Dear Mr. Klippenstein:

This responds to your request under the Freedom of Information Act, dated November 06, 2015. Therein you requested information concerning any and all Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) records, manuals, policies and/or legal guidance that were prepared, received, transmitted, collected and/or maintained by the DIA regarding 2013 Egyptian coup AKA Egypt coup. I apologize for the delay in responding to your request. DIA continues its efforts to eliminate the large backlog of pending FOIA requests.

A search of DIA's systems of records located 20 documents (108 pages) responsive to the subject of your request. Of these, 19 documents (102 pages) have been referred to another government agency for their review and direct response to you as they did not originate with DIA.

Upon review, it has been determined that all substantive portions of the remaining document must be withheld in full from disclosure pursuant to the FOIA. The withheld portions are exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(1) of the Freedom of Information Act and Executive Order 13,526. Exemption 1 applies to information properly classified under the criteria of Executive Order 13526.
