On 03/17/16 at approximately 4:27 pm, members of the Baltimore County Police Department responded to 6753 Woodley Rd., 21222, for a call for a Cardiac Arrest. Upon arrival they found a Hispanic male in the supine position at the foot of the stairs leading to the second floor. This male was suffering from multiple stab wounds and was pronounced deceased by Baltimore County Medic Miller at approximately 4:32 pm. The victim was identified as Victor Adolfo Castillo Serrano.

The victim was later taken to the OCME where an autopsy was performed by Dr. King. The cause and manner of his death was ruled a Homicide by multiple stab wounds.

The Homicide Unit was contacted to conduct the investigation and Detective Anderson was assigned as the primary investigator. Detective Anderson learned that the victim rented several rooms out from his home located at 6753 Woodley Rd., 21222. A prior tenant was identified as Pablo Aleman, aka "Cubano". According to current tenants, Pablo Aleman moved into the residence approximately three months ago and moved out of the house approximately 2-3 weeks ago.

Detective Anderson learned that earlier in the day, on 03/17/16, Pablo Aleman showed up at the victim's job looking for him. Witnesses at the victim's place of employment stated that the victim identified the person who came looking for him.

as a prior roommate named "Cubano", who needed to get personal possessions from the Woodley Rd. address. There is video surveillance at the victim's place of employment. Pablo Aleman was observed in the surveillance video wearing a pair of burgundy sweatpants with the brand name Hollister printed down the left leg in white letters, a puffy black Polo coat with a hood, and an olive and beige pullover fleece under the coat.

During this investigation a Search and Seizure Warrant was obtained for 6753 Woodley Rd. and signed by the Honorable Judge Jung of the Towson District Court of Maryland. The warrant was served on 3/17/16 at 8:58 pm. During the search the following items were among the items recovered:

1. A pair of burgundy sweatpants with the brand name Hollister printed down the left leg in white letters was recovered from a back yard trashcan. The sweatpants had wet blood on them and were located in a black plastic bag along with other items that were covered with wet blood.
2. Also recovered from the trashcan was a green and beige pullover fleece. An inspection of the fleece revealed possible blood on it.
3. A black puffy Polo coat with a hood was recovered from beneath the victim's bed. The coat was covered in wet blood and had been cut in several places. The cuts on the coat were consistent with the injury placement on the victim.

- The blood covered burgundy sweatpants with the brand name Hollister printed down the left leg in white letters is identical to the pants worn by Pablo Aleman prior to the murder of Victor Serrano, as seen in the video surveillance footage recovered from the victim's place of employment.
- The green and beige pullover fleece stained with possible blood is identical to the green and beige pullover fleece worn by Pablo Aleman prior to the murder of Victor Serrano, as seen in the video surveillance footage recovered from the victim's place of employment.
- The black puffy Polo coat with a hood that was recovered from beneath the victim's bed, covered in wet blood and cut in several places is identical to the black puffy Polo coat worn by Pablo Aleman prior to the murder of Victor Serrano, as seen in the video surveillance footage recovered from the victim's place of employment.

Residents of 6753 Woodley Rd. were shown still photos from the surveillance video as well as single photos of **Pablo Javier Aleman, DOB: 12/12/69** at which
