NOTICE OF INSANITY DEFENSES

Comes now the Defendant, LLOYD BEN POWELL, by and through his undersigned attorney and files this Notice of Insanity Defenses pursuant to Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure 3.216(b), and gives notice that at the time of trial in this case Defendant intends to rely on insanity and states as follows:

1. That Defendant was insane at the time he committed the alleged act.
2. That at the time of the alleged act Defendant was unable to differentiate between right and wrong.
3. That at the time of the alleged incident Defendant was unable to control his behavior.
