- June 22, 2018: Petitioner's motion for a preliminary injunction and response to Respondent's supplemental memorandum due.
- June 29, 2018: Respondent's opposition to Petitioner's motion for a preliminary

injunction due.

• July 3, 2018: Petitioner's reply to Respondent's opposition to Petitioner's motion for a preliminary injunction due.

The parties also request that the hearing currently scheduled for tomorrow, June 20, be

rescheduled for July 9, or as soon thereafter as practicable. Counsel for Respondent is

unavailable on July 11 and 12.

The parties thank the Court for its consideration of this matter. A proposed order is filed

herewith.
