6 The following is an application for a telephonic search warrant.

7 Person requesting telephonic search warrant is DETECTIVE MICHAEL

8 EISENLOFFEL of the Nye County Sheriff's Office, 1520 East Basin,

9 Pahrump, Nevada, reference Case #15NY-2488.

11 Person granting telephonic search warrant is JUDGE ROBERT

12 LANE. Transcription of telephonic search warrant by Marsha Steverman-

13 Meech of i WRITE transcription, inc.

16 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: Okay. Judge Lane, I've  
17 started the recorder. The date today is October 13, 2015 and the time is  
18 approximately 10:15 p.m. Would you mind swearing me in, sir?

19 JUDGE LANE: Yeah. Do you swear the testimony you're  
20 about to give is the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, so  
21 help you God?

22 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: Yes, sir. I do.

23 JUDGE LANE: Thank you.

24 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: As I just related to you, sir,  
25 this is Detective Eisenloffel with the Nye County Sheriff's Office. My P# is

1 74531, and I am making an application for a telephonic search warrant  
2 pursuant to NRS 179.045. My application is as follows: I am a peace  
3 officer employed by the Nye County Sheriff's Office and have been  
4 employed for approximately eight years. I am currently assigned to the  
5 general assignment detective division of the Pahrump substation. My  
6 duties include but are not limited to detection and investigation of  
7 violations of Nevada Revised Statute chapter 453.411, under the  
8 influence of a controlled substance.

9 I believe that there is probable cause to believe that evidence  
10 exists of a violation of NRS 453.411, under the influence of a controlled  
11 substance, and that the evidence is currently concealed within the body of  
12 Lamar Odom, date of birth 11/6 of 1975. He is currently located at  
13 Sunrise Hospital in Las Vegas, Nevada. The property referred and  
14 sought to be seized consists of a sample of Mr. Odom's blood to be  
15 obtained in a medically accepted manner and to be analyzed for the  
16 presence of any controlled substances.

17 I believe that the evidence sought exists due to the following  
18 circumstances; to wit, on this date, October 13, 2015, at approximately  
19 1516 hours, the Nye County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call from the  
20 Love Ranch, a brothel located in Crystal, Nevada, reporting that a male  
21 customer was unresponsive and unconscious. Paramedics from the  
22 Pahrump Valley Fire Rescue Service responded to the brothel and  
23 located the patient, later identified as Mr. Odom, and began transporting  
24 him to Desert View Hospital here in Pahrump.

25 Detective Fowles and I also responded subsequently and

1 conducted a investigation. During the course of the investigation, we  
2 interviewed the manager of the Love Ranch as well as two prostitutes,  
3 which were engaged with Mr. Odom prior to the reported incident. The  
4 interview revealed that Mr. Odom arrived at the Love Ranch the prior  
5 Saturday. During his initial time at the Love Ranch, he was observed  
6 both by eyewitnesses as well as on video surveillance camera to be  
7 ingesting an unknown substance in the form of an unidentified pill, which  
8 he obtained from his pocket in a plastic bag that was unmarked. It is  
9 unknown what the substance was.

10 Through interviews with the prostitutes who were with him since  
11 that point, it was learned that he possibly ingested cocaine in the  
12 bathroom adjoining in the bedroom in which the prostitutes were located  
13 along with Mr. Odom. They indicated that they heard him snorting. They  
14 indicated that they had vague knowledge of him using illicit narcotics. A  
15 Triple I or criminal history run by myself and Detective Fowles on Mr.  
16 Odom revealed that he has a prior history of illicit narcotics use,  
17 specifically driving under the influence of drugs at the time this was -- or  
18 this has occurred in 2013. We subsequently spoke with Mr. Odom's  
19 personal assistant at Desert View Hospital, who also indicated that he  
20 had knowledge that celebrities such as Mr. Odom often use illicit  
21 narcotics, and that he has actually witnessed Mr. Odom under the  
22 influence of narcotics.

23 Due to my training and experience in investigating numerous  
24 narcotics-related cases, which in some cases have led to total  
25 incapacitation to include but not limited to death, I believe that Mr. Odom

1 may be -- or may have been under the influence of a controlled  
2 substance. It should also be noted that during the interviews with the  
3 prostitutes at the Love Ranch, they observed once they found him up --  
4 unconscious to have a white substance coming from his mouth as well as  
5 bleeding from his nose. Those are all also symptoms, which due to my  
6 training and experience, I recognize as signs or evidence of a drug  
7 overdose.

8 Mr. Odom is currently located at Sunrise Hospital in Las Vegas for  
9 treatment. I would respectfully ask that this search warrant be granted in  
10 order for me to obtain a sample of his blood in a medically accepted  
11 manner so that it may be analyzed by the forensic laboratory at Las  
12 Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, specifically to be tested for the  
13 presence of illegal narcotics in order to further this investigation.

14 Judge, that is all I have at this point.

15 JUDGE LANE: Based on your testimony, it appears to the  
16 court that there's probable cause for you to obtain the search warrant and  
17 do the blood draw.

18 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: Yes, sir.

19 JUDGE LANE: Is there anything else you need from me?

20 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: Yes. I just need your  
21 permission for me to affix your name on the duplicate search warrant,  
22 which I will then forward to the court along with this recording as well as a  
23 transcript of this recording.

24 JUDGE LANE: Yes. You have my permission.

25 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: And furthermore, do I have

1 your permission to serve this warrant with nighttime service seeing as it is  
2 currently past 7:00 p.m.?

3 JUDGE LANE: Yes. Based on the totality of the  
4 circumstances, you should do it after night. Yes.

5 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: Okay. Thank you, Judge. It  
6 is currently 1021 hours, and with your permission, I will conclude this  
7 recording. Judge?

8 JUDGE LANE: Thank you, sir.

9 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: Okay. Thank you. Good  
10 night.

11 JUDGE LANE: You need anything else?

12 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: No, that is all I need. Thank  
13 you, sir.

14 JUDGE LANE: All right. Have a good night. Bye-bye.

15 DETECTIVE EISENLOFFEL: You too. Bye-bye.


