(COUNT 1) 21 O.S. 649(B)

DAVID LEE FULPS II, on or about 4/9/2016, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of ASSAULT AND BATTERY UPON A **DETENTION OFFICER**, a Felony, by unlawfully, feloniously, willfully, and without justifiable or excusable cause, knowingly commit an assault and battery upon the person of one Tyler Perry, a detention officer for Tulsa County Sheriff's Office by hitting and contending with him while he was then and there engaged in the performance of his duties as a detention officer,

(COUNT 2) 21 O.S. 649(B)

DAVID LEE FULPS II, on or about 4/9/2016, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of ASSAULT AND BATTERY UPON A **DETENTION OFFICER**, a Felony, by unlawfully, feloniously, willfully, and without justifiable or excusable cause, knowingly commit an assault and battery upon the person of one Jesse Winfield, a detention officer for Tulsa County Sheriff's Office by biting and contending with him while he was then and there engaged in the performance of his duties as a detention officer,

(COUNT 3) 21 O.S. 1760(A)2

DAVID LEE FULPS II, on or about 4/9/2016, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of MALICIOUS INJURY TO PROPERTY - \$1000 **OR MORE**, a Felony, by unlawfully, feloniously, willfully, maliciously and wrongfully, injure and deface certain personal property owned by one Tulsa County Sheriff's Office and not the property of said defendant, to-wit: a computer monitor by then and there charging at officer's station with a chair causing the computer monitor to break with the deliberate and malicious and wrongful intent to injure property of said owner,
