



The undersigned affiant, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1) The Affiant, Detective Frank A. Cuoco II #500, is a sworn member of the Connecticut Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, Division of State Police, having been so employed since June, 1, 2012. This Affiant presently holds the rank of Detective and is assigned to the Eastern District Major Crime Squad, located in Tolland, CT. At all pertinent times mentioned herein, the Affiant was acting as an official member of said department. The Affiant has conducted numerous investigations, including sexual assaults, robberies, and burglaries, which have ultimately resulted in the arrest and conviction of the involved offender(s). The Affiant has received formal training regarding the laws of arrest and laws pertaining to Search and Seizure from The Connecticut State Police Academy and has received specialized training in the investigation of such crimes mentioned above and how to process the scenes of such crimes. This Affiant attests that the following facts and circumstances are from personal knowledge, observations, and investigation as well as the information received from other Troopers and law enforcement officers acting in their official capacity and official police reports.

2) That on Wednesday, December 20, 2017, at approximately 0512hrs, the Connecticut State Police dispatch center received a 911 emergency call reporting a structure fire at #70 Kenwood Dr. Griswold, CT. Troop E patrol Troopers along with the Griswold Fire Department and several mutual aid fire companies responded to the scene.

3) The initial responding Trooper observed heavy fire consuming the majority of the structure with fire emitting from all windows. Firefighters arrived minutes later and began fire suppression techniques. Due to the amount of fire consuming the structure, fire fighters were unable to enter the residence and were forced to utilize an exterior attack to fight the flames.


4) That at approximately 0530hrs the Town of Griswold Deputy Fire Marshal Tom Holowaty arrived on scene for the purposes of conducting a fire origin and cause investigation. Upon conducting a cursory investigation of this scene, Deputy Fire Marshal Holowaty requested the Fire and Explosion

Investigation Unit (FEIU) of the State Police to respond and assist in the determination of this fire's origin and cause. Based upon neighbor statements, the residence was occupied by an older couple and a middle aged son. At the time no occupants were accounted for.

5) That at approximately 0556hrs the Glastonbury Police Department responded to a motor vehicle fire located in the area of #40 Nanel Dr., the Glastonbury Luxury Apartments. Glastonbury Police Department identified the vehicle, a 2003 Saturn Ion bearing CT. registration AL60213 registered to Matthew Lindquist DOB: 02-09-1996 of 70 Kenwood Dr. Griswold, CT. The vehicle and scene was secured pending the arrival of Detectives from the Connecticut State Police Fire and Explosion Investigation Unit (FEIU). Det. Makuc of the FEIU conducted a cursory exterior search of the vehicle, and determined the area of origin most likely originated in the passenger compartment of the vehicle. The deduction was made by the amount of fire damage to that area and that all surrounding exterior damage, which could be accessed and viewed, was the result of the fire. According to google maps and Affiant Cuoco's experience, the travel time from 70 Kenwood Drive, Griswold to the area of 40 Nanel Drive, Glastonbury, is approximately 45 minutes.

6) That during the initial stages of the investigation while attempting to locate Matthew Lindquist, Troop E dispatch personnel initiated a cellular phone location mechanized "ping" of Matthew Lindquist's cellular phone number 860-639-3493. According to the "ping", it was determined Matthew Lindquist's cellular phone was in close proximity to the location of his vehicle at the time of the reported car fire in Glastonbury.

7) That at approximately 0705hrs TFC Hoagland of the CSP-FEIU arrived at 70 Kenwood Drive to assist in the investigation. During a preliminary search, a body was discovered within the residence of 70 Kenwood Drive, Griswold, CT. While investigators were conducting a preliminary search of the exterior of the residence, investigators located a single brass 30-06 rifle round in the driveway of 70 Kenwood Dr. Griswold, CT on the east side of the residence.

8) That during interviews with family members family members they confirmed that Matthew Lindquist's cellular phone number is 860-639-3493. In an attempt to locate Matthew Lindquist, Troop E dispatch personnel continued a cellular phone location mechanized "ping" of Matthew Lindquist's cellular phone number 860-639-3493. The results placed Lindquist's cellular phone in the area of Donald and Canton Street in the city of Hartford, CT. 1630 Main Street, the Sana (Sands) Apartment Complex is in close proximity of Matthew Lindquist's cell phone pings and the rear parking lot of the apartment complex, can be accessed from Donald Street.

