Upon arrival they found a Hispanic male in the supine position at the foot of the stairs leading to the second floor. This male was suffering from multiple stab wounds and was pronounced deceased by Baltimore County Medic Miller at approximately 4:32 pm. The victim was identified as Victor Adolfo Castillo The victim was later taken to the OCME where an autopsy was performed by Dr. King. The cause and manner of his death was ruled a Homicide by multiple stab wounds. The Homicide Unit was contacted to conduct the investigation and Detective Anderson was assigned as the primary investigator. Detective Anderson learned that the victim rented several rooms out from his home located at 6753 Woodley Rd., 21222. A prior tenant was identified as Pablo Aleman, aka "Cubano". According to current tenants, Pablo Aleman moved into the residence approximately three months ago and moved out of the house approximately 2-3 weeks ago. Detective Anderson learned that earlier in the day, on 03/17/16, Pablo Aleman showed up at the victim's job looking for him. Witnesses at the victim's place of employment stated that the victim identified the person who came looking for him
