Dear Dr. Kaye:

This is our Agency's final response to your electronic Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated August 21, 2013. In your request, you sought a copy of the "high priority" email sent to Colonel John Bodgan at Guantanamo on September 7, 2013.

The Joint Task Force-Guantanamo search produced three (3) responsive documents consisting of nine (9) pages. The documents are entitled:

- a. FP Report, dated 07 September 2012
- b. Cultural Advisor E-mail, dated 07 September 2012
- High Priority E-mail, dated 07 September 2012

After a line-by-line review of the responsive documents, located at enclosure 1, the Joint Task Force-Guantanamo determined that portions of information are currently and properly classified in accordance with Executive Order 13526, Section 1.4 (c), which pertains to intelligence activities (including special activities), intelligence sources or methods and Section 1.4 (g), which pertains to vulnerabilities or capabilities of systems, installations, infrastructures, projects, plans, or protection services relating to the national security, which includes defense against transnational terrorism. Release of such information in not permitted under 5 U.S.C. 552 § (b)(1).

Other information was exempted from disclosure by statute, namely 10 USC § 130b, which authorizes protection of the names and their rank, duty addresses and official titles of personnel in overseas, sensitive or routinely deployable units. Thus, this information could not be released under 5 U.S.C. § (b)(3). Other exempted information is considered priviledge as pre-decisional under the deliberative process; under the attorney work product privilege; or under the attorney client privilege, consequently this information is exempted from disclosure under 5 U.S.C. § (b)(5). Finally, release of certain information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of individuals and is accordingly not released under 5 U.S.C. § (b)(6). Redaction of information in these categories were made and marked on the enclosed document. Denial of the redacted information is made pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § (b)(1), (b)(3), (b)(5), and (b)(6) by Commander Joseph Romero, U.S. Navy, Staff Judge Advocate, Joint Task Force-Guantanamo Bay Cuba.

If you are not satisfied with this action, you have the right to appeal to the appellate authority, Ms. Joo Chung, Director of Oversight and Compliance, Office of the Secretary of

Defense, by writing directly to ODCMO Directorate for Oversight and Compliance, 4800 Mark Center Drive, Attn: DPCLTD, FOIA Appeals, Mailbox #24, Alexandria, VA 22350-1700. Your appeal must be postmarked within 90 calendar days of the date of this response. Alternatively, you may also submit your appeal electronically, within 90 calendar days of the date of this response, at the following link: http://pal.whs.mil/palMain.aspx, or email your appeal to OSD.FOIAPolicy@mail.mil. If you use email, please have the words "FOIA Appeal" in the subject of the email. Your appeal should cite case number SC 13-165-S, and be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." A copy of this letter should be enclosed with your appeal.

Concerning your request for removal of the redaction within the report provided under our partial response to FOIA case control number SC 13-063-S (A copy is provided for easy of reference).
