BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That section 3/01.034 of the Revised Code be	8
enacted to read as follows:	9
Sec. 3701.034. (A) As used in this section:	10
(1) "Affiliate" means an entity that has with another_	11
entity a legal relationship created or governed by at least one	12
written instrument that demonstrates any of the following:	13
(a) Common ownership, management, or control;	14

(c) The granting or extension of a license or other	16

agreement that authorizes an entity to use the other entity's		
brand name, trademark, service mark, or other registered	18