9) That at approximately 0711hrs Eric Lindquist, brother to Matthew provided a written statement to Troop E patrol Troopers on scene. Eric Lindquist stated, among other things, that he was contacted by

Robert Thibeault at approximately 0500hrs who informed him of the fire at his parents' house. Eric Lindquist stated he spoke to his father, Kenneth Lindquist the previous evening and learned they were having problems with Matthew abusing illegal and prescribed narcotics again

10) That detectives obtained a written statement from Danielle T. Nichols, sister to Matthew who stated, among other things that she last communicated with Matthew around Halloween on Facebook where Matthew explained that he was in a rehabilitation center in Hartford for narcotics. Nichols also stated that her father owns numerous rifles.

11) That at approximately 0700hrs Robert Thibeault provided a written statement to Troopers on scene. R. Thibeault stated, among other things, that he has been friends with Kenneth Lindquist for the past 40 years. Kenneth lives with his wife Janet and younger son Matthew across the street. R. Thibeault mentioned that for the past couple years Matthew has been having issues with drugs. This has caused conflict within the household. Everything has been going well until the past week when Kenneth told him Matthew was having problems again and lost his job. On December 20, 2017 around 0520hrs, he noticed a bright orange light coming in through the window. He looked outside and saw Kenneth's house was totally engulfed in fire. He told his wife to call 911 and ran outside to try and help. At that point he noticed Matthew's car, a 4 door Saturn color light gray was missing from the driveway of the residence. This was unusual for Matt's vehicle not to be parked in the driveway during the morning hours.

12) That at approximately 1130hrs, Det. Lombardi of the CSP-FEIU utilized his accelerant detection K-9 Claus #9043 at the residence of #70 Kenwood Dr. Griswold, CT. During this process K-9 Claus alerted to the possible presence of an ignitable liquid in a red plastic container located in front of the attached garage. This red plastic container was deformed due to the fire but is a known and commonly used container to store and transport gasoline.

13) That during the course of the investigation, Troop E dispatch continued to initiate numerous cellular phone location mechanized "pings" of Matthew Lindquist's cellular phone number 860-639-3493. The results of the phone "pings" positioned the device in the approximate area of 1630-1640 Main Street, Hartford, CT, the Sana, also known as Sands, Apartment Complex. The time was approximately 0740 hours on 12/20/17 and subsequent "pings" over the next twenty four hours, the location remained unchanged. Additionally, based on the search warrant results for both Kenneth and Janet Lindquist's cell phone records, their cell phones last "pinged" after 0600 hours on 12/20/2017, in the area off a cell tower that faces 1630-1640 Main Street, Hartford, CT.

14) That, on December 20, 2017 at approximately 1400 hours, a search and seizure warrant was granted and executed at the property located at 70 Kenwood Dr. Griswold, CT. During the search a

second unidentified body was located within the debris. A gun safe was located standing upright with the door ajar and no contents inside. The locking mechanism on the safe door was observed by detectives to be missing which could be a result of either the fire or forced entry damage. Detectives were previously told by family members that the safe contained firearms and ammunition to include a hunting rifle in a 30-06 caliber.

15) That although an exact ignition source and origin of the house fire has not yet been determined as of December 20, 2017, numerous ignition source scenarios have been eliminated by the investigative steps. This investigation will continue as all possible origin scenarios and evidence is considered and examined.

16) That on Thursday, December 21, 2017, EDMCS Detectives Utermarck and Given attended the autopsies of the unidentified victims located during the search of the fire debris at the residence, located at 70 Kenwood Drive, Griswold, CT. Positive identifications were made on both victims by medical examiner personnel by comparing known dental records, to be that of Kenneth Lindquist (DOB 01/27/1961) and Janet Lindquist (DOB 01/18/1956). On April 25, 2018, Sgt. Ruddy #229 received the Post Mortem Report for Janet Lindquist. Affiant Cuoco reviewed the Post Mortem Report, performed and completed by Dr. McGuire, which listed the Cause of Death as: Homicidal Violence Including Blunt Impact Injuries of Head and Smoke Inhalation with Thermal Injuries and the Manner of Death as: Homicide. On Thursday, April 26, 2018, Sgt. Ruddy #229 received the Post Mortem Report for Kenneth Lindquist. Affiant Cuoco reviewed the Post Mortem Report, performed and completed by Dr. White, which listed the Cause of Death as: Homicidal Violence Including Skull Fractures; Epidural, Subdural, and Subarachnoid Hemorrhage; and Cerebral Contusion and the Manner of Death as: Homicide (Assaulted by other (s)).

