This is your 1st incarceration and at the age 41 you've served 23 years 11 months of a 45 year sentence structure for 2nd Deg Reckless Homicide (20 yrs), Robbery (PTAC) (20 yrs CS), and Aggravated Battery w/u of Dang Wpn (PTAC) (5 yrs CS). At the young age of 17, you and six associates set out to find and beat some Latin Kings. During the course of your mission you beat two boys ages 15 & 17 y/o with a golf club and stole their jackets. One victim died as a result of blunt force trauma to the head and both victims indicated prior to the beatings that they had no gang affiliation. After committing the crime you fled to IL and one of your co actors fled to Mexico; you were extradited back to WI. Prior to the offense you had dealings with Law Enforcement for Criminal Dmg to Property and Battery. You entered the system at a young age and initially had difficulty with misconduct noting one major and 14 minor conduct reports between 1994-1997. You turned things around in 1997 and only received two minor CRs since that time. You've completed all tx needs of Voc Ed-Building Services, AODA 5B, AM, and HSED. You express a great deal of shame regarding your crime and your past. You're the oldest of your siblings and you've strived to guide your siblings away from a criminal lifestyle. Your parents and siblings visit with you and have been a positive support system. You've work hard to prove you're not the same person evidenced by your better decision making, gratitude for the opportunities afforded you, and a commitment to a better life. You achieved minimum custody and transitioned to OCI in October 2013 where you held institution positions with positive reviews. You began working outside the fence in March 2015 on the Garden Crew before earning an opportunity on the Middleton Crew in June 2015. You achieved minimum community custody in June 2015 and began work release at Bruce Company in October 2015. Sgt. Ramos reported you were an excellent worker and received many compliments while working in the community. At the time of last review this Commissioner requested an Interstate Compact. You asked PRC for a transfer to a WCCS site so you could obtain a driver's license in case you're released. You transferred to OCC in July 2016, worked in both food service and at work release, and obtained a driver's license. In addition you satisfied over 3K in owed obligations while also saving 4K to aid your return to the community. Your Interstate Compact is approved for a release to IL to live with your parents. You have a job waiting for you with your cousin's construction company and during the winter slow down you plan to work at a friend's detailing company while also volunteering time at Habitat for Humanity to brush up on your building skills. You appreciate opportunities afforded to you and you've made the most of your incarceration. You maintain you need to make something positive out of this situation for which you're extremely ashamed. You're committed to making up for the pain you've caused others and hope to make a difference by giving back to the community. You want to use your experience to deter others who are on the verge of traveling the same path. You've worked with juveniles while incarcerated and plan to continue doing so in the community by speaking with youth at your sister's church. You entered the system at a young age, turned your life around, completed programming, satisfied all owed obligations, saved money for

release, secured an approved release plan and demonstrated success at multiple minimum community custody sites with work release. After considering the aforementioned information, it's recommended you be afforded a discretionary release on or after 1/24/2017. The IC reporting instructions indicate you should report on 2/1/17. Should this recommendation be approved for 1/24/17 your Social Worker will contact IL to inform them of the finalized release date.

#### COMMISSION COMMENTS

You have served 22 years of a 45 year sentence structure for 1st Degree Reckless Homicide, Armed Robbery, and Agg Battery with use of a dangerous weapon (PTAC). These offenses occurred in 1993, and involved you and six others attacking two young males (ages 15 and 17) with golf clubs, bats, fists and feet, with the intention to take their jackets. The 17 year old victim suffered a fractured skull and died as a result of his injuries. You were 18 years old at the time, you are turning 40 just this month and tearfully expressed the shame you feel for your reckless disregard for others. You were not raised to act out toward others, and your family was and continues to be incredibly supportive. This is your first incarceration, and over the years, conduct has been limited to one major infraction over twenty years ago with other minor reports. There has been no misconduct in over four years and this is expected to continue. All recommended programming is completed. You have transitioned through reduced security, attained minimum in Jun 2013, transferred to OCI in Oct 2013, and recently attained minimum community in June 2015. You have held work assignments on the unit, and in the main kitchen, and most recently received outside the fence approval and worked both on the garden crew and on the Middleton crew. You expressed the pride with your work community assignment, and expressed how valuable this experience. **The Commission supports further work opportunities** to allow you to demonstrate continued efforts toward reducing your risk and to establish some financial resources in the future. There will need to continue to be a period of monitoring at this security classification and in the community. Therefore, given the severity of the offense, that it resulted in the senseless assault on two young men, and ended one of their lives, more time is warranted to address punishment. However, with continued positive conduct, productive use of your time, further community work opportunities, and positive evaluations along the way, all this will assist in reducing your risk to a more reasonable level.

These offenses occurred in 1993, and involved you and six others attacking two young males (ages 15 and 17) with golf clubs, bats, fists and feet, with the intention to take their jackets. The 17 year old victim suffered a fractured skull and died as a result of his injuries. You were 18 years old at the time, and today, tearfully expressed the shame you feel for your reckless disregard for others. This is your first incarceration, and over the years, conduct has been limited to one major infraction with other minor reports. There has been no misconduct in over three years and this is expected to continue. All recommended programming is completed. You have managed to transition through reduced security, attained minimum in Jun 2013, and transferred to OCI in Oct 2013. You have held positions in the main kitchen as well as on the unit, and the Commission encourages you to apply for work assignments with more responsibility. You have also participated in an inmate panel speaking to youths at this location, and continued productive use of your time is encouraged to continue. You came to prison at a young age with little positive life experience; **the Commission would like a period of monitoring at this location, with more responsible work assignments, possibly outside the fence**, to assist in demonstrating risk reduction for the future. If there is success in the aforementioned, the Commission will consider the steps necessary to support further transition and work opportunities in the community. Until then, given the severity of the offense, that it resulted in the senseless assault on two young men, and ended one of their lives, more time is warranted to address punishment, and to work on reducing your risk to a more reasonable level.

