

# ST. LOUIS CITY PUBLIC OPINION 2017

Survey conducted September 29 through September 30, 2017. 1,072 likely St. Louis General Election voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2018 General Election. Margin of Error is +/-3.2% with a 95% level of confidence. Margins of Error within specific demographics (crosstabs) is significantly higher due to smaller sample size. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of Missouri Scout.