17) That on Friday, December 22, 2017, a search and seizure warrant was granted and executed by members of FEIU and detectives from EDMCS on the recovered burnt 2003 Saturn, registered to Matthew Lindquist. During the search, detectives located and seized various items including three (3) exploded 30-06 shell casings and keys matching vehicles (Ford and Hyundai) burnt in the residential fire located at 70 Kenwood Drive, Griswold, CT.

18) That on Friday, December 22, 2017 Special Agent James Wines a member of the FBI Cellular Analysis Survey Team (CAST who has extensive training and experience in cellular technology, contacted Detective Bennett. SA Wines explained to Detective Bennett that after reviewing the Call Detail Report (CDR) for Matthew Lindquist's Cellular phone, phone number 860-639-3493, he was able to identify the last placed/outgoing call, at approximately 0046 hours, to phone number 352-469-0803. This is before the time of the residential fire at #70 Kenwood Drive, Griswold, CT, reported at approximately 0512 hours. SA Wines conducted a carrier lookup on the number, 352-469-0803, which

19) That on December 22, 2017, after identifying the carrier for 352-469-0803 as TextNow, Detective Bennett completed a TextNow Emergency Disclosure Request form, with a reasonable belief that Matthew Lindquist may be in serious and/or imminent danger to himself or others, and information associated with the above TextNow number may help to locate him safely. On December 22, 2017 at approximately 1507 hours, TextNow responded to Detective Bennett's request and provided the following basic account information: username, 187mrdoe, assigned date, 10-14-2017, and email address, javyony365@gmail.com.

20) That, on December 22, 2017 after obtaining the basic subscriber information for TextNow number 352-469-0803, Detective Bennett provided the results to SA Wines. SA Wines then conducted an open source social media search utilizing the email address javyony365@gmail.com and located an Instagram account with the name javony365. The Instagram account is a private account and locked, however the name Sergio Correa is listed on the account and there is a profile picture of a male sitting down wearing jeans, white t-shirt, and black hat. Utilizing the Instagram profile account photograph, SA Wines was able to positively identify Sergio Javyony Correa (H/M DOB 10/03/1991) by comparing the Instagram photograph to the Facebook account photographs of Sergio Correa as well as Connecticut Department of Correction intake photographs and Connecticut Probation photographs.

21) That on December 22, 2017 at approximately 1854 hours, a COLLECT inquiry was conducted on Sergio Javyony Correa which revealed an address of 61 Donald Street, Apt. 1B, Hartford, CT, Correa's arrest history revealed five (5) arrests all by Waterbury Police Department with guilty dispositions for: multiple counts of Assault 1, multiple counts of conspiracy to commit Robbery 1, carrying of a dangerous weapon, carrying a pistol without a permit, criminal use of a weapon, Larceny 1, and Arson 2. girlfriend arrived back at the apartment and parked their white, 2003 Mitsubishi Galant, bearing Connecticut registration AL82421 away from the apartment building. A DMV inquiry was made of Connecticut registration AL82421, which identified the registered owners as Sergio Javony Correa and Tanisha Vicente, of 61 Donald Street, Apt. 1B, Hartford, CT, Correa and his girlfriend Vicente, walked from the car to the apartment and after entering the apartment, Correa agreed to speak with Det. Bennet and your Affiant back at the Hartford Police Department. It was at this time Affiant Cuoco informed Correa he was not under arrest and his assistance was sought for help with an investigation. Correa verbally agreed to speak with Det. Bennett and Affiant Cuoco and was transported to the Hartford Police Department Capital City Command Center (C4), located at 50 Jennings Road, by Probation Officer Davis.

