1 (Start at 37 minutes) 2 MR. BATES: In Oklahoma city. 3 MR. BERMAN: Yeah. I've never played with I'm not very good. 4 them. 5 MR. BATES: Golf is frustrating and --6 (Inaudible) 7 MR. BERMAN: I know what you mean. 8 MR. BATES: I'd rather go fishing. I'd 9 rather stand in a stream. 10 MR. BERMAN: Yeah. 11 MR. BATES: Sit on a rock, smoke a cigar. 12 And, you know, I'm just -- I'm not into -- outside of my 13 sheriff's stuff, that's about the only exciting thing I 14 do. 15 MR. BERMAN: About as fun and exciting as 16 you need I would think. 17 MR. BATES: Well, it scares that shit out 18 of me. 19 MR. BERMAN: I mean, that's all you need, 20 right? 21 MR. BATES: It's kind of the thing that I 22 need to go back to do to scare the shit out of me to 23 make feel good about why (inaudible) you know, I love 24 that. That was just great. And I hadn't done a whole 25 lot of it lately, but I'm planning on going back to it.

1 They made me the Oklahoma Sheriff's Association Reserve 2 Deputy of the Year, so I'm going to an awards banquet. 3 MR. BERMAN: Oh. MR. BATES: Where the hell is Midwest 4 5 City? 6 MR. BERMAN: Midwest City? I think it's 7 by Oklahoma City somewhere. MR. BATES: Somewhere, yeah. I've got to 8 9 go over there Friday night with the Major. 10 MR. BERMAN: Yeah, I think it's -- I think 11 it's like a suburb or whatever of Oklahoma City. I've 12 never been there. (End of 37 minutes to 38 minutes) 13 14 (Start at 45 minutes to 51 minutes) 15 MR. BATES: You know, but Mike got so hard 16 core on me toward the end, you know, like by God, you 17 better listen to me. I'm telling you what the fuck you 18 need to do. That's not good with me. I don't do well 19 with that. I don't do well with direction. 20 MR. BERMAN: Right. 21 MR. BATES: I never have since the first 22 grade. 23 MR. BERMAN: Right. 2.4 MR. BATES: My first grade teacher and I had problems and I've had problems throughout my life. 25

You know, no, fuck you. Here's what I'm going to do, 1 2 you know. And Mike I just -- in the last three or four 3 years, Mike got it in his head I'm the CEO. You need to listen to me. Fuck you, you know. I've had more 4 5 success. I've made more money. I've done whatever than you've ever fuckin' dreamed about. 6 7 MR. BERMAN: So it was just better to take 8 -- take the stronger road --9 MR. BATES: Yeah, yeah, yeah. MR. BERMAN: -- as opposed to just --10 11 MR. BATES: And, you know, I always 12 wanting to go home. I mean, my wife has got some things 13 going on that are fuckin' mind bending. You know, she 14 could (clapped hands) manufacture something for two 15 bucks and sell them for 45. 16 MR. BERMAN: No, get out of here. 17 (Inaudible) 18 MR. BATES: You got a gun on you? 19 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: No, sir, I'm 20 serving alcohol. 21 MR. BATES: Yeah. 22 (Inaudible) 23 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Well, the problem 24 is, you know --25 MR. BERMAN: You behaving?

1 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Yes, sir. 2 MR. BATES: Staying out of trouble. 3 MR. BERMAN: Bryan Berman. 4 (Inaudible) 5 MR. BATES: I'm going home here before too 6 long. 7 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: We'll save some for 8 another day. 9 MR. BATES: All right, stay out of trouble. 10 11 MR. BERMAN: Nice to meet you. 12 (Inaudible) 13 MR. BATES: Mike pushed too hard is what 14 he did. He pushed too hard. He finally pissed me off 15 in Florida of what he was poking at me, so I recorded it 16 all. I said, I don't give a shit. He said, Every 17 conversation that you've ever made with us, they said 18 they have a file that started in '08. 19 I told Mike he was an ignorant mother fucker. And, 20 you know, they went from there. Well, that didn't 21 exactly do a lot for me. Okay, so you do somewhat. I 22 get before a jury and, you know, I guarantee I know how 23 to pick a jury. American Airlines (clapped hands), you 24 know, whatever get those guys, redneck guys, poor guy

here, you know.

Doug Cameron, money big, whatever, trying to fuck me over, whatever, I guarantee you (clapped hands) I'll fuck them in the ass for some strong money (clapped hands). Trust me. I have damages. I'm not going into details, but I have damages. As you well know as an attorney, I will stick it up their ass and they're going to get barbequed. But, you know, if they want to do that, that's all right.

MR. BATES: Well, I'd love to prevent it.

I just -- I have -- Bryan, I have millions of dollars.

I'm in good shape. My wife makes millions of dollars.

I don't need to work. I don't have to do this shit at all. She looked at me the other day and said, What the fuck are you doing this for? Why don't you just get up and go home? I said because now it's become a principal. It's become a part. I can (inaudible)

MR. BERMAN: Well, are you still -- are you still of the mindset you can settle with them? Are you still willing to buy some --

