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I was born in a small village in Central Nyanza. My father earned the living for the family by being a cook in European homes. My mother worked on our land to help provide our food. I have four sisters and two brothers.

My father did not have opportunity for much formal education but was eager for his children to obtain as much as possible. He sent me to Ng'iya Intermediate School which is near our home. I was interested in my studies and was the top of my class. I went from the Intermediate School to Maseno High School. I enjoyed all my studies but I was especially keen on Mathematics and Sciences. My father had taught me some English at home and when I continued with this subject in school I found it easy and fascinating. I also joined in many school activities and took leading parts in dramatics, music, sports and debating. I was forced to leave school in my last year due to financial difficulties at home. This was due to the fact that my father got very ill during that period and could not earn money to pay my school fees. Therefore, I was unable to sit for my Cambridge School Certificate.

However, I have continued to educate myself since leaving school by taking courses in secretarial work (typing, shorthand, accountancy), Quantity Surveying and Journalism. I have also furthered my learning by reading extensively on many subjects.

Since leaving school I have worked for various business firms.
