



Attachment I – Statement of Facts

1. Eric Lynn Johnson ("Johnson") is the Mayor of the City of Dallas.


- 2. Donald Parish ("Parish") is a candidate for City Council from District 7.
- 3. On information and belief, Johnson maintains an account with the social media platform, Twitter, under the name @Johnson4Dallas ("Johnson's Twitter Account").
- 4. On information and belief, Johnson and/or persons acting on Johnson's behalf and at his behest have sole control over Johnson's Twitter Account. Johnson's Twitter Account has about 38,000 followers.
- 5. On information and belief, Johnson regularly publishes materials on the Johnson Account that are of interest to the public, such that Johnson's Twitter Account has become broadly associated with Johnson in the eyes of the public.
- 6. On information and belief, Parish maintains an account with Twitter under the name @DonaldRParishJr ("Parish's Twitter Account"). Parish's Twitter Account has about 89 followers.
- 7. On information and belief, Parish and/or persons acting on Parish's behalf and at his behest have sole control over Parish's Twitter Account.
- 8. On or about April 19, 2021, Parish published a flyer (the "Endorsement") announcing the endorsement by Johnson of Parish in the May 1, 2021 municipal elections (a copy of the Endorsement is included herein as Attachment II-A). The endorsement contained language identifying Johnson as "the leader of the city."
- 9. On information and belief, the Endorsement was approved and authorized by Johnson.
- 10. On April 19, 2021, the Dallas Morning News published an article (the "DMN Article") about Johnson's endorsement of Parish bearing the headline "Mayor Eric Johnson backs opponent in City Council race over incumbent Adam Bazaldua." (a copy of the DMN Article can be viewed at https://www.dallasnews.com/news/elections/2021/04/19/dallas-mayor-eric-johnson-endorses-2nd-city-council-challenger-over-incumbent-in-south-dallas/)
- 11. On or about April 19, 2021, a post containing a copy of the Endorsement (the "Parish Post"), together with a link to the DMN Article appeared on Parish's Twitter Account (a copy of the Parish Post is included herein as Attachment II-B). The Parish Post also included the headline from the DMN Article, which mentioned Johnson's City of Dallas title.
- 12. On information and belief, the Parish Post was approved and authorized by Parish and Johnson.
- 13. Complainant asserts that the Parish Post constitutes a political endorsement by Johnson and notes that the Parish Post includes mention of Johnson's title—Mayor of Dallas.
- 14. On or about April 19, 2021, a post (the "Johnson Post"), republishing or "retweeting" the Parish Post, appeared on Johnson's Twitter Account (a copy of the Johnson Post is included herein as Attachment II-C).
- 15. On information and belief, the Johnson Post was approved and authorized by Johnson.

16. Complainant asserts that the Johnson Post constitutes a political endorsement by Johnson and notes that the Johnson Post includes mention of Johnson's title—Mayor of Dallas.

Conclusion

Complainant maintains that not only has Johnson made political endorsements in the Johnson Post and the Parish Post that include mention of his City of Dallas title, Johnson has broadcast those endorsements via Twitter to approximately 38,000 people. Complainant seeks a ruling from this Board that Johnson's conduct as described above violates Section 12A-10(a) of the City of Dallas Code of Ethics. Plaintiff further seeks guidance from this Commission as to whether the inclusion of the words "the leader of the city," in the Endorsement also amounts to a "mention" of Johnson's office in violation of that statute.






