Here is the clean Cabinet paper and Appendix 1 as word, and PDF prepared for lodging (fingers crossed). I've also put in a compare version with what we provided on the 30th. I will provide the rest of the appendices as PDFs in a separate email to you and Sophia in case she should liaise with Min O'Connor's office.

A few quick explanations for why some of John's changes were edited:

- 1. Footnote 1 was slightly inaccurate. Below I have text from the policy lead to explain why it has been changed to what it is now.
- 2. Hydropower exceptions I have removed references to catchments when referring to these schemes because some schemes have infrastructure in multiple catchments (for example, the Tongariro scheme has infrastructure in other river catchments).
- 3. The noting rec 8 that lists the instruments on which we're seeking agreement in the paper is now clearer, so I didn't modify the recs as much as he wished for cross-referencing.
- 4. The big change in SOP-related recs compared to his version is that between the 30th and today we had legal review of SOP recs so there were significant changes.
- 5. DRP went into the body as requested by John, and I've removed appendices 9-13 (the letters from advisory groups) as you requested); as an aside, I flagged to Annabelle your comment on the Minister likely needing material soon to

Otherwise, I believe we've talked over adjustments made, but if there is something unexpected, please call. I'll be watching early tomorrow in case we need something then.

In relation to footnote 1, the lead said:

"The Minister wanted notification to be a set date of 31 Dec 2024 with no extensions to this notification date, as per the SOP (see clause 47 of the paper below).

Clause 13, new section 80A (4) in the Bill is where notification is required by a certain date – this is what the SOP will change. As per the Ministers decision, the extensions we enabled in the Bill do not apply to the notification date - they only apply to the post notification hearing processes See new clause 46A in the RT version of the Bill.

Minor point - only freshwater **rules** have legal effect and really only can impact a new consent application. The whole plan can still be changed through the hearing/appeals process though, and existing consent reviews can't occur until this stage is complete."







On the advice of our legal team and in line with comments on RM bill interactions, I have added a noting rec (no. 28) for stock exclusion since the RM Bill has changes to that which allow stock exclusion regs to include setbacks:

3. **Note** that the select committee have recommended that s. 360(1)(hn) of the RMA be amended to make it clear that regulations can exclude stock from the margins of a waterbody as well as the waterbody itself.

The Table 2 stock ex footnote (number 19) now reads: Costs associated with stock exclusion can be broken down into capital expenditure (fencing expenses) and opportunity cost of land that cannot be grazed due to new setbacks from streams and rivers. The capital expenditure component represents \$44 million per annum (\$788 million PV) as amortised over 25 years using a 3% real interest rate, and the opportunity cost component represents \$17 million per annum (\$304 million PV).

Also, thave corrected the typos you noted, and have updated recommendation numbers in the paper and the appendix according to changes made now.

Hayden, the impacts table I'm not inclined to change any further at this stage — it has been simplified per John's comments to the extent we think appropriate given our inter-agency discussions. Also, the fert cap reporting requirement isn't meant to apply except for dairy. John asked about this and Bryan talked him through it already. Also, I left this out of my comments to Katherine yesterday, but in case it's helpful in discussions with John, I also haven't made changes on telemetry that he queried since it is a technical matter about how data is transferred.

Some of the text we proposed adding yesterday didn't make it into today's version of the paper particularly once comments from the minister's office on removing some text were also made which is why the conversation between Chris and myself isn't reflected completely in the paper.



Para 132: suggested change to the text below (also in attached version in track change). Note previously we've received comments on not including the land use change figures for 2017 NPS-FM in the paper. This edit now puts those figures in.

Impacts of the new nitrogen toxicity bottom lines varies by region. For example, the Canterbury region is expected to be most impacted and represents \$25 million per annum of the estimated cost of \$30 million per annum for all regions. These costs represent a 0.9% per annum reduction in Canterbury dairy sector profits by 2050 and around 4,200 hectares changing land use from dairy to arable cropping. This in addition to impacts due to the 2017 NPS-FM, which are estimated at 8.9% per annum in Canterbury dairy sector profits by 2050 and around 40,000 hectares of land use change. Impacts are also expected in Waikato but to a lesser degree: a reduction in dairy sector profits of 0.3% per annum by 2050 and 2,300 hectares leaving the dairy sector.

