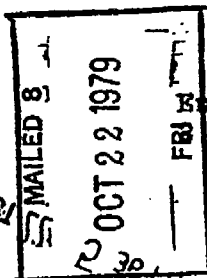

Result of examination

As previously reported in the FBI Laboratory report dated September 28, 1979 (FBI Laboratory Numbers 90830010 S RQ TR, 90831023 S RQ TR, 90904074 S RQ), blond pubic hairs were found on the specimen Q12 trousers, one brown pubic hair was found on the specimen Q1 trousers, and one brown head hair fragment was found on the specimen Q24 cloth and twine. These hairs were compared to the hairs of WIENEKE, specimens K9 and K10, and to the hairs of PHILLIPS, specimens K13 and K14. The above-mentioned pubic hairs are dissimilar to the pubic hairs of WIENEKE and PHILLIPS and could not be associated with these sources. The above-mentioned head hair fragment microscopically matches the head hairs of PHILLIPS. Accordingly, this hair either originated from PHILLIPS or from another Caucasian individual whose head hairs exhibit the same microscopic characteristics as the head hairs of PHILLIPS. This head hair is dissimilar to the head hairs of WIENEKE and could not be associated with WIENEKE.

It is pointed out that hair comparisons do not constitute a basis for positive personal identification.

Grouping tests conducted on specimens K15 and K16 disclosed that GEORGE TED PHILLIPS belongs to blood group "A" and is a secretor. Specimen K11 was grouped as "A." Saliva grouping tests conducted on K12 did not disclose the presence of any blood group substances.

Specimens K9 through K16, the ALSO SUBMITTED item, and the items listed in the above-mentioned report, specimens Q1 through Q24 and K1 through K5, are being returned to the Milwaukee Office under separate cover by registered mail.