23) That upon arrival at the Hartford Police Department C4 building, Affiant Cuoco again informed Correa that he was not under arrest, free to leave at any time, could stop answering questions at any time, and if he chose to do so, could contact an attorney. Affiant Cuoco asked Correa if he understood to which he verbally stated "I got you" while nodding his head up and down affirming he understood, and agreed to stay and talk. Affiant Cuoco informed Correa that he was interested in the whereabouts of someone that he (Correa) had recently been in contact with and needed help locating him. Detective Bennett showed Correa a photo of Matthew Lindquist, and Correa paused upon viewing the image. After the pause, Correa did not identify Matthew by his name but said he was not involved with "his business". Affiant Cuoco explained to Correa that he was certain he and Matthew had communicated since the arson at which point Correa explained he wanted to contact a lawyer. It was at this time Correa removed an iPhone with a black case from his pants pocket, unlocked it and began searching the internet for an attorney. Affiant Cuoco asked Correa what type of phone he had and if it was his only cell phone and Correa explained it was his only cell phone. Affiant Cuoco explained that I would be seizing his cell phone at which time Correa locked the phone and handed it to Affiant Cuoco. Correa then got up and spoke with a Probation Officer before being escorted to the lobby. As part of the investigation, Affiant Cuoco later reviewed the interview with Correa and Correa provided Det. Vicente provided written/signed consent to search the vehicle, owned by both her and Correa. Adult Probation Officers informed Det. Bennett and your Affiant of items discovered during the search of the vehicle to include, but not limited to: a red gas can in the trunk, multiple knives, a bottle of wound cleanser spray, a small sledge hammer in a bag near the front passenger seat, assorted clothing, a black HP brand computer monitor, and miscellaneous hand tools. located inside of the vehicle in combination with the information and facts obtained to this point, the vehicle was seized to prevent the likelihood of the destruction of evidence. The vehicle was towed to the Connecticut State Police Troop E - Montville barracks and secured in the garage pending issuance of a search and seizure warrant.

25) That on December 20, 2017 several still photos were obtained from the Bank of America located on the corner of New London Turnpike and Clinton Street, in the area where Matthew Lindquist's burnt vehicle was recovered. At approximately 0543 hours, a silver four door Saturn, similar to and later confirmed to be registered to Matthew Lindquist, is seen traveling south on New London turnpike and turn east on Clinton street. Seconds later, an additional sedan, similar in style, color, and shape to Correa's 2003 Mitsubishi Galant, is seen travelling behind Lindquist's vehicle. Shortly thereafter at approximately 0547 hours, the first flames can be seen in the distance of the still surveillance photographs.

26) That on Friday, January 5, 2018 at approximately 1440 hours, Detective Utermarck and Detective Given of EDMCS and Hartford Police Officer Montanez, met with Witness #1 (01/09/1987) inside the interview room located on Jennings Road, in Hartford, CT. Witness #1 stated he has been employed by the Sana (Sands) Apartment Complex onsite security company for approximately 6-8 months. The company provides 24 hour security at the apartment complex. Witness #1's duties include working the front desk and monitoring the people/tenants that come and go from the facility. Witness #1 explained that he believed either on December 24th or December 30th, 2017 around 1:00 AM, he was approached by a female he knows as Ruth Correa who lives in apartment #1002. Witness #1 explained that he was walking the hallways conducting patrols when he was approached by Ruth. Witness #1 is also aware of Ruth's brother, "Giovanni" also known as "Gio" who lives in the complex behind the apartment tower, the lower level, located on Donald Street.

27) That during the interview, Witness #1 explained that Ruth did not appear to be drunk or high; however, she began to talk with him while the two stood in the hallway. Ruth discussed how she has a thing of putting stuff in a guy's drink, "roofies" them, gets them high, then takes their money and or whatever she can get of value. Ruth continued to explain to Witness #1 about how the Police went to the complex and were looking for something and her knowledge of a serious house fire in Griswold, CT and how the mom and dad were killed and the Police are stupid. Ruth explained to Witness #1 that he's on the property and they don't even know it. He's dead and they are not going to find him. Ruth explained that they drugged him by the "lake" and then killed him and left him there. Ruth then explained they took his keys from him and walked through the woods from the big lake behind their house, and went back to the house. Ruth explained that he's rich and had pounds of "weed and other stuff" in the house to steal. Ruth continued talking to Witness #1 and explained when they went back to the house, they went after the father and then after the mother, who later put up a "big" fight. Ruth

explained that they "stabbed" both, killing them, and then burnt the house before they took a car, which he believed was the kid's car. Ruth explained to Witness #1, her brother walks around with a knife, also loves to burn stuff. Ruth explained that after everything happened, they had evidence on them and the only way was to burn the car. Ruth explained that they drove the kid's car off the highway and burnt it. Witness #1 believed Ruth and Sergio drove the Mitsubishi Galant to Griswold and then took the other car and burnt it and that Ruth must have cleaned up somewhere because he did not believe that she would walk back into her apartment complex with blood all over her. Witness #1 also believed there was no forced entry into the house so they must have used the kid's keys to get in.

