The University **FOR** Portland is a 2-month social impact experience where students are challenged to widen their perspectives to the realities of homelessness, learn effective social innovation techniques, and propose support strategies to help address this issue.

Requirements

- 1. Student groups must have at least 3 students and no more than 7 students.
- 2. Each student group must represent at least 3 different colleges on campus by majors (College of Arts and Sciences, School of Education, School of Engineering, School of Business, and the School of Nursing).
- 3. Each Student Group must propose and execute an immersion experience that fosters understanding and empathy with individuals experiencing homelessness.
- 4. **Presentation guidelines will be given to each student group on January 29.** All presentations must be submitted by 12:00 p.m. on March 9th
- 5. All Student Groups must present at the Gala on March 24.

Support

- 1. Each student group will be educated on what a "Sprint" is, as well as background information on Design Thinking Methods.
- 2. Each student group will be provided a faculty advisor. The faculty advisor will offer support and guidance throughout the project and will help facilitate immersion and reflection experiences.
- 3. Each student group will be provided an expert social innovator to help teach the Sprint process and other innovation techniques.
- 4. Each student group will be provided with additional resources on a weekly basis that will aid in the process.
