- 9 section (c), no agency may mandate or request that a

manufacturer, developer, or seller of covered products design or alter the security functions in its product or service to allow the surveillance of any user of such product or 3 4 service, or to allow the physical search of such product, by any agency. 5 6 (b) COURT ORDERS.—Except as provided in subsection (c), no court may issue an order to compel a manu-7 8 facturer, developer, or seller of covered products to design or alter the security functions in its product or service to allow the surveillance of any user of such product or serv-10 ice, or to allow the physical search of such product, by 12 an agency. 13 (c) Exception.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall not 14 apply to mandates, requests, or court orders authorized 15 under the Communications Assistance for Law Enforcement Act (47 U.S.C. 1001 et seq.). 16 17 (d) Definitions.—In this section— 18 (1) the term "agency" has the meaning given 19 the term in section 3502 of title 44, United States 20 Code; and (2) the term "covered product" means any com-21 22 puter hardware, computer software, or electronic de-23

vice that is made available to the general public.
