## Narratives

On 07-29-2015, at 1245 hours, I was on Hermitage Way, checking for parking violations. I saw the subject hiding behind a pick-up with a cellular phone in his hand. The subject was holding the phone up and pointing it at me. I drove closer and the subject looked like he was taking photos or video of me. I took my phone out and took the attached photo of the subject. The subject became very angry. I got out of my patrol car and asked what was going on and if he need help. The subject would not answer my questions. He command me to leave the street, because I had no authority there. The subject put his hand in his pocket and was grabbing at a object in his pocket. I asked if he had a weapon. He did not answer. I pulled my gun out of my holster and pointed it to the ground. The subject continued to say I commanded you to leave. I told him to take his hand out of his pocket, because he could have a weapon. The subject took keys a phone and another black object out. He slammed them on the hood of his pick-up. He said your whole department is corrupted. I asked him if he needed help if he wanted to hurt himself, or others. He slowly walked into his garage.

I backed away. I called for back-up and Sgt. Nicks and PSO Labno arrived. I told him on what had happened.