28) That during the interview, Witness #1 explained he has never seen the knife Sergio carries but believed it is inside his pocket. Ruth also explained to Witness #1 that after the fire that morning, she and Sergio walked into her apartment and the news was on the television. "NiNi" was watching and the video of the fire was on. Sergio then somewhat bragged to Ruth how you would not usually see that big of a fire in Connecticut. Witness #1 explained that based on the conversation with Ruth, it appeared that she and her brother, did not know the parents were at the house and they were caught off guard. Witness #1 believed Ruth needed someone to talk to that night and she picked him. Witness #1 also explained that "Gio" drives a white "Galant" and Ruth told him when she got inside the car with the knife, she was covered in blood. Ruth told Witness #1 that she looked at her brother, and he said to her, "Man I didn't know you lived this life." Ruth explained that she responded to her brother, "Buddy for the 10 years you've been locked up, I've been doing stuff you don't even know about." Ruth explained that the inside of the Mitsubishi was now "renewed." She told Witness #1 that they replaced the interior inside the Galant from other stolen interior pieces they got somewhere, in an effort to clean out the inside of the car and get rid of any additional evidence. Ruth also explained that they were able to take a Laptop and cell phone from the house he believed. Ruth explained to Witness #1 that after the Police came around the complex looking for information they cleared the kid's phone and shut it off.

29) That Witness #1 believed since he has been working at the complex, he has observed Matt Lindquist come and go from the facility a few times. When asked, Witness #1 said he recognized Matt from a photograph after he google searched the fire in Griswold. He also believed that Lindquist visited in February sometime and another time with a "chunky young white girl." He also believed that Lindquist was hoping to "get some" from Ruth that night because he frequently sees her leaving her apartment and getting into various cars and bringing different people to her apartment. Ruth and Sergio are typically together most of the time, however, recently that has stopped. Most times Ruth is home inside her apartment and Sergio is not around too often. After Witness #1 was told of this incident and the involvement of Ruth and Sergio, he kept the information to himself. He was able to look up the fire in Griswold, and the car fire in Glastonbury, through the Internet. He felt bad that this had been done to a family. After a few days going by, he decided to tell his friend and co-worker, Witness #2, about the information Ruth provided him. After doing more research and discussing this

with Witness #2, and another friend, he decided to speak with Hartford Officer Montanez, who later recommended that he speak to the Connecticut State Police and provide them with this information.

30) That on Saturday, January 6, 2018 at approximately 1701 hours, a Search and Seizure warrant was obtained for Correa's white, 2003 Mitsubishi Galant, bearing Connecticut registration AL82421, VIN 4A3AA46G83E181849. On Sunday, January 7, 2018, detectives from the EDMCS executed the search warrant on the aforementioned 2003 Mitsubishi Galant in the Troop E - Montville garage. During the search, detectives located and seized various items including numerous sledge hammers and hand tools, pry bars, a red gas can, a black HP brand computer monitor, multiple knives, a bottle of wound cleanser spray, and assorted clothing. Additionally noted during the search was that various screws were out of place or replaced, the front seats were not bolted to the floor properly, the interior trim package did not match (wood grain in only some places, power seat wires under the seat with no power seat controls on the doors), and underneath the front driver's seat contained yellow writing that was subsequently traced back to a junkyard in New Hampshire.

