I now enclose further Advices received from our Legal Advisors relating to a specific letting at 9 Tolka Valley, Balbriggan, Co Dublin in relation to Notice received regarding Planning Acts.

You should ensure that when negotiating on such a Lease that there is absolutely no ambiguity in relation to the user clause viz-a-viz planning permission. If there is doubt the Planning Authorities should be consulted.

Note also Advices given re issue of Fire Certificate and the fact that by altering the premises in any way such Certificate is likely to be invalidated. You should in such a case bring the matter to the attention of your architect/engineer who should liaise with Enforcement Officer.

I understand that Gerry Speiran, Assistant Manager with responsibility for apprenticeships, explained our position to you regarding the fall off in demand for apprentice plumbers. At present we have reduced Apprentice plumbing activity from five classes to two classes, leaving us with spare capacity of one training area within our Finglas Training Centre. In view of this situation we cannot justify the continued renting of Unit 9, Tolka Valley as we no longer require the additional capacity.

Notwithstanding the above situation we are prepared to continue to pay rent on Unit 9 up until 12 May 2003 without prejudice in order to allow you more time to find an alternative tenant.
