DETAILS: On 3-3-18 at approximately 0154 hours, Camas units responded to a disturbance with a weapon at _____. Emily Javier reported to dispatch she had just stabbed her boyfriend, Alex Lovell, with a sword and was thought to be dead.

Sgt. Nadgwick, Officer Kaplan, and I arrived on scene first and observed a female later identified as Emily Javier had just come out of the house and was walking in the front lawn with her hands up. As we approached and challenged Javier she was covered in blood and was crying. Javier stated, "He's in there!", "I just stabbed him!", and "You guys need to help him!" Javier was then detained in handcuffs without incident.

Camas officers located Lovell lying curled up in the bedroom bleeding and blood splatter was found on the walls. Lovell was found to have multiple lacerations and life threatening injuries. Paramedics were requested to respond to the scene.

I secured Javier in the back of my patrol car and advised her of her Miranda Rights per card. Javier stated she understood her rights and was willing to speak with me about what happened. Javier said she has been living with Lovell for the last two years and they have been in a dating relationship. Javier said Lovell just sits at home all day playing video games and does not do anything to help. Javier said about a week ago she found out Lovell had been cheating on her after finding a "Tinder" dating application on his phone, scratches on his back, and red hair which is not hers in the shower drain.

Javier said she did not confront Lovell about him cheating explaining she has in the past and he has just denied it. Javier explained about a week ago she had bought a samurai sword at the mall to use to stab Lovell. Javier said the past week she had thought about stabbing Lovell. Javier stated, "I thought, I was gonna stab him while he was sleeping." Javier said she had just been thinking about it until tonight when Lovell came home tonight. Javier said Lovell came home without even acknowledging her and just ignored her. Javier said this angered her and she decided tonight was the night she was going to do it.

Javier explained she had hid the sword along with two knives she had taped together on her side of the bed. Javier explained she was going to wait until Lovell fell asleep to stab him. Javier said she went to bed at about 8 or 9 PM and after a couple hours Lovell fell asleep. Javier said she grabbed the knife and began swinging and stabbing at Lovell in the dark as the light was off. Javier said Lovell was screaming and yelling for her to stop.


Javier stated her intent was to kill Lovell stating, "I was trying to kill him for cheating." Javier said, "That was my purpose."

Javier was transported to the PD and interviewed further by Sergeant Boyles. After he read her the Miranda warnings,

Javier again admitted that she had been planning to kill Lovell for several days. She added that she had purchased a samuria sword with the intent of using it to kill Lovell while he slept. Javier told Sergeant Boyles that while Lovell was asleep in the dark she hid his phone so he couldn't call for help then used her phone as a light to illuminate Lovell. She then swung the samuria sword at his throat with the purpose of killing him for cheating on her.