31) That Affiant Cuoco contacted Eric Lindquist during the search of the vehicle and asked him to come to Troop E to attempt to identify some of the recovered items. E. Lindquist stated there were two items he recognized. The first item E. Lindquist recognized was a HP brand monitor of the same model that his dad would have had in the office room of the house. E. Lindquist described the monitor similar in that of design, size, configuration, and assembly as well as color and wear markings that he is familiar with due to his use of the monitor and computer. E. Lindquist stated the second significant item was a yellow pry bar. E. Lindquist explained he used the pry bar many times recently and the wear patterning looked exactly the same as he remembered it and he also recalled a set of initials engraved on the pry bar in the same area. E. Lindquist said he couldn't remember the exact initials or engraving but that he knew there was something engraved on his father's pry bar. E. Lindquist later emailed Affiant Cuoco on 1/7/18, and attached a photograph of Kenneth Lindquist seated at a desk with a HP computer monitor, similar in color, size, and design to the one seized from Correa's 2003 Mitsubishi Galant, in view on top of the desk.

32) That as of January 7, 2018, investigators were unable to locate Matthew Lindquist or his body and there also had been no cell phone activity for Matthew's cell phone, number 860-639-3493. Based on these circumstances, Sgt. Ruddy coordinated with members of the K-9 unit to conduct another search of the residence and immediate woods located at 70 Kenwood Drive, as well as additional surrounding properties with negative results.

33) That on Wednesday, January 3, 2018 a Search and Seizure warrant was obtained for the records associated with Correa's TextNow phone number 352-469-0803. On Tuesday, January 16, 2017, Affiant Cuoco received the results from the TextNow search warrant for Correa's TextNow phone

Ruth stated her brother, Sergio Correa, is not her biological brother but they were raised together in the same home in Hartford. Ruth said her brother was incarcerated from 2007 through 2017 and when he was released, he was living in her grandfather's house located at 61 Donald Street in Hartford. Ruth stated Sergio was working for a company called Ment 2 be Movers.

Ruth explained one day in December 2017, her brother "hit me up" and asked her to join him during the night. Ruth said she was not certain if he called her or sent a message to her phone but she was getting a haircut at the time. Ruth stated she met Sergio in the back of her building and he was driving his white car. Ruth said she then got into the driver's seat and they drove about an hour away from her building. She stated she drove and it was dark. Ruth stated her brother told her during the car ride that this guy owed him money and he was going to pretend to give this guy drugs and he was going to get guns. Ruth said Sergio told her that she was going to pretend to pick a lock to the safe at this guy's house. Ruth said she thought that she was only the driver.

40) That during the same interview with Ruth Correa, she stated on the way they could not find the house and she thought they were lost around some big houses and around a cul de sac. Ruth stated her brother then called this guy and he appeared in the street. Ruth described the guy as a white guy with shaggy brown hair and he was healthy not fat or skinny. Ruth explained she has never seen this guy before and thought he was in his early 20's. Ruth stated the guy gets in the back seat and he asked Sergio if he had the drugs. Ruth said she thought it was dope. Ruth stated she had seen dope baggies in the car when her brother showed them to him. Ruth stated her brother told him that he was not getting anything unless he got what he was promised. Ruth stated Sergio and this guy talked about a fake robbery and that the basement door to the house was already unlocked. Ruth stated her brother and the guy talked about tying him up and making it look like a robbery. Ruth said this was the first time that she had seen her brother this way. supposed to be his boy and they were going to work this out. Ruth stated her brother told the guy he can't trust him because he was moving too much. Ruth stated Sergio told the guy he was going to tie him up and duck-tape his mouth because he didnt want him to scream. Ruth said her brother had tape and zip ties with him and the guy started to yell and freak out and that was when her brother started to stab him with a knife. Ruth said at that point, everything started to get fuzzy. Ruth stated all this happened next to the car near the wooded area. Ruth stated Sergio stabbed the guy a lot and he stopped moving. Ruth said Sergio also had stabbed the guy a few times while he was on the ground. Ruth explained before the guy hit the ground, her brother told her to "get him" and he gave her a knife. Ruth said she hesitated and Sergio grabbed her hand and guided her and she stabbed the guy in the chest about 10 times. Ruth stated she could not remember the exact number of times that she stabbed him and she wanted to disappear and not be part of it. Ruth said after that she walked back to the car and waited. Ruth stated they looked around trying to find a safe and they found the safe in the basement which was bolted to the ground. Ruth stated they made their way up the stairs and they got to the area between the kitchen and the living room and the "Dad" got up and went after her brother. Ruth said the dog came after her and she hit the dog with a golf club twice and it ran away. Ruth explained she had grabbed a golf club that was inside her brother's car, which was parked down the street, before going into the house. Ruth stated she took the club because the guy that they stabbed told them about the dog in the house. Ruth stated Sergio was beating the "Dad" up with a bat and she was not certain if he had brought the bat with him or found it in the house. Ruth believed it was a wooden bat. Ruth stated Sergio had already gotten keys to the safe and brought a gun up to the bedroom. Ruth said her brother then pointed the gun at the woman and she walked around the house grabbing items like house hold items to include a purple laptop from the office. Ruth said she told her brother it was time to go and her brother started to taunt the woman and had her get all of the jewelry but he never took any.

