






OFFICIALS, BOARDS, EMPLOYEES AND PUBLIC RECORDS

"Measurement" means to quantify by means of comparison to a reference standard characteristic of an observable event, occurrence or object.

"Open standard" means a technical standard developed and maintained by a voluntary consensus standards body that is available to the public without royalty or fee.

"Public data set" means a comprehensive collection of interrelated data that is available for inspection by the public in accordance with any provision of the Wisconsin Public Records Laws (Wis. Stats. §§ 19.31-19.37) and the Madison Public Records Ordinance (Sec. 3.70, and is maintained on a computer system by, or on behalf of, an agency. Such term shall include:

1. Any data set or portion thereof to which an agency may deny access pursuant to the public records laws or any other provision of a federal or state law, regulation or local law;
2. Any data set that contains a significant amount of confidential data pursuant to the preceding subsection and where removing such data would impose a financial or administrative burden;
3. Data that reflects the internal deliberative process of an agency or agency component, including but not limited to negotiating positions, future requirements, and recommendations.
