AFFIDAVIT

I, Bartlett J. Ledbetter, #688, hereinafter referred to as your affiant, am a duly qualified peace officer employed by the City of Fresno, Fresno Police Department (FPD). I have been employed as a FPD Police Officer for over 23 plus years. My current assignment is a Detective with the Violent Crime Bureau, Homicide Unit, which has been my assignment since April 2014. This is my second assignment to the Homicide Unit in a period of six years. My first four year tour was focused on cold case homicides and Officer-Involved-Shootings. In the past 22 plus years, my prior assignments included Patrol; Field Training Officer; MAGEC (gang) Detective; Neighborhood Policing Officer; DCST Tactical Officer; Cold Case Sexual Assault and Homicide; and Night Detective.

I have received training related to criminal investigations, including training related to homicide and suspicious death investigations, officer involved shooting investigations, interview and interrogation and other investigative related training. I have investigated or assisted with the investigations of numerous violent crimes, including but not limited to homicides, gang shootings, stabbings, other felony assaults, as well as robberies, carjacking, kidnappings, suspicious deaths and officer involved shootings.

Having been first duly sworn, I hereby depose and say that I have probable cause to believe, and that I do believe that a violation of section 187(a) of the California Penal Code, a felony, was committed by Suspect KORI ALI MUHAMMAD during the timeframe of 23:09 -23:10 hours, April 13,, 2017. The shooting victim or DECEDENT is CARL WILLIAMS. The following paragraphs document mine and my fellow officers' investigation of Fresno Police Department (FPD) Homicide case number 17-024325; and establish probable cause for the issuance of this search warrant.

On 04-13-2017, at 23:11 hours, per Fresno PD Event 17-AO0622 (Homicide Case No. 17-024325), FPD Dispatch received numerous 911 calls regarding a shooting victim on the ground in front of the Motel 6, 4245 N. Blackstone Avenue, Fresno CA.

Minutes after the above 911 calls, FPD patrol officers and American Ambulance personnel arrived at the above motel and found unconscious shooting victim CARL WILLIAMS on the ground in front of the motel office. He had been shot three or more times (front, back and side). He was subsequently transported to Community Regional Medical Center

- 1 (CRMC)/Emergency Room. Unfortunately, the CRMC medical staff could not save
- 2 WILLIAMS' life. He was declared dead at 00:55 hours, 04-14-2017.
- 3 Per motel staff and security personnel, the occupants of Room 213 were being evicted
- 4 because an unknown African-American male with dread locks refused to register or pay the
- 5 extra visitor fee. The registered occupant of Room 213 was identified as LISA RENE
- 6 MARTIN. She too refused to pay the extra fee and started cursing the motel clerk.
- 7 DECEDENT WILLIAMS, a contracted security company employee, responded to the motel
- 8 to help another security guard in the above eviction. While DECEDENT was talking to IP
- 9 MARTIN outside the office and explaining the motel's rules, the above unknown African-
- 10 American male suspect pulled out a revolver from his waistline and without any provocation
- 11 shot DECEDENT three or more times. The shooting (murder) was in cold blood. After
- shooting DECEDENT, the above shooter fled from the motel running westbound into a county
- 13 island.
- 14 The above shooting was captured in its entirety by the motel security cameras. The high
- definition camera footage captured the shooter's face, clothing and revolver. It also captured
- 16 IP MARTIN witnessing the shooting and trying to leave the motel with suspected evidence.
- 17 As stated, IP LISA RENEE MARTIN tried to flee the motel with clothing and other unknown
- 18 items, but was stopped by hotel security and a civilian witness. She told the witness and
- 19 security guard that she was not involved in the shooting and did not know the shooting
- 20 suspect. She subsequently stated the shooting suspect was her daughter' friend.
- 21 Unable to leave, IP MARTIN returned to Room 203 and refused to open it for arriving
- 22 officers. The motel door was kicked in and IP MARTIN was taken into custody for PC 32
- 23 after failing to comply with officers' orders and refusing to identify the shooter by name or
- 24 destination. She told the arresting officers to go fuck themselves and she was not talking.
- 25 Area canvassing failed to locate shooter or firearm. With IP MARTIN's help, the shooter
- 26 escaped the police dragnet and is currently considered armed and dangerous.
- 27 Based on a separate signed search warrant, FPD/SVB Detectives entered Room 213 and
- 28 located the shooter's blue colored backpack. Inside the backpack, officers located four
- 29 revolver speed loaders with live .357 caliber bullets. In addition, the above backpack
- 30 contained documents with the name KORI ALI MUHAMMAD, DOB: 03-21-1978. After
- 31 comparing S-MUHAMMAD's DMV and social media photographs with the motel's security
- 32 camera footage, there was no doubt S-MUHAMMAD is the murderer.
- 33 The information we are looking for is outlined in Attachment B. Specifically, we want to
- 34 download the two SAMSUNG cellular phones belonging to S-KORI ALI MUHAMMAD and IP