Ruth stated she went to grab more items from the house and when she went back into the bedroom, her brother had a rope/string around the woman's neck and his foot in her back. Ruth said the woman was on the ground near the bed and her face was leaning up on the side of the mattress. The woman was trying to breath and appeared to be choking. Ruth stated the woman then stopped making noise and Sergio and her started to bring bags of items out the car. Ruth said she thought it was bags of Christmas items. Ruth explained she made about three trips of property from the house to the car and put the property into the silver car that was parked in front of the house.

42) That during the same interview with Ruth Correa, She said on the last trip into the house, she found Sergio choking the woman again with a rope/string because she appeared to have been reaching for the phone. Ruth stated it was at this time, her brother grabbed a bat and hit the woman in the back of the head about 4-5 times. Ruth stated while walking around the house, she could smell human shit. Ruth explained Sergio then said, "look this nigger really shitted himself". Ruth stated she never saw the Dad or what had happened to him but she heard loud "thuds" and the Dad stopped making noise. Ruth stated she only saw what happened to the guy in the trees and what happened to the woman.

Ruth said on the last trip out of the house, she went through the basement and her brother told her to look for something flammable. Ruth stated she turned the light on in the basement and went into the boiler room. Ruth said she stood in the room for about 2 minutes when her brother came down to the room and then started to hand him cans that were square and the liquid inside smelled strong. Ruth stated Sergio started to pour the thick liquid out onto the floor. Ruth stated Sergio told her to pour more liquid on the first floor office and bedrooms. Ruth said she dumped the entire can in one spot and then went out the basement door hoping to leave. Ruth stated when she was outside, she heard birds chirping and she thought it was about 4 AM but it was still dark. Ruth said she went back inside the house and Sergio was on the first floor with exercise ball and he lit it on fire with a lighter. Ruth stated the ball went up in flames quick.

Ruth stated they had loaded the property into the silver car that was out-front of the house. Ruth stated while in the driveway, she got into the front passenger side seat of the silver car which was a stick shift. Ruth stated they drove to her brother's car which was still down the road and she got out of the car and got into the driver's seat of her brother's car. Ruth stated she followed Sergio out of the

neighborhood and they drove for about 1/2 hour and found a place to park near an abandoned building. Ruth explained they parked next to each other and they put all of the property from the silver car into Sergio's car. Ruth stated they then drove for another 5 minutes and that was when Sergio told her to stay parked and he drove the silver car away. Ruth stated Sergio returned after about 5 minutes and he sat in the passenger seat and told her to go. Ruth said Sergio used the GPS on his phone to get them back to Hartford.

43) That during the same interview with Ruth Correa, She stated when they arrived back in Hartford, she pulled the car to the back of the building and she went upstairs to her apartment and brought 4 bags of property into the building. Ruth stated Sergio then drove the car away, she assumed that he drove home, and it was around 7:00AM when she got home.

Ruth stated the next night, she walked to the railroad tracks and burned the clothing that she was wearing that day. Ruth said she was wearing Nike Joggers pants (black) and a spaghetti strap shirt. Ruth explained Sergio took the jacket that she was wearing before she left the silver car. Ruth stated she got rid of all of the property in the garbage shoot and in the trash. Ruth explained there should not be anything in her apartment from that house. Ruth stated Sergio came over to her apartment a few days later and made certain that all of the property was out of the apartment. Ruth said she has not seen the guns they took from the house since that night and she does not know what Sergio did with them.

Ruth said she did talk to Sergio's girlfriend, Tanisha Vicente, about what had happened and when Adult Probation had went to her grandfather's house. Ruth explained they talked to each other about the guns and if the Probation Officers found them. Ruth stated she believed that she (Vicento) was aware of what had happened.

