A Look at the African National Congress

By ROBERT MORRIS

INCREASINGLY, Big Media, some church leaders, much of academia, and sometimes even the State Department are speaking of the African National Congress with respect, as if its opposition to apartheid alone defies the ANC and its leadership in the eyes of all decent people.

But, let us have a look at the African National Congress:

Its Secretary General, generally the key man in Communist parties, is Alfred Nzo. In March of last year, Nzo addressed Moscow's 27th World Congress. That is the body that establishes worldwide Soviet policy. He is vice president of Moscow's World Peace Council and has received the Soviet Order of Friendship of Peoples.



Also a top man is Joe Slovo, white Lithuanian Comintern agent, chairman of the South African Communist party who is commander of the military arm of the ANC, Umkhonto we Sizwe. That organization has been committing more acts of terror with fiery, rubber-tire "necklaces" and other ghoulish measures than Gadhafi and all other terrorists put together.

THE CIA HAS ISSUED a biography of the 19 pro-Soviet leaders of the ANC. Two of these officials, Martin Hani and Cassius Make, received military training in the Soviet Union. Two others, Francis Meli and Anthony Mongalo, have close ties to East Germany, which supplies intelligence and security support for pro-Soviet regimes. My information on Hani is that

he is the political commissar of the ANC's military wing... Make is a senior commander of that wing... Meli is the editor of Sechaba, the ANC's official journal published in East Germany; and Mongalo is the official ANC representative in that satellite country.

Winnie Mandela, ANC's spokesman, has been quoted in Pravda, "The Soviet Union is a torch bearer for all our hopes and aspirations... the land of the Soviets is the genuine friend and ally of all people fighting against dark forces of world reaction."

THE CIA LIST of pro-Soviet ANC leaders also includes Mzwai Piliso of the Afro-Asian Peoples Solidarity Organization; James Stuart of the World Federation of Trade Unions, based in Prague; and Thabo Mbeki of the World Federation of Democratic Youth; also S. Maharja, an Indian South African Communist Party official; and Stephen Diamini.

My information on Piliso is that he is a special aide to Oliver Tambo, ANC's chief spokesman in Zambia; Stuart is also at Tambo's headquarters; Mbeki is ANC's Secretary of Information; and Maharja is a member of the political arm, Umkhonto we Sizwe; and Diamini is president of the South African Communist Party's labor front, South African Congress of Trade Unions (SACTU).

I understand that of the 30 members of ANC's National Committee, the following are also members of the South African Communist Party: Henry Makgothi, secretary of the ANC Education Department; John Nkadimenj, chief secretary of SACTU and chairman of the ANC's political committee; Aziz Pahad, ANC's representative in London; Reg September,

formerly of the ANC's London office, now in Zambia; and Dan Tloome, ANC's deputy secretary general and deputy treasurer general.

AS FOR OLIVER TAMBO, the front man for the ANC based in Zambia, he hardly conceals his Soviet allegiance. For instance, he said "There is going to be more bloodshed and the whole country will be involved. The Soviet Union will give us what the West does not want to give us, namely weapons." Actually, the U.S.S.R. has been arming the ANC for years.

The African National Congress makes no effort to conceal its reliance on violence or its allegiance to world communism.

When I was in the region last year, 500 ANC guerrillas were being trained in Angola by Soviet and East German officers. Others were being trained in Mozambique, a Soviet surrogate. And in 1982, many others were being trained by the PLO in Lebanon — all with Soviet weaponry.

THESE ARE JUST A FEW of the facts about the African National Congress, whose members too many unsuspecting American see as noble fighters for freedom and justice.

Tambo Gets an Unwarranted Boost

WHEN RONALD REAGAN was fighting the Communists and their fellow travelers in the Screen Actors Guild, he carried a loaded

Smith and Wesson revolver to protect himself against anonymous threats to end his Hollywood career by throwing acid in his face. As president of the guild he went to Washington with a

previous president, George Murphy, to testify before the House Un-American Activities Committee about Communist infiltration of Hollywood organizations. So we may assume that Reagan knows plenty

about Communist maneuverings in committees that they aspire to dominate for their own Marxist-Leninist ends.

What a pity, then, that Reagan did nothing to forestall the meeting the other-day between Oliver Tambo, the head of the Communist-infiltrated African National Congress, and Secretary of State George Shultz. Between the acid-throwing of Reagan's Hollywood days and the "necklacing" (setting fire to a kerosene-filled rubber tire around a victim's neck) there can't be any moral difference. Tambo, both before and during his meeting with Shultz, refused to repudiate the practice of necklacing by his followers. As a condition for the meeting Tambo should have been required to disassociate himself from the statement of Winnie Mandela, wife of Nelson Mandela, an ANC founder, that "together, hand in hand, with our boxes of matches and our necklaces, we shall liberate this country."

To do him justice, Shultz made it clear that the United States would not condone ANC violence in South Africa. But in meeting with Tambo, who has less of a following among South African blacks than Buthelezi, the chief of the Zulus, Shultz conferred upon Tambo and the ANC a dignity that is certainly unwarranted.

Michael Armacost, who is Shultz's undersecretary of state for political affairs, has said the

Shultz is not going to fire Armacost, his undersecretary for political affairs, or Chester Crocker, his assistant secretary for African affairs. But Reagan might gain some ground by making a personal repudiation of the "legitimacy" of the ANC to claim spokespersonship for all the South African blacks.

Shultz-Tambo meeting was set up to "facilitate a dialogue between the government of South Africa and the legitimate voice of the black community." Armacost's notion of "legitimacy" is very strange indeed. What is "legitimate" about necklacing? What is "legitimate" about Tambo's support of violent revolution?

Tambo has said that "members of the ANC fully understand why both the ANC and the SACP (South African Communist Party) are two hands in the same body, why they are the two pillars of our revolution." Just last November Tambo, in amplifying his statement that "we have to make our country ungovernable," said the "ANC and the SACP have common objectives... the seizure of power."

Shultz cannot feign unawareness of Tambo's sentiments. Howie Phillips, the head of the Conservative Caucus and chairman of the Coalition Against ANC Terrorism, has deluged the State Department with damaging Tambo quotes. Rep. Jack Kemp, in addressing his own criticism to Shultz,

Shultz is not going to fire Armacost, his undersecretary for political affairs, or Chester Crocker, his assistant secretary for African affairs. But Reagan might gain some ground by making a personal repudiation of the "legitimacy" of the ANC to claim spokespersonship for all the South African blacks.
