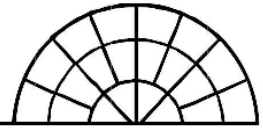

Greetings, I write to inquire whether your office also represents the Mayor's spokesperson, Jeff Reading. As you are aware, Mr. Reading concluded, and publicly asserted, that my client's allegations are politically motivated within about one (1) hour of the Complaint filing on Thursday, April 6, 2017 at 1:30 p.m. Mr. Reading must have coordinated with Mayor Murray in this regard. We would like to explore Mr. Reading's communications with Mayor Murray and the basis for this expeditious conclusion. Obviously, the Mayor's campaign should not be disseminating information to the public about these allegations without proof and/or foundation. Please know that we will depose *everyone* that makes these sorts of comments to the public to find out the basis, and will need vivid clarity as to who you represent.

Enclosed you will find the subpoena and notice to depose Mr. Reading at my office on Thursday, April 20, 2017 at 1:30 p.m. Please know that I do not believe in unilaterally scheduling depositions, or determining locations. This notice is merely a placeholder. After you confirm whether you represent Mr. Reading, we can discuss the timing of the deposition. We would be happy to move the location to your office, if preferred.

Please also advise if formal service of process is required. We await your response. Thank you.
