## **AFFIDAVIT**

Your Affiant (YA), Dennis Sullivan has personal knowledge of the facts set forth therein, and having been duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

- 1. YA is a Detective with the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO). He has been employed by JSO for the past 18 years and is currently assigned to the Homicide and Cold Case Unit which encompasses Child Abduction.
- 2. On today's date at approximately 2:19 a.m., William Ebron, Jr. called JSO to report a stolen vehicle and kidnapped child 2 years of age who was inside the vehicle.
- 3. YA has received a statement from William Ebron, Jr that William Ebron, Jr. dropped off the mother [Lonna Barton] of the now missing child at work the night before at approximately 8:30 p.m.. William Ebron, Jr. was about to pick up Ms. Barton from Wacko's Gentleman's Club when the vehicle and child were taken. William Ebron, Jr provides transportation to Ms. Barton to and from work.
- 4. William Ebron, Jr. told YA that William Ebron, Jr. was at a nearby laundry mat, put a load of clothes in, went back to the apartment complex to use powder cocaine, and left the now missing child in the vehicle with the engine running. A few minutes later, William Ebron, Jr. heard the vehicle leaving and William Ebron, Jr. ran outside to see the vehicle exiting onto Old Kings Road South in Jacksonville.
- 5. William Ebron, Jr. told YA that he and Ms. Barton are residing together in a rented room at friend's apartment located at 8030 Old Kings Road South, Apt 66, Jacksonville, Florida. William Ebron, Jr. rented the room after Ms. Barton lost her apartment in Baker County due to the pending case in which the defendant and Ms. Barton are codefendants.

6. YA verified with Daniel Aranda this information of the residence being shared by William Ebron, Jr. and Ms. Barton. Mr. Aranda is charging rent of \$250.00 a month and half the cost of utilities. YA has personally seen the room being rented and observed feminine products and children's items within.

7. YA has also reviewed surveillance video from today's date which shows at 12:33 a.m. the defendant going into a Kangaroo gas station

located at Baymeadows and Old Kings Road in Jacksonville.
