On 03-20-11 at 1512 hours Officer Jones and I responded to 1246 Blaine Ave reference picketing outside the residence. Information from dispatch indicated (7) picketers were yelling and making a lot of noise outside the residence.

Upon our arrival, Officer Jones directed me to park on the street just south of the residence (approximately 15-20 feet away) and observe the picketers. The group of picketers was approximately 10-12 people, and were peaceful during the time we observed them walking in front of the residence on the sidewalk. Officer Jones then talked me through how to deal with the picketers, and called the shift commander to confirm policy on how to handle the situation. During this time we realized we were not dispatched with a cover squad and put ourselves out at the call, approximately 2-3 minutes after our arrival. We requested a cover squad and waited for Officer Sackman's arrival.

Once Officer Sackman arrived we made contact with the group of picketers. We asked the group if they had a group organizer and the persons stated they did not. The group of picketers was then advised of city ordinance 66-422 which prohibits picketing in front of a residence, and were told they could move to Washington Ave if they wanted to continue. A few of the picketers then requested copies of the ordinance, at which time Officer Sackman produced a copy. The group was shown the copy of the ordinance, and at that time a few of the picketers requested that they have their own copies.

The group then dispersed from the area, with one stating they would like to come to the police station and receive copies of the city ordinance for the group. Officer Jones and I then returned to the PD and made copies of the ordinance and gave them to the person who requested the copies.

Case Detail

On 3-20-11 Officer T. Bodnar #0090 and I were dispatched to 1246 Blaine Avenue (3:13 P.M.) in reference to Picketing. We were advised by Racine dispatch that there were (7) seven picketers outside of the residence yelling and screaming. Officer Bodnar and I responded directly to this address where we observed several subjects walking with umbrellas in heavy rain directly in front of 1246 Blaine Avenue. We positioned our marked patrol vehicle in the roadway directly adjacent to the picketers (approximately 15 feet away). Officer T. Bodnar (New Recruit Officer) was advised how to safely manage a crowd situation prior to exiting our vehicle. I then observed that we were dispatched to this call for service without a cover squad. I then observed that the reported crowd of seven subjects was now a crowd of 15-20 subjects. I then advised Racine Dispatch that a cover officer would be needed prior to making any approach. Racine Dispatch was also advised that the crowd was peaceful and calm. As Officer Bodnar and I waited for our cover squad to arrive, I contacted the shift commander Lt. Lopez and advised him of the situation. Lt. Lopez advised me to ask the group of individuals who the leader was and collect that name should someone come forward. I was advised that if no one came forward, have the entire group disperse from the residence and advise them of the Racine City Ordinance pertaining to Picketing.

Officer Sackman #1289 arrived while I was still on the phone with the shift commander at which time I advised both he and Officer Bodnar of the directive to be followed. We then approached the group of subjects gathered on the sidewalk at which time I asked if there was "anyone in charge of the group?" At this time the ENTIRE group replied "There is no one in charge of the group!" At this time I advised the group that The Racine City Ordinance advised that Picketing a residence was not permitted in The City of Racine. An Unidentified female subject explained that picketing was not against that law. I then explained to this subject that while picketing a residence is not against the law, there is a city ordinance that prohibits such actions. This same subject stated that she wanted to see the Ordinance if possible because she had never heard of such a thing. At this time, several members of this group stated that they had never heard such thing as well. Officer Sackman provided a printed copy of the city ordinance for Picketing for the entire group to read. Several subjects within the group read the ordinance at which time I advised them that I would not have a problem making copies of the printed ordinance for each of them to have and extra to give to their friends. The group thanked us for being polite and respectful to them at which time they dispersed immediately without incident.

Officer Bodnar and I then returned to The Racine Police Department to make copies. One subject from the group followed us back to The Racine Police Department to obtain the copies that I, in turn, provided for him. I advised Sgt. Ide and Lt. Lopez of the copies being distributed to the group at which time I requested the complete list of rules for picketing within The City Of Racine. Sgt. Ide provided me with several copies of Racine Police Department Demonstrating/Picketing Rules and Guidelines. All copies were given to this subject who stated that he would distribute to the entire group. I provided 50 copies of The City Of Picketing Ordinance and at least 20 copies of the Rules and Guidelines forms.

Please note that at no time did anyone become loud, disruptive, or disrespectful in any way. The entire group was very polite and courteous. No one within this group wished to provide identification at the time of this incident on Blaine Avenue.

There is no one in custody at the time of this report.
