OFFENSE: MURDER (TXDPS Code 09990019) IN THE NAME AND BY AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

BEFORE ME, personally appeared the undersigned affiant, who, after being by me duly sworn, deposes and says that WILLIAM MITCHELL HUDSON, who is hereinafter styled DEFANDANT, on or about the 14th day of NOVEMBER, A.D., 2015 and before the making and filing of this complaint, in the County of Anderson, and the State of Texas, did then and Intentionally or knowingly causes the death of an individual; or intends to cause serious bodily injury and commits

Your affiant would show that he is a peace officer in the State of Texas. Your affiant is currently employed as a Sergeant with the Anderson County Sheriff's Department, Anderson County, Texas and he has reason to believe and does believe the above offense

On 11/15/2015, the Anderson County Sheriff's Office responded for a call for service at the 800 block of ACR 2217, Tennessee Colony, Anderson County, TX. Upon arrival they spoke with Cynthia Johnson, a white female, who stated she and several family members were camping on the above described unimproved land.

On 11/14/2015, a white male riding an orange tractor approached Johnson and her family members. He identified himself as "William." William assisted Johnson and her family in pulling a vehicle from the mud. Later, William returned and sat with Cynthia Johnson and her family and consumed alcoholic beverages with them. He later accompanied several family members into the surrounding woods, after which Cynthia Johnson heard multiple gunshots. William returned to the campsite alone. William then chased 2 of Johnson's family members into a camper trailer. Cynthia Johnson stated that she heard two gun shots and observed her husband, Carl Johnson, fall on the steps of the Camper trailer and therefore witnessing HUDSON shoot her husband, Carl Johnson. Cynthia Johnson continued to hide hearing multiple gunshots and remained in hiding until she felt it was safe to move.

Responding investigators secured the scene upon arrival and observed two bodies in a silver travel trailer matching the description of Cynthia Johnson's husband and daughter.

Responding investigators canvassed the area, locating William Hudson at 1132 ACR 2217, Tennessee Colony, TX. At this address a red tractor was discovered on the property with visible blood stains on the tractor. The Anderson County Sheriff's Office personnel viewed Hudson through a door with what was believed to be visible bloodstains on his person. While speaking to Hudson through the door he discontinued communication and barricaded himself inside. Law Enforcement personnel surrounded the property and he eventually surrendered to

While on scene, investigators observed an area of unearthed dirt that appeared to have been freshly disturbed. In this area, there were tire tracks resembling that of the tractor tires of the tractor located on scene leading up to the freshly disturbed ground this appears to be part of the property of either 1272 or 1132, ACR 2217.

Due to the facts and circumstances, witness interviews and other evidence collected your affiant believes that the victim is deceased due to the actions caused by Williams, and requests the approval of this arrest warrant for