Footnote 26 – agree would prefer this was in the text rather than footnote. We can use the current footnote wording or this version below (I've removed some words from the third line and added in reference to DairyNZ). Suggest add it as a new para 133.

There has been a range of modelling undertaken by different entities and stakeholders on the impacts of these policies, for example DairyNZ, the results of which vary significantly. There is a degree of uncertainty with all modelled figures. Assumptions around discount rates, time periods, approaches used by councils, current farm practices and effectiveness of mitigation techniques all have an impact on the final figures being presented.

I personally wouldn't single out DairyNZ's modelling as I think other submitters included useful modelling also. If MPI want them singled out from all the other submissions then I think the new paragraph is the best place.

I also wonder if footnote 24 can go now as it doesn't add much to what's already in the text but I don't feel strongly about this.

Some of the text we proposed adding yesterday didn't make it into today's version of the paper particularly once comments from the minister's office on removing some text were also made which is why the conversation between Chris and myself isn't reflected completely in the paper.

Looking at the version Nora sent through to me at 2.50pm here's my comments.



Para 132: suggested change to the text below (also in attached version in track change). Note previously we've received comments on not including the land use change figures for 2017 NPS-FM in the paper. This edit now puts those figures in.

Impacts of the new nitrogen toxicity bottom lines varies by region. For example, the Canterbury region is expected to be most impacted and represents \$25 million per annum of the estimated cost of \$30 million per annum for all regions. These costs represent a 0.9% per annum reduction in Canterbury dairy sector profits by 2050 and around 4,200 hectares changing land use from dairy to arable cropping. This in addition to impacts due to the 2017 NPS-FM, which are estimated at 8.9% per annum in Canterbury dairy sector profits by 2050 and around 40,000 hectares of land use change. Impacts are also expected in Waikato but to a lesser degree: a reduction in dairy sector profits of 0.3% per annum by 2050 and 2,300 hectares leaving the dairy sector.

footnote wording or this version below (I've removed some words from the third line and added in reference to DairyNZ). Suggest add it as a new para 133.

There has been a range of modelling undertaken by different entities and stakeholders on the impacts of these policies, for example DairyNZ, the results of which vary significantly. There is a degree of uncertainty with all modelled figures. Assumptions around discount rates, time periods, approaches used by councils, current farm practices and effectiveness of mitigation techniques all have an impact on the final figures being presented.

I personally wouldn't single out DairyNZ's modelling as I think other submitters included useful modelling also. If MPI want them singled out from all the other submissions then I think the new paragraph is the best place.

I also wonder if footnote 24 can go now as it doesn't add much to what's already in the text but I don't feel strongly about this.

I have attached the outputs of one of our essential freshwater economic impact assessments. Rather than being one report, Tim has split this into two shorter reports, one on benefits and one on costs. The focus for this review stage is that the approach taken was reasonable. There has been a considerable amount of discussion and input from MPI in the development of the costs report in particular. 

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



Regarding the other RIAs, I'm conscious that the drafts we were sent 3-4 weeks ago are a bit out of date now. In particular, the N-Cap and intensification draft RIAs do not reflect the current recommendations. For example, in the version we have for N-Cap the RIA only discusses Option1 from the discussion document (using Overseer to manage nitrogen in Schedule 1 catchments) rather than Option 2 hationwide fertiliser cap) which is currently the recommended option. I presume the RIAs have teen updated to reflect this, but we are happy to go through and do so if that would be helpful? In any event, we would appreciate if we could see the most recent drafts of the N-Cap and intensification RIAs if possible.







Freshwater Leaders Group: Final Recommendations

The Freshwater Leaders Group (FLG) met on 2 and 3 March 2020 to consider the report from the Independent Advice Panel (IAP) and further advice from the STAG on dissolved Inorganic nitrogen (DIN) and dissolved reactive phosphorous (DRP). Our deliberations were also informed by the meeting between the Chairs and yourselves on the morning of 3 March 2020.

