of this letter. You should be aware that North Carolina General Statute '95-241 provides that "no person shall discriminate or take any retaliatory action against an employee because the employee in good faith does or threatens to file a claim or complaint, initiate any inquiry, investigation, inspection, proceeding or other action, or testify or provide information to any person with respect to... the Occupational Safety and Health Act of North Carolina."

As you may know, the operations of Butterball, LLC at the Mt. Olive facility include the processing of turkeys and production of food products. As a food manufacturing facility, the business is deemed an essential business and is remaining in operation to provide essential services to the State.

We are actively monitoring the guidance issued by the CDC and OSHA as well as other regulatory bodies to promote the safety and health of our employees. For example, Butterball has taken the following steps that meet or exceed this guidance: working with local health departments, isolating employees, social distancing in welfare areas, allowing employees to wear masks subject to food safety coverings and the institution of daily temperature screening.