Ruth stated before her brother was arrested, she had heard from a family member that her brother was so paranoid about what happened that he told the family member that he wanted the "OK" to kill her. Ruth said she took that as if she told anyone what had happened, Sergio would kill her. Ruth stated Sergio's girlfriend, Tanisha, was in the room at the time that Sergio had said it. Ruth concluded by saying that her brother, Sergio Correa, and her were the only ones involved and no one else was with them.

44) That during the interview with Ruth Correa, Det. Bennett and Affiant Cuoco explained to Ruth that she was not under arrest and was free to leave at any time. During the interview, Ruth was given multiple cigarette breaks, multiple bathroom breaks, and was provided with food and water.

45) That based upon the aforementioned facts and circumstances, this Affiant believes that Ruth

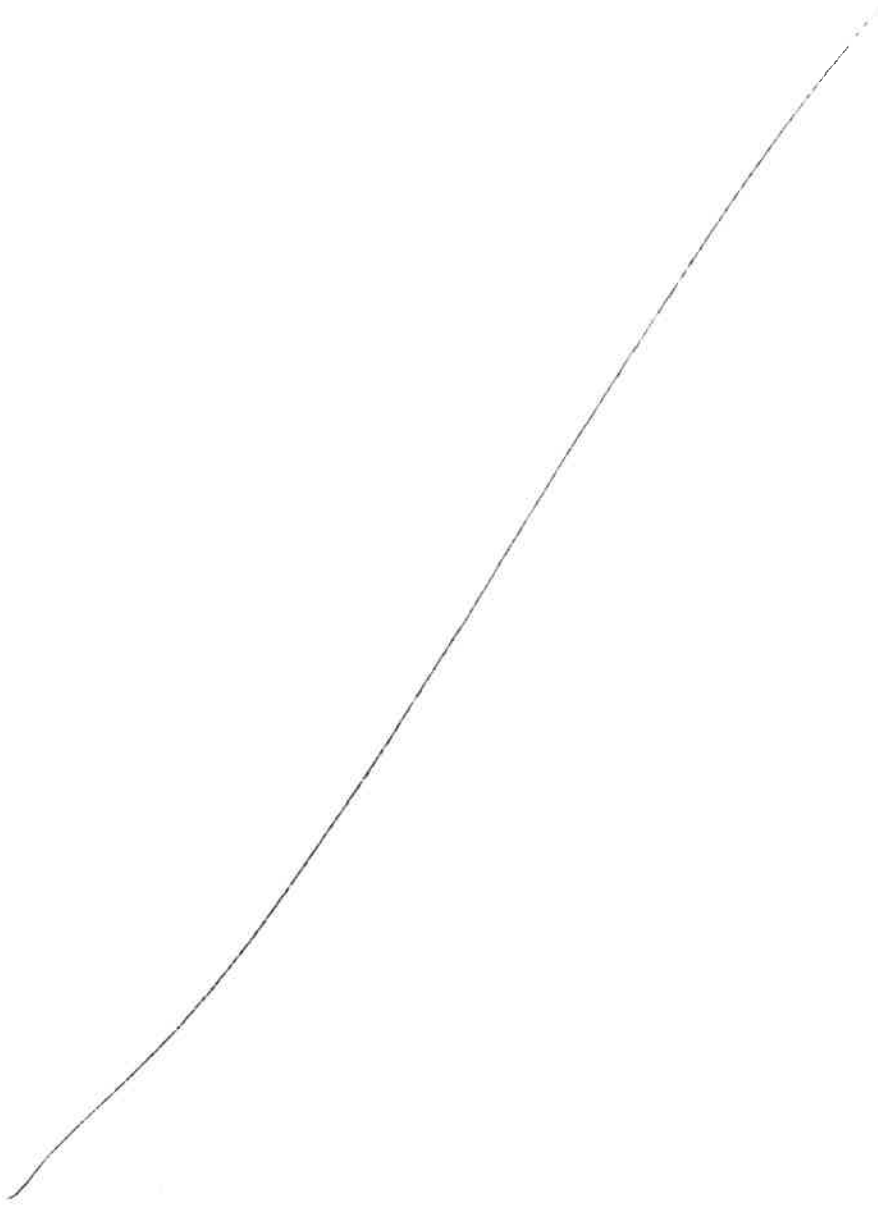
