

Stipulation for Dismissal

The undersigned parties and their counsel stipulate as follows:


1. Counsel for defendant, on behalf of defendant, stipulate that the State has sufficient evidence to constitute a submissible case in 22nd Cir. No. 1822-CR01377.
2. The defendant withdraws all motions to disqualify the Circuit Attorney of the City of St. Louis and her office from prosecuting 22nd Cir. No. 1822-CR01377.
3. The Circuit Attorney acknowledges that the trial of the charges in 22nd Cir. No. 1822-CR01377 would be attended with considerable public expense and the outcome could not be predicted.
4. The parties agree that it is in the interests of justice that the charges in 22nd Cir. No. 1822-CR01377 be resolved expeditiously.
5. The Circuit Attorney hereby dismisses the charges in 22nd Cir. No. 1822-CR01377 pursuant to Section 56.087, RSMo. The Circuit Attorney further stipulates that, upon receipt of the defendant's resignation from office by the Secretary of State of Missouri, the Court may dismiss No. 1822-CR01377 with prejudice.
6. Defendant, after advice of counsel and in consideration of the stipulations herein, releases the Circuit Attorney of the City of St. Louis and all members of her office and consultants of her office from any civil liability on account of matters alleged in 22nd Cir. No. 1822-CR00642 and No. 1822-CR01377 and waives any claim to court costs not already taxed in either cause.
7. Defendant's stipulation in paragraph 1 hereof regarding the complaint in No. 1822-CR01377 shall be sealed and shall not be made public by any party unless defendant commits a new offense or engages in public comment contrary to the stipulation.