Since the time of last review you have made further progress. You were approved for minimum custody and transitioned to OCI in October 2013. You obtained a job in the kitchen and have held that position for four months. The Parole Commission would like to see you afforded the chance to work outside the fence and is endorsing such at this time. The Parole Commission believes you will release well in advance of your MR and would like to see you afforded opportunities to prepare for a transition back into the community. You have made a great deal of progress throughout your incarceration so maintain focus and keep up the good work! Continued positive conduct, serving additional time, and transitioning successfully through reduced custody with work release will aid in mitigating your level of risk. You're proposing to reside in IL with your parents and that will eventually require the approval of an Interstate Compact.

You continue to express a great deal of remorse for your actions and you indicate that you are committed to being a better person which is supported by your actions. **The Parole Commission believes you will release well in advance of your MR and would like to see you afforded the opportunity to transition through reduced custody to prepare for a transition back into the community.** You have made a great deal of progress throughout your incarceration so maintain focus and keep up the good work! Continued positive conduct, serving additional time, and transitioning successfully through reduced custody successfully will aid in mitigating your level of risk. You're proposing to reside in IL with your parents and that will eventually require the approval of your agent.

This is your 1st incarceration and you've served 18 yrs 1 month of the 45 yr sentence structure for 2nd Deg Reckless Homicide (20 yrs), Robbery (PTAC) (20 yrs CS), and Aggravated Battery w/u of Dang Wpn (PTAC) (5 yrs CS). You've completed your tx needs of VE Required, AODA 5B, AM, and HSED; no tx needs remain. A Voc Ed certificate of Building Services was completed at CCI in 1998 and AODA, as well as AM, was completed in 2000 while you were housed OOS in Whiteville, TN. At the young age of 17, you and six associates set out to find and beat some Latin Kings. During the course of your mission you beat two boys ages 15 & 17 y/o with a golf club and stole their jackets. One victim died as a result of blunt force trauma to the head and both victims indicated prior to the beatings that they had no gang affiliation. After committing the crime you fled to IL and had to be extradited back to WI and one of your co actors fled to Mexico; a warrant remains in effect for his arrest regarding this crime. Prior to the offense you already had dealings with Law Enforcement for Criminal Dmg to Property and Battery. You've continued to express remorse for your actions and today you stated, "I felt bad about what I did back then and I continue to feel bad about it today. It is not something I'm proud of. The only thing I can do is make something positive come out of it." Today it was explained that although you're doing everything to demonstrate being a changed person, it does not remove the need to serve the consequences for your actions. One day you will leave prison and be provided the opportunity to become a productive member in the community; but the victim cannot be afforded that opportunity because he lost his life. It is noted that you were a very young person at the time, 17 y/o; but you were old enough to know better and chose to act in a deliberate aggressive manner toward the victims. The Prosecuting Attorney from the case is opposed to release citing the brutal nature of the case and only 35% of the sentence being served thus far. When the recommendation was rendered today you stated, "I just feel like I'm doing something wrong." It was reiterated that you're demonstrating positive adjustment and you've take advantage of the opportunities that have been made available; however moving toward an early release at this time would unduly depreciate the seriousness of taking another person's life. Continued positive conduct, serving additional time, and eventually transitioning through reduced custody successfully will aid in mitigating your level of risk.

You also stated that remaining in contact with family members is important to you, especially your parents and siblings. You do accept responsibility for your actions and expressed proper remorse for the loss of life. You stated that if you were a parent, the loss of a child would be the worst possible situation to endure. Unfortunately, remorse alone is not sufficient to address the severity of your actions and additional punishment must be served. At the young age of 17 you and six associates set out to find and beat some Latin Kings. During the course of your mission you beat two boys ages 15 & 17 with a golf club and stole their jackets. One victim died as a result of blunt force trauma to the head and both victims indicated prior to the beatings that they had no gang affiliation. Prior to the offense you already had dealings with Law Enforcement for Criminal Dmg to Property and Battery but the interventions had little to no impact on your decisions. Today you emphasized that regardless of the deferment decision, you will continue to focus on activities centered on self-improvement, a noteworthy approach. You stated that you have a great desire to help young people to avoid the same mistakes you made. You are nearly 35 yrs old now. You must maintain your positive attitude while you're incarcerated and eventually you will begin your transition back into the community. This is your 1<sup>st</sup> Incarceration for 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Reckless Homicide (PTAC), Armed Robbery (PTAC), and Aggravated Battery with a Dangerous Weapon (PTAC). At the age of 17 you and six accomplices drove around Racine on a "mission" to find and beat Latin Kings. According to the Sentencing Transcripts of your case, you and your accomplices' cornered two boys ages 15 & 17 and confronted them. When they responded that they were not involved in a gang, you proceeded to beat them with a golf club and steal their jackets. You even boasted to your girlfriend about getting the jacket and that you, "beat the fuck out of the mother fucker and got your good licks on that asshole". This crime is horrendous in that you felt entitled to beat two strangers to the point that one of them died from blunt trauma to the head. Prior to this occurrence you were placed in a juvenile diversion program for involvement in Criminal Damage to Property and you had contact with the law for Battery in which you were counseled and released. You have completed recommended programming and express an interest in talking with other individuals about the effects of gang involvement. At this time your release would depreciate the seriousness of the crime you committed and continued confinement is warranted.