We are cognisant that you are in the process of making decisions. We would like to provide you with some final advice on six key matters:

• Ensuring DIN and DRP are clear bottom-lines to be addressed in regional plans (not via action plans) and how to manage their implementation

Ensuring DIN and DRP are clear bottom-lines and how to manage their implementation

It is clear from the report of the STAG that DIN and DRP are attributes that must be managed to achieve desired ecosystem health outcomes in New Zealand freshwater. We agree with Kahui Wai Māori and the Regional Sector Group that these should be included in the NPS-FM 2020 as bottom-line attributes at the levels recommended by the majority of the STAG. We recommend making these attributes compulsory bottom-lines managed by the regional plans through 'limit setting'. We advise against the IAP's recommendation to have 'action plans' for these bottom-lines because of the importance of these attributes for ecosystem health and the non-statutory nature of 'action plans'.

Because reference conditions for DRP can be influenced by geology and because achieving a DIN target of 1ppm may not be practical or feasible in a small number of catchments within the period of the next regional plans (ten years), or indeed in the foreseeable future, the NPS-FM could allow for the following exceptions:

- 1) Where DRP exceeds the bottom line because the catchment is in acid-volcanic terrain, these water systems are readily identifiable and quantifiable (according to STAG) and could readily be managed by exception.
- 2) Where DIN of greater than 1ppm when all other attributes, ecosystem health measures and their bottom-lines, are met, and there is compelling, peer-reviewed scientific evidence that acting to reduce the DIN to 1ppm will not result in further improvement in ecosystem health of the freshwater body or the downstream receiving environments (including estuaries and lakes).
- 3) Where DIN is much higher than 1 ppm Regional Councils must target at least a 30% reduction over a ten year period as part of a long-term plan long term plan to reduce DIN towards the national bottom line, consistent with ecosystem health.

Exemptions would be applied for by regional councils on a catchment or Freshwater Management Unit (FMU) basis during the planning process and adjudicated by the independent plan panel. Robust, science-based criteria and process will be essential to ensure that the opportunities for exemptions are not exploited and undermine the integrity of the system.

If one of the above exceptions is granted for a catchment in a regional plan, additional ongoing monitoring must be implemented to manage the elevated risk of degradation, or the failure to meet improvement targets. If agreed freshwater quality outcomes are not met, the exception will be called in for review and amendment.

Ensuring FEPs do not replace national-level regulation but are used as a regulatory tool by regional councils and a management tool by industry and farmers

We reiterate the advice of the FLG that FEPs are not a substitute for a strong regulatory framework that sets meaningful bottom lines for freshwater quality in regional plans by way of clear, effective rules. NES rules are required to manage intensification and high-impact land uses and activities during the period before regional plans are operative. It is not

appropriate for rules that can be practically regulated to be moved to FEPs.

While the majority of the FLG continues to believe that FEPs should not be mandatory, most see their usefulness as a regulatory tool for Regional Councils. The majority believe that rather than all farmers being required to have FEPs, they should be used as regulatory tools to control high risk land use activities at tge discretion of Regional Councils. Regional Councils must have the ability to ensure FEPs are robust, auditable and enforceable. The majority of FLG recommends that Government stop short of making these mandatory across New Zealand and instead devolves their implementation to regional councils, to be deployed at their discretion. We endorse the inclusion of enabling provisions in the current Peleased under the Resource Management Amendment Bill by way of a Supplementary Order Paper (SOP). Some members of the FLG believe that FEPs should not be used as regulatory tools at all.

Regional Sector Response to the IAP Report

Thank you for providing the Regional Sector Water Subgroup (RSWS) the opportunity to consider the Independent Advisory Panel's (IAP) report on the Essential Freshwater Reform Proposals.

However there is also a range of matters arising out of the IAP report that continue to be of interest to the Regional Sector. The purpose of this letter is to set out those matters for your consideration. We would say, at the outset, that we consider that the IAP has added significant value to the EFW proposals and in broad terms we agree with the direction proposed in its report.

