### Level I – Site-based, early in the process (Pre SARB/SART), no outside agency assistance

Phone calls and/or Home Visits  
Class schedule change, modified day

P.M. Intervention – detention, community service  
Saturday School  
SPED Assessment  
504 Plan Development  
Nutrition Services  
Administrator Conference  
Saturday School/Detention

### Level II – Site driven, mid process (SART possible), may involve outside agency support

Boys and Girls Clubs  
Teen Parents-Cal Safe  
Parenting classes; Parent Project, Triple P, United Parents  
LGBTQ Resources  
District Programs – ie Breakthrough (CVUSD)  
Migrant/Homeless/Foster Support Services – VCOE  
Transportation  
SART Contract

### Level III – Intensive services involving outside agencies and/or change of placement

Outside Agency Referral - City Impact/Interface  
DAT/Substance Abuse referral  
Public Health/Medical/Nurse referral  
VCBH Referral including: STAR/RISE programs  
SPED Placement  
Change of schools / Alternative Education Placement / HHT/ISP  
ISES referral  
SARB Referral Contract and possible citation
