To whom it may concern:

I am a financial adviser and have been in business since 1988. At present, I offer advice on mortgages and life assurance and retain a building society agency.

I have advised and acted for Andrew Turner, MP for the Isle of Wight since 2010.

In 2015 the Independent Parliamentary Standards Authority awarded MPs a pay rise of £6,940.00 gross. Mr Turner pays tax at 40%, (disregarding higher NI payments due) this gives a net amount of £4,164.00 per annum. Mr Turner said he would donate this sum to charities and good causes on the Isle of Wight.

I can confirm that I have been given free access to all the relevant documents for Mr Turner's Good Causes Account and have been able to make any checks I wish. Over the course of the year he has paid in over £4,500.00 from his personal account. So as to ensure this is Independent, I have contacted some charities who have acknowledged and been very grateful of the funds they have received.

Mr Turner has also made personal donations during the course of the year which exceed £4,500.00. There have also been other payments into the account, including from a trip to the Houses of Parliament. People who took part were asked to make a charitable donation of £10.00 each to the independent lifeboat services; this is not included in the sum of £4,500.00 donated.

The beneficiaries are all charities or other good causes active on the Isle of Wight; they include the organisations which are listed by Mr Turner on the attached page.

I can therefore confirm that Mr Turner has not only complied with his promise to donate his pay rise to charity, he has exceeded it.

On a personal note, I have been involved in the local community for over forty years. I continue to support many charities and organisations from our office in Ryde where we have displays in our windows, promoting their worthy causes which on average is a minimum of six a year. This year to date, we have been able to support five already.

Personally, I am Treasurer of Headway Isle of Wight and also Vice-Chairman of Vectis Housing Association for which I have been on the board for over twenty-five years.
