Dear Andrew Diamond, Leia Vetter and One Medical Leadership Team,

Recently the San Francisco Department of Public Health ("DPH") requested information from One Medical related to its administration of doses of COVID-19 vaccines that DPH has allocated to One Medical under protocols adopted by the State of California. Thank you for the information you provided dated February 17, 2021. Your response included the information we were seeking.

This letter serves two purposes. First, we want to ensure that you continue to administer all second doses of the COVID-19 vaccines to patients who are awaiting a second dose as outlined in your February 17, 2021 letter. Section 5) of your response lists a total of 3,170 second doses that you are reserving (830 doses of the Moderna vaccine and 2,340 doses of the Pfizer vaccine) and states that all second doses have appointments associated with them. Please continue to provide these doses on the appropriate schedule and keep us updated on a weekly basis regarding your progress on completing the vaccination schedule for these groups.

Second, this letter directs you to prepare for return to DPH the remaining 270 vials of Pfizer vaccine vials you list as "saved for other uses." DPH is redirecting those doses to be provided to other priority populations in the City. We will have Eleanor Morse contact you immediately to arrange for pick-up of those 270 vials (1600 vaccine doses) on Monday, February 22, 2021. You are directed not to use those doses for any other purpose. Although your response lists 984 of these doses for walk-ins from DPH and the remaining 636 doses for an "Oracle Park mass vaccination launch," neither of those uses is authorized by DPH at this time.

We appreciate your on-going work on the overall response to this pandemic, and we will be in touch if we are ready to allocate additional doses to One Medical for administration at a future date.