Default for DIN and DRP

We have consistently expressed concern about proposals for national DIN and DRP bottom-lines, suggesting that such an approach risks perverse outcomes. Accordingly, we strongly agree with the proposal whereby a national bottom-line for DIN and DRP is set as a default but which enables a process for determining different bottom-lines where the science supports this. Such outcomes would be enabled through regional plan change processes (involving independent, expert, freshwater panels).

The Regional Sector has given further thought to how the above proposal might be given effect to and this is set out in detail in our submission. We note that the IAP suggested that our approach would be 'workable.'

The approach we suggested essentially involves:

- Requiring regional councils to set nutrient target attribute states in prescribed circumstances (essentially where surface water/ecosystem health are susceptible to elevated nutrient levels);
- Set those target attribute states at a level that ensures the target attribute states for other (mandatory) attributes, and coastal receiving water standards (as set in regional coastal plans) will be met; and
- Councils being required to satisfy the above using the NPSFM default DIN and DRP bottomlines (at least) unless there was regional scale monitoring and research that justified different standards.

At the conceptual level, we continue to consider such an approach to be the most appropriate option and would welcome the opportunity to work with officials on refining the wording to ensure that approach is both clear and robust.

We strongly support the commentary of the IAP report on the matter of DIN and DRP attributes. The IAP recommendation of shifting DIN and DRP to Appendix 2B is welcomed but we are concerned that, unless other parts of the NPSFM are also amended, it may not provide the solution to the issues identified. That is because Policy 7 of the NPSFM rightly requires councils to avoid future overallocation and phase-out existing over-allocation. 'Over-allocation' is defined by the NPSFM to occur when water is, "being used to a point where one or more target attribute state is not being met." Hence, while the IAP seemed to suggest that moving DIN and DRP to Appendix 2B would remove the mandatory regulatory nature of DIN/DRP attributes (allowing councils to apply them in a regulatory context only when considered appropriate to do so), the NPSFM itself seems to require otherwise. If the IAP recommendation is to be accepted, then the relationship of Policy 7 and the definition of overallocation needs to be carefully considered to ensure the change has the recommended effect. To be clear, however, RSWS supports the alternative solution outlined above.

- The group asked if at risk catchments had been mentioned, officials replied that they did not appear to be a common theme in intensification, but had been mentioned in regards to the Nitrogen proposals.
- 25. The dissolved inorganic nitrogen (DIN) proposal was the next topic covered by officials who reported that:
 - Some groups and Councils noted that in regards to DIN, lower nitrogen does not always equal improved environmental health.
 - Other submitters stated that the social and economic impacts of changing the DIN bottom lines would be too great to justify the environmental outcomes.
 - NIWA's submission said ecosystem health is multi-factorial and DIN is spuriously correlated to it, consequently DIN should be subservient to other factors. A proposed alternative to the currently proposed DIN bottom line could be different bottom line numbers.
 - The group asked if there were any derogation/exemptions requests, officials replied there had been (example: ECAN).

The figures below show the modelled median minimally disturbed condition (McDowell et al. 2018¹) by REC (2nd level) class, in relation to the STAG's proposed dissolved inorganic nitrogen (DIN) and dissolved reactive phosphorus (DRP) attribute state boundaries. We used nitrate-N (NO₃-N) and filterable reactive P (FRP) as proxies for DIN and DRP.




Figure 2. Estimated reference median filterable reactive P concentrations for sites grouped by REC (2^{nd} level) classes are shown as the circles with \pm 95% confidence interval whiskers. The numbers at e site . he filled bottom ("Values") show exact median values for each classes. The cross indicates the median values for a known minimally disturbed condition-reference site within a class while the number of sites used for this analysis is indicated at the bottom as N. The filled colour bands show rough boundaries of the




Figure 3. River segment distribution of REC (2nd level) classes where the median reference FRP values exceeded the proposed DRP "A" band.




Figure 4. River segment distribution of the REC (2nd level) classes where the median reference FRP values exceeded the proposed DRP "B" band (i.e., the WWLk class).
