15 Mark J. Murphy, an Assistant Attorney General for the
16 state of Montana and a Special Deputy County Attorney for
17 Lincoln County, alleges that on or between January 1, 1997, and
18 April 30, 1998, in Lincoln County, Montana, the Defendant
19 committed the offenses of Theft, two counts, both felonies, in
20 violation of Mont. Code Ann. § 45-6-301(2)(a), or in the
21 alternative, False Claims to Governmental Agencies, two counts,
22 in violation of Mont. Code Ann. § 45-7-210. The facts
23 constituting the offenses follow.

COUNT I

On or between January 1, 1997, and April 30, 1998, in
Lincoln County, Montana, the Defendant, Larry Dolezal, did

1 purposely or knowingly and as part of a common scheme, obtain
2 by deception control over property, namely money of Lincoln
3 County, by filing claims of meal reimbursements to which he was
4 not entitled and he had the purpose to deprive Lincoln County
5 of its property. The value of the property exceeded \$500.

COUNT II

8 In the alternative to the offense alleged in Count I, on
9 or between January 1, 1997, and April 31, 1998, in Lincoln
10 County, Montana, the Defendant, Larry Dolezal, did purposely or
11 knowingly and as a part of a common scheme, presented for
12 payment false or fraudulent claims for meals reimbursement to
13 which he was not entitled, to a public agency, namely, Lincoln
14 County. The value of the claims exceeded \$500.

COUNT III

17 On or between January 1, 1997, and April 30, 1998, in
18 Lincoln County, Montana, the Defendant, Larry Dolezal, did
19 purposely or knowingly and as part of a common scheme, obtain
20 by deception control over property, namely money of Lincoln
21 County, by filing claims of mileage reimbursements to which he
22 was not entitled and he had the purpose to deprive Lincoln
23 County of its property. The value of the property exceeded
24 \$500.

COUNT IV

2 In the alternative to the offense alleged in Count III, on
3 or between January 1, 1997, and April 30, 1998, in Lincoln
4 County, Montana, the Defendant, Larry Dolezal, did purposely or
5 knowingly and as a part of a common scheme, present for payment
6 false or fraudulent claims for mileage reimbursement to which
7 he was not entitled, to a public agency, namely, Lincoln
8 County. The value of the claims exceeded \$500.

9 A person convicted of the offenses alleged in Counts I and
10 III shall be imprisoned in the state prison for a term of not
11 more than ten years or be fined an amount not more than
12 \$50,000, or both.

13 A person convicted of the offenses alleged in Counts II
14 and IV shall be imprisoned in the state prison for a term of
15 not more than ten years or be fined an amount not more than
16 \$10,000, or both.


