#### **BE IT REMEMBERED:**

That STEVE KUNZWEILER, the duly elected and qualified District Attorney for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, who prosecutes in the name and by the authority of The State of Oklahoma, comes now into the District Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and gives the Court to understand and be informed that:

## (COUNT 1) 21 O.S. 645

FRENCHEL RENEE JOHNSON, on or about 8/13/2016, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of ASSAULT WITH A DANGEROUS WEAPON, a Felony, by unlawfully, feloniously, willfully, wrongfully and intentionally, without justifiable or excusable cause commit an assault on one Toshiba Sabe Brown with a certain and sharp dangerous weapon, to-wit: a kitchen knife, held in the hand of said defendant and used by her to threaten the said Toshiba Sabe Brown with the unlawful and felonious intent then and there to do her bodily harm,

## (COUNT 2) 21 O.S. 644

FRENCHEL RENEE JOHNSON, on or about 8/13/2016, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of ASSAULT & BATTERY, a Misdemeanor, by unlawfully, willfully and wrongfully, commit an assault and battery upon the person of one Toshiba Sabe Brown by then and there spitting her about the face with force and violence and with the unlawful intent to do her corporal hurt and bodily injury,



## (COUNT 3) 21 O.S. 540

FRENCHEL RENEE JOHNSON, on or about 8/13/2016, in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of OBSTRUCTING AN OFFICER, a Misdemeanor, by unlawfully, willfully, knowingly and wrongfully obstruct one Christopher Turner a Tulsa police officer in the performance of his legal duty in assisting in the arrest of one Frenchel R Johnson for the offense of Assault And Battery with a Dangerous Weapon the said defendant well knowing that the said Christopher Turner was an executive officer then and there in the performance of a duty imposed on him by law, to-wit: defendant refused to follow officer's lawful commands to drop the knife,

Contrary to the form of the statutes in such cases made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State.

Said crime being an offense punishable under the laws of this state by imprisonment in the penitentiary. That the said **Frenchel Renee Johnson** was heretofore on 7/31/2007, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Case No.CF-2007-3648, convicted of a Felony, to-wit: the crime of **DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL - 2ND OFFENSE** and sentenced to a term of 4 years. Said crime being an offense punishable under the laws of this state by imprisonment in the penitentiary.