MR. BATES: No, hell, no, no. I'm -- you know, they can stick it up their ass now. I mean, that's -- my attorneys have convinced me that it's money in this. And, quite frankly, the comment was there's

quite a bit of money in this. Based on what we see in 1 our previous plaintiffs' litigation, we believe you can 2 3 sack this guy. And, you know, and I've heard it from 4 three of them now. 5 MR. BERMAN: Which -- which plaintiff? 6 Are you talking about the lady? 7 MR. BATES: Hum? MR. BERMAN: Previous plaintiffs' 8 9 litigation, what do you mean? 10 MR. BATES: No, the guys that I've hired. 11 The guys that pro bono shit for me because they said, 12 Oh, my god, you know, this is -- this is an attorney's 13 dream. I said, Okay. 14 MR. BERMAN: Well, I've -- I've been 15 talking to producers trying to figure out how not to 16 have any damages and I think that's --17 MR. BATES: I'm not willing to pay it at 18 this point for fucking anything. I mean, I -- I don't 19 need to pay it for anything. I've already got it. I 20 own it, you know. I --21 MR. BERMAN: You're all set up with the 22 new court decision? 23 MR. BATES: Yeah, oh, yeah, good God, yes. 24 They're already screwed. We've got 13,000 feet down 25 there of beautiful office, everything we bought, you

1 Jarmon said, Well, you paid more than me, and I know. 2 didn't pay a half of that, you know. I've got 3 everything set up. Cash-wise I can afford to do it. 4 These guys will take it over. They've all signed up. 5 MR. BERMAN: Are they all partners or? 6 MR. BATES: Yes, every -- no, not 7 everybody. There's one, two, three, four, five, six. 8 MR. BERMAN: Six partners? 9 MR. BATES: Six are partners but everybody 10 is going to participate in the profits. And I didn't care about me. I mean, quite frankly, I don't give a 11 12 shit, you know, I'm getting to this. 13 MR. BERMAN: Well, Brad is going to take 14 over your position, right? 15 MR. BATES: Yes, we've got Brad. There 16 will be several people say my business is mine. I said 17 give me a monthly installment for a period of a year. 18 MR. BERMAN: Sure. 19 MR. BATES: I'm good. I'm already on my 20 Social Security. I get 2700 a month in Social Security. You guys just give me another check and shit I'm gone. 21 22 Send it to me in Florida. 23 MR. BERMAN: If you're on your boat but --24 MR. BATES: Yeah, I'll be on a boat. You 25 know, send it to our Post Office Box in Florida, and

I'll get it when I get back. I don't care. That's what Mike doesn't understand is I really don't care. But how to get him off of his high horse and shut him down and get him to start thinking what is the percentage in this? What's he going to? He's not going to get anything.

When five attorneys look at this and start laughing and say, you know, he's going nowhere. You will be in the driver's seat in another four or five months, and you can just tie him like a goat at a post and fuck him in the ass. And I -- that's what one of them said, and I started laughing.

MR. BERMAN: Well, from my seat, I'm going to try to make sure no one gets hurts --

MR. BATES: Yeah.

Two of them work pro bono all the time. He 20 donates that to them. He represents the sheriff's 21 office, the City of Tulsa. 22 MR. BERMAN: Oh. 23 MR. BATES: Free, no charge. 24 MR. BERMAN: Gotcha, gotcha. 25 MR. BATES: And he told me that's

important to me. I said, Clark, you're an unusual attorney. Most attorneys say, you, know, 400. Hey, we'll do it. It will be 100 grand. MR. BERMAN: But you never pay him or is it free? MR. BATES: I haven't paid them yet, let's say. I mean, he knows I've done some shit for him at the sheriff's office, of course, for some of his clients.

MR. BERMAN: Gotcha, yeah. Kind of owes -- owes some --

MR. BATES: Yeah. No, I mean, he'll bill me for some. I -- I told him you cannot -- you know, give me a bill and he just grins. He's a hell of a guy, this guy. And then, of course, Jarmon is running around saying Bates changed attorneys, did whatever. It's his fuckin' attorney that asked him to stay and defend you -- well, over there.

Old Matt Cane said, you know, we -- you know, I'm going out of town. I'm going to Yugoslavia or something to adopt a kid so we need some time. That doesn't have anything to do with me. That's why I 5 don't think Mike needs to know. 6 MR. BERMAN: Like personal stuff or 7 business stuff? 8 MR. BATES: Both. And, you know, I --9 it's just stupid. It's just stupid on their part. And if they want to pull their pants down, it's okay with 10 11 me. And I'm not telling you that so you can tell them. 12 MR. BERMAN: Well, I mean --13 MR. BATES: They -- they don't understand 14 what I've done. They don't understand how my mind 15 works, believe me. And, you know, based on what I do as 16 a hobby and so forth, they don't have a fuckin' clue. 17 MR. BERMAN: Oh, you mean being a police 18 officer there? 19 MR. BATES: Yeah, they don't have a 20 fuckin' clue. I'm going to tell you I've got Jarmon on 21 audio and video. I've got shit that is fuckin' mind 22 bending. 23 MR. BATES: Bryan, it would be so 24 embarrassing to them. 25 MR. BERMAN: I'm sorry, say that --

1 MR. BATES: It will be so embarrassing to 2 them if I put them (inaudible) 3 MR. BERMAN: What just like stuff on 4 Jarmon? 5 MR. BATES: Audio and video on the stupid 6 bastard, you know. 7 MR. BERMAN: Doing -- doing what? 8 MR. BATES: Talking. 9 MR. BERMAN: Oh, just --MR. BATES: Just leading him into shit, 10 11 getting him to say things that he shouldn't say that in 12 front of a jury will be unbelievably God damn 13 embarrassing. I mean, they are going to get fucked and, 14 you know, whatever. But, anyway, I mean, that's just --15 you don't need to say anything about that, you know, 16 whatever. I just -- I want to make this --17 MR. BERMAN: Go away. 18 MR. BATES: -- as easy as I know and I 19 want to make it go away. But they are not in a position 20 to win and, you know, it's just, okay, if they want to 21 go for it, I'll go. 22 MR. BERMAN: And I -- I'm happy to -- if 23 you want me to, I'd be happy to relay some sort of 24 information back. 25 MR. BATES: I don't know that you should.