1 LISA RENEE MARTIN, and MARTIN's SAMSUNG Tablet. We want to search for any and all 2 messages, photographs, videos, emails, or texts in either S-KORI ALI MUHAMMAD's or IP 3 LISA RENEE MARTIN identified phones or Tablet. We hope the downloads will (1) identifies 4 S-KORI ALI MUHAMMAD's and IP LISA RENEE MARTIN's states of mind: (2) threats given or perceived; (3) emotions like anger or fear of imminent threat or death; (4) desires to hurt or 5 6 protect one self, family members or others; (5) seeking help from family members or 7 unknown others. Did Suspect KORI ALI MUHAMMAD or IP LISA RENEE MARTIN use their 8 cellular phones or the SAMSUNG Tablet to contact family or friends about the homicide? 9 Who are S-KORI ALI MUHAMMAD's and IP LISA RENEE MARTIN's phone contacts? These contacts, when identified (and contacted by Detectives) might provide additional 10 insight into the minds of Suspect KORI ALI MUHAMMAD and IP LISA RENEE MARTIN; to 11 12 include information on the family or other social dynamics which concur or differ from future suspect interrogations/statements, or current witness statements. These contacts might 13 14 provide additional evidence to this case.

As of this writing, Suspect KORI ALI MUHAMMAD is wanted for PC 836/187(a). He is considered armed and dangerous. IP LISA RENEE MARTIN was arrested for PC 32. She has refused to cooperate with the police regarding the homicide which she witnessed or identify the shooter or his possible destination. . She attempted to flee the crime scene with suspected evidence before being stopped by civilians and forced to return to the motel room which she shared with Suspect KORI ALI MUHAMMAD prior to the homicide. She also refused to identify or cooperate with the police in identifying the shooter (MUHAMMAD) prior to his backpack being found in the motel room which she controlled.

In summary, I am requesting judicial permission to have only one person (DOJ or FPD IT technician, or a Homicide Detective) download the two SAMSUNG cellular phones and Tablet as identified in Attachments A, B and this Affidavit, using the most current and updated Celle-Brite technology and software, for the purpose of obtaining uniformed extraction reports, (with correct UTC-7 times) which thus can be researched and inspected by assigned FPD detectives and/or assistant District Attorneys for court usage using an internal search engine (UFED reader).

In today's world, cellular telephones are used to place phone calls, text messages or send photographs, videos or emails to one or more parties. Cellular telephones and tablets are small hand-held computers which contain valuable evidence such as photographs, telephone numbers, text messages, etc., which can help homicide; gang and violent crime detectives identify motives (and physical evidence) behind criminal activities.

