Mr. Williams,

Seminole County Public Schools was sent a public record request on January 4, 2012 concerning teacher and student records for one of our schools, Seminole Virtual Instruction Program. This is a vendor-provided program, explained below.

During the course of this records request, information was uncovered that has raised some concerns and we are currently trying to determine the breadth and depth of the issue.

Background:

Each district is required to operate a Virtual Instruction Program. This is a full-time virtual school program and districts must select a provider approved by the state Department of Education. Currently those providers are Connections Academy and K12, LLC. Seminole County Public Schools held a Request for Proposal in the spring of 2009 and selected K12, LLC as our vendor for Seminole Virtual Instruction Program for grades Kindergarten through 12.

August/September 2009

As the virtual program began, K12 struggled to provide teachers for the courses our high school students required for graduation.

In response to this issue, K12 employee Patty Betoni called to ask if K12 could have a non-FL certified teacher teach the students and then allow a Florida certified teacher to sign off on them. This is referred to as having a “teacher of the class” (that is non certified) and a “teacher of record” (that is certified). In this way, they can use any teacher to teach, but have a certified teacher listed as the “official” teacher when reported to the state.

The response to K12 from the staff of Seminole Virtual Instruction Program was that this did not seem to be allowed according to the new virtual school statute, but that a second opinion would be requested from the Executive Director for High Schools for Seminole County Public Schools, Mr. Walt Griffin.

See Exhibit 1, two emails referring to the questioning of Mr. Griffin, his answer of, “no”, and the offer to use Seminole County teachers that were certified.

See Exhibit 2, Florida Statute section 1002.45 concerning the requirement to use FL certified teachers, and the changes to that law since 2009 to present.

October 2009

In October and February of each school year, schools report FTE (Full Time Equivalent) data to the Department of Education. This student data identifies grade levels, courses, teachers and other demographic data for the purposes of reporting student attendance to the state for funding. Seminole County requires that all teachers sign class rolls, verifying that the students listed on the rolls were their students for the dates in question.

In October 2009, class rolls were sent to K12 containing the lists of students enrolled during the October survey period (referred to as Survey 2). These lists also contained the names of teachers that K12 had reported were teaching the students.

Shortly after sending these class rolls, staff at Seminole Virtual Instruction Program received a copy of an email sent from one K12 employee (Laura Creach) to another (Julie Frein) indicating that the company was utilizing a “teacher of class” and “teacher of record” system. Ms. Creach then questioned the practice, acknowledging that this was not allowed in Florida, and reported that teachers were being given lists of students that they did not teach. This email also references faxes from teachers claiming to have taught Seminole County students but these teachers’ names did not appear on any list of teachers provided by K12 up to that point in time.

See Exhibit 3, an email detailing the information above. Portions highlighted for clarity.

Following this email, K12 and SVIP held a phone conference to reiterate that the company was not allowed to use non Florida certified teachers to teach students and then report the students under a certified teacher’s name. This was in violation of the law and in opposition to conversations that had already been held on the topic. The company promised to tighten up their practices.

2009 - 2011

During the two years following, Seminole Virtual Instruction Program experienced flurries of teacher name changes at the last minute during survey periods. However, K12 always sent lists signed by certified teachers.

January 2012

On January 4, 2012 Seminole Virtual Instruction Program was sent a Public Records Request for information regarding FTE surveys and teacher information from 2009 to present. During preliminary gathering of information for this request, an email was forwarded (on January 18, 2012) to a staff member of Seminole Virtual Instruction Program by a former K12 teacher. This email contains the following request from K12 management (Samantha Gilormini) to K12 teachers:

- That the teachers sign the enclosed class rolls for Seminole Virtual Instruction Program
- That the teachers *may see students on these rolls that are not theirs, but to sign anyway, and the students were appearing on their list due to certification issues*
- *That virtual school permits any teacher to teach any student but Florida districts “like” to have a certified teacher*

Attached to this email was the list of students for teachers to sign. One K12 teacher, Amy Capelle, responded that she had reservations about signing the form, and in a second email indicated that, of the 112 student entries listed on the form for her to sign, only seven were actually her students. Ms. Capelle refused to sign the form.

See Exhibit 4, an email from Samantha Gilormini a K12 employee (the same “Sam” that is referenced in the email string from 2009) to K12 teachers and email responses from Amy Capelle to other K12 employees

See Exhibit 5, the class rolls for Amy Capelle listing 112 student entries, with the seven that were actually hers highlighted.

K12 contacted SVIP staff members on March 2, 2011 providing the signed class rolls. We were advised at that time that two teachers were “not available” to sign the class roll and they had been signed by other K12 staff members. Amy Capelle did go on maternity leave February 25, 2011, but that was after the February 18, 2011 deadline to sign the form. Her form was signed by a K12 staff member, Gila Tuchman on February 25, 2011. This is the same supervisor Ms. Capelle advised that she could not sign the form as the data was not accurate.

See Exhibit 6, the email sending the class rolls from Samantha Gilormini and the second page of the faxed student class roll for Amy Capelle’s class, signed by Gila Tuchman.


In Closing

The use of Florida certified teachers is required by Florida Statute and we have cause for concern over the use of non certified teachers by K12, LLC. Since K12 uses the same teachers across the state in virtual instruction programs, this issue may reach far beyond the borders of Seminole County.

Exhibit 2 – Florida Statutes concerning Virtual Instruction Programs and the certification of teachers:

2009

Section 11. Section 1002.45, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1002.45 School district virtual instruction programs.—

(1) PROGRAM.—

(a) For purposes of this section, the term:

1. “Approved provider” means a provider that is approved by the Department of Education under subsection (2), the Florida Virtual School, or a franchise of the Florida Virtual School.

2. “Virtual instruction program” means a program of instruction provided in an interactive learning environment created through technology in which students are separated from their teachers by time or space, or both, and in which a Florida-certified teacher under chapter 1012 is responsible for at least:

a. Fifty percent of the direct instruction to students in kindergarten through grade 5; or

b. Eighty percent of the direct instruction to students in grades 6 through 12.

In 2010-11 there were no changes to the section concerning the use of Florida-certified teachers.

In 2011-12, there was a shift in location of the information concerning certification, detailed below and showing the strike from the original position in number (1) as it was in 2009-10 and 2010-11 and highlighting the new position in number (2) for 2011-12. The requirement to use FL certified teachers remains the same.

Section 4. Section 1002.45, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

1002.45

School district Virtual instruction programs.—

(1) PROGRAM.—

(a) For purposes of this section, the term:

1. “Approved provider” means a provider that is approved by the Department of Education under subsection (2), the Florida Virtual School, a franchise of the Florida Virtual School, or a community college.

2. “Virtual instruction program” means a program of instruction provided in an interactive learning environment created through technology in which students are separated from their teachers by time or space, or both, and in which a Florida-certified teacher under chapter 1012 is responsible for at least:

a. Fifty percent of the direct instruction to students in kindergarten through grade 5; or

b. Eighty percent of the direct instruction to students in grades 6 through 12.

(2) PROVIDER QUALIFICATIONS.—

(a) The department shall annually publish online provide school districts with a list of providers approved to offer virtual instruction programs. To be approved by the department, a provider must document that it:

1. Is nonsectarian in its programs, admission policies, employment practices, and operations;

2. Complies with the antidiscrimination provisions of s. 1000.05;

3. Locates an administrative office or offices in this state, requires its administrative staff to be state residents, requires all instructional staff to be Florida-certified teachers under chapter 1012, and conducts background screenings for all employees or contracted personnel, as required by s. 1012.32, using state and national criminal history records;
