[PROPOSED] ORDER

This matter came before the Court for a hearing on February 14, 2017, on Plaintiffs' Motion for Supplemental Relief under Wis. Stat. § 806.04(8) or, Alternatively, for Sanctions under Wis. Stat. § 785.04. The Plaintiffs, Kathleen Papa and Professional Homecare Providers, Inc. ("Plaintiffs"), appeared by Attorneys Diane M. Welsh and Susan M. Crawford of Pines Bach LLP. The Defendant, the Department of Health Services ("Department"), appeared by Assistant Attorney General Christopher Blythe of the Wisconsin Department of Justice.

Pursuant to its authority under Wis. Stat. §§ 806.04(8) and 808.07(2)(a)3., the Court hereby GRANTS the Plaintiffs' Motion for Supplemental Relief. To restate and give effect to the declaratory judgment and injunction previously entered by this Court, the Court orders:

The Department of Health Services shall not issue a notice of intent to recover
 Medicaid payments to, or otherwise recoup funds from, a Medicaid provider

if the provider's records verify that the services were provided and the

provider was paid an appropriate amount for such services, notwithstanding

that an audit identified other errors or noncompliance with Department

policies or rules;

2. The Department of Health Services shall not further any agency action,

including an administrative proceeding, currently underway in which the

Department seeks to recoup Medicaid payments from a Medicaid provider, if

the provider's records verify that the services were provided and the provider

was paid an appropriate amount for such services, notwithstanding that an

audit identified other errors or noncompliance with Department policies or

rules; and

3. The Department of Health Services shall pay the Plaintiffs' costs and

attorneys' fees incurred for prosecuting this Motion.