As required by PC 1524.1 (d), those items that are within the scope of this warrant will be 1 2 copied and retained by the undersigned or the District Attorney's Office. FPD and/or the DA's office will also seal and discard any information from the devices that is unrelated to the objective of the warrant and does not fall within the scope of Attachment B, and will not further review said information absent an order from the Court. If no evidence of criminal activity is discovered relating to the seized property and associated peripherals, the device/s will be returned to the owner/s after conferring with the DA's office. Once this warrant is signed and the two SAMSUNG cellular phones and tablet are downloaded or extracted, S-KORI ALI MUHAMMAD and IP LISA RENEE MARTIN will be officially notified of said downloads immediately or within three days per PC 1546.2(a). The notifications will be done via registered mail, or subsequent arrest in the case of S-MUHAMMAD. Per PC 1546.2(a), the law enforcement agency servicing this warrant must notify the target of the warrant contemporaneously with the service of the warrant unless an order delaying notification is granted. At this time, I do not see a reason to delay notification. Night Service is not requested. Based on the above, good cause being shown therefore, and the same is brought before this Magistrate or retained subject to the order of the court, or of any court in which the offense(s) in respect to which the seized property is triable pursuant to Section 1536 of the California Penal Code. - 2. All location data during leading up to 04-13-2017 (homicide), and the period of time between the homicide and the date and time of seizure (04-14-2017). Location data may be stored as GPS locations or cellular tower connection data. Location data may be found in the metadata of photos and social networking posts, Wi-Fi logs, and data associated with installed applications.
- 3. All photographic/video/audio data and associated metadata leading up to the 04-13-2017 homicide, and the period of time between homicide and the two SAMSUNG cellular phones' and tablet's date/time of seizure (04-14-2017/05:00 hours).
- 4. All internet history for the dates above, including cookies, bookmarks, web history, and search terms leading up to 04-13-2017/Time: 23:10 hours (homicide), and time period between the homicide and the cellular phones' and tablet's seizure date/time (02-04-2017/05:00 hours)
- 5. All indicia of ownership and control for both the data and cellular device, such as devices' identification and setting data, address book/contacts, social network posts/updates/tags, Wi-Fi network tables, associated wireless devices (such as known Wi-Fi networks and Bluetooth devices), associated connected devices (such as for backup and syncing), stored passwords, user dictionaries.
- 6. The device and purchased and free phone applications (or Apps) assigned to S-KORI ALI MUHAMMAD's and IP LISA RENEE MARTIN's respective SAMSUNG cellular phones and tablet.
- Investigating officers are authorized, at their discretion to conduct an offsite search of the two seized SAMSUNG cellular phones and tablet for the property described. Investigating officers and those agents acting under the direction of the investigating officers are authorized to access all data on the two seized cellular phones and tablet to determine if the data contains the items described above. If necessary, investigating officers are authorized to employ the use of outside experts, acting under the direction of the investigating officers, to access and preserve data on the cellular and tablet devices. Those items that are within the scope of this warrant may be copied and retained by investigative officers.
- As required by California Penal Code 1524.1 (d), any information obtained through the execution of this warrant that is unrelated to the objective of the warrant shall be sealed and shall not be subject to further review, use or disclosure absent an order from the Court.

If no evidence of criminal activity is discovered relating to the three seized cellular phones (and associated applications), the cellular phones will be returned to evidence, or to their respective owners.

With respect to the two SAMSUNG cellular phones and Tablet, the peace officers are authorized to transfer the booked evidence to a Law Enforcement Agency location prior to commencing the search of those items. Furthermore, said search may continue no more than 90 days upon issuance of this search warrant, to the extent necessary to complete the search on the two SAMSUNG cellular telephones and tablet.

Once this warrant is signed and the two SAMSUNG cellular phones and Tablet are downloaded via Celle-Brite equipment or other, S-KORI ALI MUHAMMAD and IP KORI RENEE MARTIN will be "officially" notified of said downloads immediately or within three days per PC 1546.2(a). S-MUHAMMAD will be notified subsequent his arrest for PC 187(a). The official notifications will be done via registered mail or in person.

NOTE: When her SAMSUNG cellular phone and Tablet were seized, IP LISA RENEE MARTIN (not S-KORI ALI MUHAMMAD) was advised that we (the Fresno Police Department Homicide Detectives) would be downloading her cellular phone and tablet found on her person subsequent her arrest for PC 32 at the motel.

Under the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act, Penal Code section 1546 ET. Seq., the target of the investigation must be notified by law enforcement contemporaneous with the service of a Search Warrant for electronic communication information. Notice with reasonable specificity of a nature of the investigation and copy of the warrant or written statement setting forth facts giving rise to an exigency must be provided contemporaneously with the warrant or, in the case of exigent circumstances within three (3) days after obtaining the information. Pursuant to Penal Code section 1546.2(b) (1), if the courts finds there is reason to believe that notification will cause an adverse result, this court has the authority to extend delayed notification to the target of this investigation for up to 90 days and shall issue the order only for a period of time that the court finds that notification will cause an adverse result. Penal Code section 1546 (b) defines adverse result as: danger to life or physical safety of an individual; flight from prosecution; destruction of or tampering with evidence; intimidation of potential witnesses; and serious jeopardy to an

investigation or undue delay of a trial. The Federal Electronic Privacy Act, 18 U.S.C 2701 ET. Seq. and the California Public Utilities Commission also stipulate notification from the electronic communication service provider to the subscriber of law enforcements request for the provider's records of the subscribers account and/or device. A 90 day delayed notification request can also be requested by law enforcement if proof of adverse result can be shown. 18 U.S.C 2705 defines an adverse result which is congruent with the definitions of Penal Code section 1546 (a) stated above.
