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1 Within that process while that officer open there, 2 he open up his trunk. Nieto was walking down, and, 3 let's say, like -- let's say 100 to 120 --4 approximately 100 to 120 feet away, he was -- I saw him that distance. 5 6 0. I'm sorry. Feet or meters? Α. 7 Feet. 8 Q. Okay. I'm not so much in the meters and -- I use 9 Α. 10 it, but feet, inches person. Sorry. 11 At that point they stopped, opened their 12 doors, officers came out on both sides. Officer on the right-hand side shout out, 22 "stop." Within that moment, approximately some --23 some how much of a second, and fired his first shot, 24 bam; fired second shot, bam; fired a third. Alex 25 Nieto went to his knees. And another fourth.

- Q. You said that you saw Mr. Nieto go to his

- 21 A. Pulling them out.
- Q. Did you see his hands out of his pocket at
- 23 some point?
- A. Just a glimpse moment, because he got
- another shot just immediately after that fourth shot

- 1 and was in his face.
- Q. So you did get a glimpse of his hands? I'm
- 3 sorry. I am trying to clarify.
- 4 A. Not -- I don't think -- I cannot recall his
- 5 hands, like, all the way out of his pocket.

I saw no movements of that. But you never saw him with his hands up, 14 0. did you? 15 16 Α. No, he never made his hands up. 17 0. So you said you thought that there might be 18 shots coming in your direction? 19 Yes, there was a person that to me, I felt 20 maybe it's another officer. It was another -- kind 21 of had me in a baffled state, because I also thought 22 maybe it might be a shooter. So, yes, I was -- there was approximately 23 24 five people -- one, two, three, four, five,

including myself, because from the other car there

I was kind of -- I felt pretty weird that you are going to cuff 8 9 a dead person or a dying person. That I couldn't handle, and I started 10 11 walking, just start walking out of the park then, up 12 the hill where I met that one gentleman, same time. He was giving me what he heard and told me a little, 13 14 and, yeah, I just left the park after that. At any point did you hear any of the 15 officers who were engaged with Mr. Nieto say 16 17 anything to each other? No, I could not really hear from there. 18 You can hear the highway noise, the city noise. 19 20 From that distance, I cannot hear what -- I could just see -- all I could see is the movements and the 21 22 gestures people making. As I say, I did not stay much longer after they handcuffed him. 23 Do you know which officer handcuffed 24 25 Mr. Nieto?

It was only after the news report I heard 1 2 he was hit 16 times or something. For me I cannot I would say he got hit, like, approximately 3 4 10 to 15 times, because there was like so many shots 5 and they all ringing off at the same time. Do you know what -- okay. 6 Q. 7 So when Mr. Nieto fell to his face, do you know where his hands were? 8 9 They seemed to be tucked under him. MR. POINTER: Did you see -- can you repeat your 10 11 answer again? I'm sorry. 12 THE WITNESS: Say he was laying on his hands. BY MS. BAUMGARTNER 13 14 So -- let's see. I'm not sure I asked you this. Forgive me if I did. But which direction 15 16 were you facing when you heard the multiple shots? 17 Α. As I stated before, I was facing in a northwestern direction. 18 19 Okay. Sorry about that. 20 So you were facing towards where the police officer and Mr. Nieto were, or were you facing some 21 22 other direction? I was facing, yes, police officers, 23 24 Mr. Nieto, the park bench, the other police officer 25 up at the eucalyptus tree.

1 MS. BAUMGARTNER: For the record, Mr. Theodore 2 is holding a subpoena. 3 THE WITNESS: I have another, too. BY MR. POINTER 4 5 0. In terms of when the shooting actually took place, during this incident when Mr. Nieto was shot 6 7 and killed, given these maps and your description of where you were at today, is it fair to say you were 8 9 behind the officers as you watched them shoot and kill Mr. Nieto? 10 11 MS. BAUMGARTNER: Objection. Vaque. 12 THE WITNESS: Yes, I was behind the officers. BY MR. POINTER 13 14 0. Now --Behind and in an aerial position as well. 15 Α. 16 0. When you say behind and in an aerial 17 position, do you mean and behind and to the side? Α. Behind and aerial, vertical. I was up 18 19 maybe a hundred, 75 feet. So is it fair to say you were behind and 20 21 above the officers? 22 Α. Behind and above, that's correct. 23 0. Is it fair to say you were essentially 24 looking down at this incident? Yes, I was looking down. 25 Α.
