PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

BEFORE ME, THE UNDERSIGNED AUTHORITY PERSONALLY APPEARED THE AFFIANT HEREIN, A PEACE OFFICER UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, WHO, BEING DULY SWORN, ON OATH MADE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS AND ACCUSATIONS:

My name is CPL T. JOHNSON 19 and I am commissioned as a peace officer by the WEATHERFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT. I hereby state upon my oath that I have reason to believe and do believe that heretofore, and before the making and filing of this Complaint, that

on or about the 3 day of NOVEMBER, 2015, in Parker County, Texas, did then and there commit the offense of CAPITAL MURDER, a CAPITAL FELONY, in that ASHLEY NICOLE BLADES did then and there,

then and there intentionally or knowingly cause the death of an individual, namely, FEMALE INFANT BLADES, by SUFFOCATION, and the said FEMALE INFANT BLADES was then and there an individual younger than six years of age.

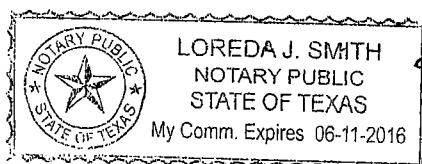
My probable cause for said belief and accusation is as follows:

ON 11-03-15, AT ABOUT 1420 HOURS, CPL. WESTENDORF AND I (CPL. T. JOHNSON 19) WERE DISPATCHED TO A WELFARE CHECK AT 413 W BALL ST. A MALE SUBJECT CALLED AND SAID THAT HIS GIRLFRIEND CALLED HIM AND TOLD HIM THEIR BABY WAS DEAD. CPL WESTENDORF ARRIVED ON SCENE AT ABOUT 1426 HOURS, AND I ARRIVED A FEW MOMENTS AFTER. WESTENDORF WAS TALKING TO A FEMALE, LATER IDENTIFIED AS BLADES, UNDER THE CARPORT OF THE RESIDENCE. I HEARD WESTENDORF ASK HER WHERE THE BABY WAS, AND SHE TOLD HIM THAT IT WAS IN THE TRUNK OF THE CAR, AND SHE POINTED TO A SILVER FORD FOCUS. WE RETRIEVED THE KEYS TO THE CAR. WESTENDORF OPENED THE TRUNK. INITIALLY, WE DIDN'T SEE THE INFANT. BLADE, FROM THE FRONT OF THE CAR, TOLD US THAT IT WAS WRAPPED UP IN A TOWEL THAT WAS IN A PLASTIC SHOPPING BAG. I HAD GLOVES ON, SO I PULLED BACK THE PLASTIC AND THE TOWEL AND DISCOVERED AN INFANT THAT APPEARED TO BE DECEASED. WE CALLED FOR DETECTIVES AND CRIME SCENE, AND MEDICAL INVESTIGATOR. I PLACED HANDCUFFS ON BLADES AND PLACED HER IN THE BACKSEAT OF MY PATROL CAR.

MEANWHILE, LIFECARE PARAMEDICS ARRIVED ON SCENE. PARAMEDIC A BIGHAM WAS ALLOWED TO EXAMINE THE BABY, AND HE OBSERVED THAT IT WAS COLD TO THE TOUCH, AND HAD VISIBLE LIVIDITY IN THE EXTREMITIES. HE PRONOUNCED THE INFANT DECEASED. DET LUECKE ARRIVED ON SCENE. LUECKE READ HER MIRANDA AND SHE AGREED TO WAVE HER RIGHTS AND ANSWER QUESTIONS. DURING QUESTIONING, SHE CONFESSED TO SUFFOCATING THE BABY SOMETIME MONDAY NIGHT, AND LEAVING THE INFANT WRAPPED IN A TOWEL OVERNIGHT. ASHLEY NICOLE BLADES DID then and there intentionally or knowingly cause the death of an individual, namely, FEMALE INFANT BLADES, by SUFFOCATION, and the said FEMALE INFANT BLADES was then and there an individual younger than six years of age.




