Subject: Previous Reserve Deputy Testing

I have examined the files that we previously spoke about. This included the list of names you gave me plus the names of the reserve deputies that I was assigned to conduct a background investigation in May, 2006. The list of names you supplied me included some of the same reserve deputies.

The reserve deputies in 2006 had partial backgrounds conducted in 2005 and 2006 and were already made reserve deputies before the 2006 backgrounds. I could find no written, test results for these reserve deputies. I was unable to determine if they were given a MMPI at any time. MMPI results are not kept in this office. They are kept by the Undersheriff's office.

I failed two of the reserve deputies when I conducted the 2006 backgrounds. I failed Sam Wegland, Sr. and his son, Sam Wegland, Jr.

Vicky Dalton was one of the reserves that I was assigned in 2006. She had a suspended Oklahoma DL in 2005 when she was made a reserve and still had a suspended DL in 2006, but had it reinstated after I determined while doing her partial background in 2006 that her DL was still suspended.

I determined that reserve Duffy McAnallen did take a written test in 2002. He had a very limited background conducted with no background book in his file. I could not determine if he took a MMPI.

Reserve deputies Zellinger and Wallace had partial backgrounds conducted in 2007. I could not determine if they were given a MMPI.

I checked the files of the names that you supplied to me. The only subjects that I could determine took a written test for reserve status was Coonce in 2003 and Ed Pierce in 2002. However, they had almost no background conducted at that time, according to their files.

However, Ed Pierce in 2008 and Chuck Jordan in 2005 had a written test, full background, and MMPI done for a full-time deputy position.

I determine that Reserve Deputy Sam McCullough did not take a written test and no background was conducted in 2007.

According to their background files, Coy Jenkins in 1997, Gary Glanz in 1992, and Larry Johnson (year unknown) had no background conducted. There were no written test results in their background files. I could not determine if a MMPI was taken, except there was a 1994 Psychological Evaluation form in Larry Johnson's file. That was the only piece of paper in his file.

Almost all of the other names had a partial background conducted in 2005 and 2006. I could not determine if a written test or MMPI was given to these reserve deputies. There were no test results in their background files. As I previously wrote, MMPI files are kept out of this office.
