Mr. Griego:

This correspondence is the thirty day notice of cancellation of Lease No. GT0402.

As discussed in previous correspondence on February 12, there have been several areas of default by you regarding your lease (No. GT0402) with the State Land Office. As we have not received any communication from you regarding your intent to address these areas of default, please consider this letter as official notice of our intent to cancel the above referenced lease. Per paragraph nine of the lease, you have thirty days to cure these defaults and avoid cancellation.

The lease will be cancelled in thirty days due to the following: the failure to protect the leased property from waste and trespass, the failure to fence the leased property, the unauthorized removal of large rocks from the leased property, the failure to report aforementioned removal to the SLO and the destruction of cultural resources on the leased property.

If all the requirements of the February 12, 2016 letter are met within thirty days, the lease will not be cancelled.

Re: Phil Griego and Lease No. GT0402

Mr. Stranahan:

Pursuant to our discussion on January 28, 2016, this correspondence contains the requirements for Mr. Griego to satisfy the State Land Office regarding fencing, trash clean up, rock theft, the school building and cultural site damage on his grazing lease GT-0402.

- 1. The State Land Office requires Mr. Griego to install 3,070 feet of three strand barbed wire with metal stakes fence to protect the lease from illegal dumping and rock theft. The estimated cost of this fencing is \$4,850.00 to \$6,262.00. A map is attached that indicates the required fencing.
- 2. The State Land Office requires Mr. Griego to clean up the garbage on the lease, including some junked vehicles. This garbage is located mostly near the homes on the northern portion of the lease. We estimate that the cleanup will cost \$3,000.00.
- 3. The State Land Office requires Mr. Griego to pay the State Land Office for the rocks that were removed from the lease. At the very least, Mr. Griego gave permission to others to mine and remove the rocks from the lease. We will accept payment of \$6,000.00 for the rocks from Mr. Griego.
- 4. The State Land Office requires that the abandoned school building be removed and the site cleaned up. The building detracts from the value of the lease and is a safety hazard.
- 5. Finally, Mr. Griego will need to have a cultural damage assessment done on the lease. We noted damage to cultural sites on the lease. The assessment should cost between \$1,000.00 and \$5,000.00 dollars. The assessment will provide Mr. Griego and the State Land Office with a monetary amount of the damage to the cultural sites upon the leased land. This damage amount will also need to be paid by Mr. Griego to the State Land Office.

The fencing, garbage clean up, rock repayment, and school site cleanup will need to be completed by March 17, 2016. The cultural damage assessment will need to be completed and provided to the State Land Office by April 21, 2016.

Pursuant to our meeting on January 28, 2016, Mr. Griego has until February 19, 2016 to accept or reject the offer described in this correspondence. A failure to respond will constitute a rejection of the offer.
