- 1. Economics with TT/JS all set. Comp and equity will be reviewed annually. They are employed/retained now and everyone should use them as you would any employee. AG it is my understanding that JS will begin showing up daily at Gillette on Monday. We need to get them on payroll maybe JS can work with Robyn on Monday (see below)
- 2. Benefits as PM agreed with AG, TB12 will reimburse JS for his COBRA healthcare payments until TB12 institutes a normal employee benefits plan JS will make overall benefits proposal to the Board as part of the "First 100 Days"
- 3. Profits Interest TT has been pushing me to institute a minimum annual pro rata profits distribution Meaning, for example, if the Company earns \$1mm and TT owns 2%, he will receive an additional \$20,000. I argued against instituting any policy now as it is early stage company and cash must be cherished. When and if the company hits "steady state", the Board will consider

if a minimum pro rata profits distribution (over and above the tax distribution) should be created. He said ok.

- 4. Company valuation when issuing stock I raised this in an earlier email this is an open item. There is a balance here. If we set the company value too high, JS/TT will not be motivated by equity. If we set it too low, there is more implied dilution of the existing shareholders. I suggest we discuss a number with \$2.5mm as the low end and \$10mm as the high. I remind everyone that when TB bought RKK's shares, the value was \$2.5mm. MB has more experience w/ this than I do. Thoughts? This is a Board decision meaning it needs to be a formal process b/c the IRS cares about the valuation being reasonably defendable.
- 5. Jeff's title they suggested his title be Senior Vice President for now. Nice and innocuous. The COO title implies more of an internal role (As compared with biz dev which obviously is external). SVP is a good 'tweener. I had already discussed this possibility with AG and he/we were indifferent. I agreed- but also said the title may change if we deem that in the best interest of TB12. They agreed.
- 6. Legal docs SCS had drafted offer letters, equity grants docs, an equity incentive plan and had reviewed the existing LLC agreement to identify what needs to change based on the above evolutions. I spoke with Robyn Glaser yesterday and sent her all of our drafts. She will be speaking with Morgan Lewis, the law firm that drafted the original docs (which were very well done). Robyn, Morgan Lewis and I will be speaking early next week about what we need and me answering any questions they have. I imagine that within 10 days we will receive all docs, at which point TT/JS will ask their lawyer to review. They asked for \$1500 legal expense reimbursement for this review this is a normal ask I accepted this. Robyn, as always, was 100% supportive.
- 7. They have done a ton of planning already I attached a pdf of the docs I received last night apologies for not laminating the pdf......

PS – one nit that slightly irks me – TT keeps referring to himself as the Board Chair or the Lead Director – and last night said to me, "As you suggested". One, I think TB is the Chair and TT is the Board Mtg Organizer (BMO). So if he needs a title, BMO would be fine. Ha. Second – I never suggested or said anything like that.



In response:

- 1. I am not sure we registered any IP that you did not already have you own TB12. In fact, I had asked Steve/ for a license for TB12 LLC to use TB12. I even sent them a sample license agreement. I'll see if I can find that correspondence and send it to you. I will, of course, continue to think through IP protection and strategy with you, Alex and Jeff, if you wish. I'm not sure what level you want my involvement to be going forward but I remain ready and willing to support in any way I can the development and growth of TB12, as little or as much as you wish.
- 2. I have forwarded a full list of all registered domain names to you and Alex in the past. I will see if I can find those emails and re-send them.
- 3. I don't know of any other partner agreements, but I will look back at my emails.
- 4. I think that Alex entered into a lot of the vendor agreements directly (i.e., cleaning crew). I am not sure what we have here. I don't remember having anything but I will check with Jim Wilson. I will check with HR because there may be an agreement with the payroll company. Also, there was a retainer with Ernst & Young to do your taxes last year. Will you be taking over taxes this year or do you want us to have E&Y do yours again? If so, you'll need to sign another retainer with them. Please let me know so I can get that done.

I should definitely meet with Jeff live. That would be most efficient. He and I have discussed doing that but I have honestly been tied up 24/7 on the psi matter. In the building before 6am most every day and not home until 8 – 9pm. I just need a bit longer – until after your interview next week – to be available.
