BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned affiant who, after being duly sworn by me on oath stated:

My name is M. Brazelton #191, and I am a peace officer for the Town of Addison, Dallas County, Texas. I, the affiant, have good reasons and do believe that on or about **March 13, 2016**, one (suspect)

Johnson, Ken Dewayne - Black / Male 03/24/80

did then and there in the Town of Addison, Dallas County, Texas commit the offense of: **Murder**, a violation of section 19.02 of the Texas Penal Code, a 1st Degree Felony.

Affiant's belief is based upon the following facts and information which Affiant received from: E. Aguilar #205, a fellow peace officer for the Town of Addison, Dallas County, Texas, who personally participated in this investigation of this alleged offense, providing this information to Affiant, and whose information Affiant believes to be credible.

On March 13, 2016 at approximately 7:00 PM, Farmers Branch Police Officers and Addison Police Officers were dispatched to a shooting, which had just occurred in the [REDACTED], Addison, Dallas County, Texas. Responding Officers arrived at the intersection of Marsh Lane and Spring Valley Road, at which point they made contact with a male, who was later identified as Ken Johnson. Johnson was standing in the roadway (Marsh Lane) while armed with a black semi-automatic pistol when officers contacted him. Officers also contacted two occupants of a red Dodge Challenger. The driver of the challenger was identified as Jose Cruz. It was determined that Cruz was deceased. It was further determined that Cruz' death was caused by being intentionally shot by Johnson with a firearm, a deadly weapon. The passenger of the Challenger was identified as Edgar Rodriguez Arevalo. It was determined Arevalo suffered serious bodily injury in the form of gunshot wounds to his hands and to his head, after being intentionally being shot by Johnson. Arevalo was transported to a hospital for treatment of his injuries.

WHEREFORE, Affiant requests that an arrest warrant be issued for the above accused individual in accordance with the law.

Arevalo was transported to a hospital for treatment of his injuries.
