GE DETAILS PLANS FOR NEW BOSTON HEADQUARTERS CAMPUS

- *World-class campus reflects Company's digital transformation while paying*

FAIRFIELD, Conn. – August 1, 2016 -- GE (NYSE: GE) today released detailed plans for its new global headquarters campus in the Fort Point Channel neighborhood of Boston, Mass. The campus is scheduled to open in two phases in 2018 and will ultimately host approximately 800 GE employees as well as collaborators from the innovation, start-up and learning communities.

“We want our campus to be a global epicenter of innovation, a place to foster relationships among our employees and the greater community,” said Ann R. Klee, head of Boston Development and Operations for GE. “Our headquarters is designed to engage and leverage the talent, technology and work ethic of Fort Point and greater Boston, while also giving back to the community through investment, rehabilitation and an inviting public space.”

GE released the details in a public filing with the Boston Redevelopment Authority (BRA). The filing can be found [here on the BRA's website](#). High resolution renderings are available [here](#).

As part of the construction process, GE will rehabilitate two historic brick buildings and construct a new 12-story building connected by a bridge and a pedestrian-only walkway. The architect for the project is Gensler. The 2.4-acre campus will include:

- **Maker space** for GE employees and co-collaborators, as well as hands-on classroom workspace for tech start-ups, university and high school students and the community to explore Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM);
- **Convener space** for presentations and events for GE and the community;
- **Community work lounge** for visitor reception with a variety of options for employees, customers, and public visitors to use as a “co-work” area;
- **Laboratory** space where GE will to engage 6-12 early stage life sciences companies to develop innovative co-created products;
- **Innovation and exploration center** highlighting the past, present, and future of GE; and
- **Employee community space** including a cafeteria and other amenities.

The new and improved public outdoor space, including an expanded Harborwalk, will be about 1.5 acres and will invigorate access to the area. The campus will also feature a public coffee bar and a bistro-style restaurant.

Continuing its global commitment to the environment, the GE headquarters campus will be in the top quintile of similar buildings using the Energy Use Index and will be LEED version 4. Key “green” features include encouragement of public transportation, walking or biking for employees and visitors (the site will have only 30 parking spots), reuse of existing buildings, a rooftop solar system, and green, vegetated roof areas. In addition, given its proximity to the Fort Point Channel, the buildings will be resilient to sea level rise by raising the ground floors and critical systems, as well as landscape design.

The project is intended to be completed in two phases. The first phase of construction includes preservation and rehabilitation of the existing brick buildings, to begin in the 4th Quarter of 2016. The anticipated occupancy of the brick buildings will be in the 1st Quarter of 2018. The second phase of construction will begin in the 1st Quarter of 2017 with

occupancy of the new building anticipated later in 2018.

“We are excited to present these plans today and will continue to work closely with the neighborhood, city and state to move forward together,” said Klee. “GE expects our new HQ will transform the existing, unused site into a hub of technology, innovation, and intellectual stimulation as well as become a new meaningful destination on the City’s Harborwalk,” she said.

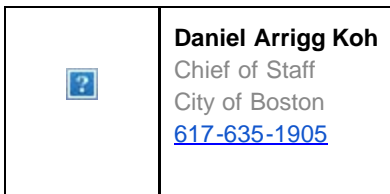

Mobile treatment and alerts, anti-stigma innovations among top winners at Opioid Epidemic Hack-a-thon

BOSTON – September 12, 2016 – As the opioid addiction crisis continues to escalate across Massachusetts and the U.S., the [GE Foundation](#) and [Massachusetts General Hospital \(MGH\) Global Health](#) convened over 220 global health innovators and experts at District Hall in Boston at the [Opioid Epidemic Challenge Summit Hack-a-thon](#). The event, held September 9-11th, challenged participants to create health innovations that can address the prevention, treatment and recovery of opioid addiction.

Participants from a wide variety of backgrounds and skills sets pitched over 70 problems from the field, formed cross-disciplinary teams and presented 18 innovations. A total of five \$1,000 prizes were given to winning teams in the following categories:

- **The Innovation Award:** [Team RxReturn](#) – a notification system that reminds patients to dispose of expired medications through label, light, and text messages.
- **The Anti-Stigma Award:** [Team Ally](#) – a social innovation that de-stigmatizes opioid use and ~~improves overdose response through~~ [enables community responders to make naloxone quickly available when and where it is needed.](#) ~~immediate availability of naloxone, an indicator pin and an access strategy.~~
- **The Tech Solution Award:** [Team ReadyACCESSviaSMS](#) – an anonymous, SMS-based system that increases access to life-saving resources and information.
- **The Treatment On-Demand Award:** [Team MATmobile](#) – a mobile van with treatment-on-demand for those struggling with opioid use disorder.
- **The Community Building Award:** [Team The 3rd Place](#) – a meeting and activity space that acts as a “hub” for those in recovery and offers a safe, welcoming environment.

In addition, the GE Foundation will award \$10,000 to the team that makes the most progress 90 days after the hack-a-thon, along with business acceleration support through the [CAMTech Innovation Platform](#).

The event opened with an Opioid Epidemic Challenge Summit, a series of panel discussions and keynote speeches from 25 distinguished speakers from clinical, government, law enforcement and public policy sectors.

“Opioid addiction is an isolating issue, and one that is associated with a very strong stigma,” said Governor Charlie Baker, who gave one of the morning’s opening remarks. “The more we can do to deal with the stigma, the better off we will be.”

To reinforce this notion, hack-a-thon participants heard personal accounts from [family members of those with substance use disorder and](#) several individuals in recovery, including former NBA and Boston Celtics player Chris Herren, who shared his own personal story of addiction and recovery.

Other speakers included Director of the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy, Michael Botticelli, United States Chief Technology Officer Megan Smith, and Massachusetts Secretary of Health and Human Services Marylou Sudders.

“The story of recovery is a powerful one,” said Botticelli. “It can shatter people’s misconceptions about you and about substance use disorder. The good news is we have the power to help change this.”

Over the next 48 hours, hack-a-thon participants worked around the clock to develop projects that ranged from mobile apps that help improve access to treatment to wearables that can monitor and detect overdoses and automatically dispense appropriate naloxone dosages.

“This was my first hack-a-thon and I really didn’t know what to expect,” said Jessica Moreno, a member of the winning team Ally. “I originally signed up to be a mentor, but I was so inspired and encouraged by everyone and all of the hacking and innovating, that I joined a team. This was truly a fulfilling weekend and a wonderful experience that I am so glad to have been a part of.”

The opioid epidemic has hit particularly hard in the state of Massachusetts, where 1,379 deaths in 2015 were attributable to a fatal dose of heroin or prescription opioid overdose. That reflects nearly four people per day statewide.

This event is part of GE Foundation’s five-year, \$50 million philanthropic commitment to the Greater Boston community, \$15 million of which will be dedicated to health efforts, increasing access to health for the underserved, particularly those patients requiring care for addictions and behavioral health, and increasing training for specialty care.

“I anticipated this weekend being an energetic and innovative event focused on data-driven solutions, but I quickly learned it was more personal than that,” said David Barash, Executive Director of the Global Health Portfolio and Chief Medical Officer at the GE Foundation “The [stories and](#) innovations that came out of this weekend [focused-highlighted access to treatment on demand, more on](#) community, [connect](#)~~ednessions~~ and obliteration of ~~the~~ stigma.”
