PLANS: All drawings, tracings or blue prints pertaining or relating to the construction of the work as specified herein.

SPECIFICATIONS: All provisions, requirements, and directions contained herein, together with all written agreements, orders for additional and extra work, made or to be made, pertaining or relating to the method and manner of performing the work, or the quantity and quality of materials to be furnished under the Contract.

CONTRACT: The agreement covering the performance of the work and the furnishing of all materials required for the construction. The Contract includes the Advertisement, Proposal, Plans, Specifications, Bond and other agreements or orders which may be required to complete to work of construction in a substantial and workmanlike manner.

BOND: The approved form of security furnished by the Contractor and his surety, as a guarantee of good faith on the part of the Contractor to execute and perform the work in accordance with the terms of the Plans, Specifications and Contract.

XIV. CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION ADVISEMENT
FOR PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

A new law, known as "The Public Works Contractor Registration Act" (P.L. 1999, c.238), will become effective April 11, 2000. Under the Act, no contractor/subcontractor will be permitted to bid or engage in any contract for public work, as defined in section 2 of P.L. 1963, c.150 (C.34:11-56.26), unless that contractor/subcontractor is registered with the New Jersey Department of Labor. The Act provides that upon registration with the Department, a public works contractor/subcontractor will be issued a certificate by the Department indicating compliance with the Act's requirements. The registration fee has been set at \$300 per year. Upon the effective date of the Act, public bodies will be expected to request production of such a certificate from those bidding on or engaging in public works projects.

It is important to note that the term "contractor," is defined in the Act as, "a person, partnership, association, joint stock company, trust, corporation or other legal business entity or successor thereof who enters into a contract which is subject to the provision of the "New Jersey Prevailing Wage Act," P.L. 1963, c.150 (C.34:11-56.25, et. seq.) for the construction, reconstruction, demolition, alteration, repair or maintenance of a public building regularly open to and used by the general public institution, and includes any subcontractor or lower tier subcontractor as defined herein, except that, for the purposes of the act, no pumping station, treatment plant or other facility associated with utility and environmental construction, reconstruction, demolition, alteration, repair or maintenance shall be regarded as a public building regularly open to and used by the general public or a public institution."
