DESCRIBE BRIEFLY WHAT HAPPENED: On the above date and time 4m Tucker had a seizure in pod J-B. 4m Tucker was then transported to the medical unit. 4m Tucker continued to seize and a medical emergency was called in the medical unit, due to 4m Tucker not breathing. The medical staff began CPR, and EMSA was called. EMSA arrived along with the Tulsa Fire Department, and assisted our medical staff with CPR. 4m Tucker was transported to St. John hospital by EMSA and at approximately 1342 hours the time of death was called by the hospital.

Deputy's Summary:

On March 12, 2010 at approximately 1202 hours I was working at the Tulsa County Jail as an escort deputy. A medical emergency was called in pod J8, Detention Officer Take, Detention Officer Johnston, Detention Officer Conley, Detention Officer Burkholder, Sgt. Peters, Nurse Richie, Nurse Jacobs, and myself all responded to j8 and locked down the pod. Inmate Tucker 9600433 was laying at the top of the small steps by the on the pod medical room. On the request of the two nurses on scene Detention Officer Burkholder, Detention Officer Johnston, and I put Inmate Tucker on the gurney and wheeled him to DLM's in house medical facility. While in medical Inmate Tucker raised up under his own power and sat himself onto the exam table. The medical emergency was cleared at that time and I went back to my escort duties. At approximately 1242 hours a second medical emergency was called for the same inmate Tucker. EMSA was called and arrived on scene at approximately 1251 hours and departed with inmate Tucker at approximately 1315 hours. Deputy Scott maintained sight of inmate Tucker during the EMSA ride to Hilcrest hospital as I followed EMSA in a Sheriff van. We arrived at Hilcrest Medical Center at approximately 1336 hours. Inmate Tuckers Time of death was pronounced by Hilcrest Medical Staff at 1342 hours. At

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approximately 1400 Detective Brown (ZEBRA 5, B7589) relieved Deputy Scott and I to go back to David L, Moss to start our reports.

## Person Reporting/Witness Summary:

Witnesses: Sgt Peters;

Sgt Peters states at about 1217 hours she responded to a medical emergency to J8. She states that inmate Tucker was placed on a gurney and take medical. At 1242 hours another medical emergency was called on the same inmate and at 1251 hours Sgt Peters states she responded and assisted medical staff with CPR. At 1315 hours EMSA left with inmate Tucker and at 1343 hours she states she received a phone call from Deputy Scott stating that inmate Tucker was pronounced dead at 1342 hours. Sgt Peters States the jail inspector was notified and reports completed.

Witnesses: Cpl. D'souza

Cpl. D'souza states at approximately 1242 hours when medical emergency was called in medical he witnessed Mrs. Rodgers enter with an AED. Cpl. D'souza states he witnessed Pam Hoisington, nurse Ritchie, Nurse Harrington, Dr. Adusei, Nurse Jacobs, and Nurse Summers present and working on inmate Tucker. Cpl. D'souza States Nurse Ritchie was giving inmate Tucker chest compressions and Dr. Adusei incubate and place an ambu bag over inmate Tuckers mouth. Cpl. D'souza states EMSA arrived at 1251 hours and took control and EMSA left at 1315 hours destine for Hilcrest Medical Center.

Witnesses: Detention Officer Bailey

Detention Officer Bailey states that approximately 1212 hours inmate Tucker was brought into medical, at 1243 hours Nurse Summers ran to main desk and stated medical emergency, and at 1244 hours Sgt. Peters, Cpl D'souza, and Cpl. Darden arrived and Nurse Summers called for EMSA. Detention Officer bailey states that at 1255 hours three EMSA and three firefighters arrive on scene and at 1315 hours departed for Hilcrest.

Witnesses: Detention Officer Bell

Detention Officer bell states at 1243 hours she saw Nurse Summers running and shouting telling Detention Officer Bailey to call a medical emergency. Detention Officer Bell states at 1244 hours Sgt. Peters, Cpl D'souza, and Detention Officer Scroggins and Cpl. Darden arrived and Nurse Summers called for EMSA. Detention Officer Bell states that at 1255 hours three EMSA and three firefighters arrive on scene and at 1315 hours departed for Hilcrest.

At approximately 1244 I was relieved from my post in J11 of the Tulsa County Jail. I was notified that Emsa was on scene and would be transporting an inmate from Medical to a hospital. I was assigned to escort emsa and the inmate. At approximately 1315 emsa transported Inmate Tucker to their vehicle. I waited with them and witnessed emsa doing chest compressions and getting the inmate ready for travel. I rode in the passenger seat of drivers cabin and watched the inmate through the viewing port. We arrived at Hillcrest at approximately 1336 hours and the inmate was brought into a room where hillcrest staff took over. At approximately 1342 hours Hillcrest staff notified me the inmate was pronounced dead at 1342 hours. I notified Sergeant Peters who let me know Detective Brown would be coming to relieve myself and Deputy Golliday. Detective Brown arrived at approximately 1400 hours and relieved us to file our paper work. End of Report.

Nurse Rogers &amp; Nurse Harrington presented &amp; Nurse Rogers instructed to retrieve A&amp;D. Compressions started by this nurse &amp; Dr Adusei &amp; Nurse Harrington administering breaths. A&amp;D intact &amp; "NO SHOCK" advised. Nurse Summers called EMSA. Compressions continued until EMSA arrived &amp; took over care of pt @ approx 1755. 3/12/10 1215- 1315	<p>Walked in treatment room to see if unit needs assistance with medical emergency I/M. I/M lying on side of exam table. Sheld in place by Jacobo LPN. I/M diaphoretic (profusely) &amp; hot to touch. I/M was having intermittent seizure activity &amp; bowel incontinence; in between seizures he would move, briefly, occasionally speaking, combative &amp; attempting to get up from table. Present were also L. Ritchie, RN, L. Summers LPN &amp; myself. At approx 1218, O2 was placed via NC @ 15L. 1-2 people were needed to continually keep I/M on his side, during seizure 2° combativeness &amp; large size of I/M. L. Ritchie notified Dr. Aducci of I/M's condition @ 1225, returning a ativan to administer I/M for seizure. Med given @ 1230 or 1235 (later to order for exact time). Just after ativan was administered for first time, Dr. Aducci entered room. Dr. Aducci what effect ativan had had upon seizure &amp; I/M had another seizure @ that time. Briefly of I/M given to Dr. which included all depression, apnoeosis (being treated) &amp; htn, for which I/M received Heparin (signed &amp; noted in chart). No seizure, htn noted. Suction equipment was set up per Dr. Aducci who rolled I/M onto his back when seizure ended. Second dose of ativan was given @ 1240 by Ritchie. I/M noted to have R in breathing pattern &amp; was biting &amp; bit tongue, concluding airway between 1240-1245. Airway was opened &amp; a tongue blade &amp; tongue blade, &amp; I/M placed in prone position &amp; airway, w/ cheek. I/M then noted by Jacobo LPN to have 0 respiration. N/O pulse was found by myself or Ritchie. At that time, ambu bag was connected to O2; DAN &amp; NSA in room &amp; got AED.</p>
