ALLEGATIONS:

Accused: Chicago Police Officer Brian TREACY Star 5181
Employee [REDACTED]
Unit of Assignment: 7th District

Allegation #1: On 23 August 2012 at 1930 hours in the vicinity of 68th and Halsted in Chicago Illinois, Complainant [REDACTED] alleged that Accused Officer Brian TREACY Star 5181 touched [REDACTED] bare left breast.

Allegation #2: On 23 August 2012 at 1930 hours in the vicinity of 68th and Halsted in Chicago Illinois, Complainant [REDACTED] alleged that Accused Officer Brian TREACY Star 5181 touched [REDACTED] vagina.

INVESTIGATION:

In summary, Reporting Officer was assigned this investigation based on complainant [REDACTED] allegation that Chicago Police Officer Brian TREACY Star 5181 touched [REDACTED] bare left breast and vagina. (Attachment #1, 3, and 4)

On 23 August 2012, Sergeant John P. HIGGINS Star 1612 from the 7th District generated an initiation report regarding alleged inappropriate touching by Department member Chicago Police Brian TREACY Star 5181. Sergeant HIGGINS stated in the initiation report that complainant [REDACTED] was arrested for prostitution on 23 August 2012 at 1930 hours. Sergeant HIGGINS relayed the accounts of the arrest, the undersigned summarized the report as follows. (Attachment #4)

[REDACTED] flagged down Officer TREACY, who was working in an undercover capacity, and entered the covert vehicle. Officer TREACY then traveled to the area of 71st and Green. During the drive, [REDACTED] offered sexual acts for a set monetary fee. Officer TREACY then signaled to enforcement Officer Kevin RAKE Star 7524 to execute the arrest of [REDACTED]. At that point [REDACTED] stated "You're a cop," opened the door, and ran. [REDACTED] was apprehended at 7104 S. Emerald after a brief foot chase. [REDACTED] was then transported to the 7th District for further processing. The incident was recorded under RD#HV443894. (Attachment #4)

The report further stated that Sergeant HIGGINS received a phone call from Officer TREACY in that [REDACTED] was divulging narcotic information to Officer TREACY and Officer RAKE. After a brief review of [REDACTED]'s narcotic information, Sergeant HIGGINS, Officer TREACY, Officer RAKE, and [REDACTED] traveled to the alleged narcotic location. [REDACTED] was returned to lock up with no reported incident. (Attachment #4)

The report continued in that [REDACTED] asked to speak to Sergeant HIGGINS. Sergeant HIGGINS met with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] related that [REDACTED] should be let go for the information she provided. Sergeant HIGGINS informed [REDACTED] that she was not going to be let go due to the approved felony charges placed against [REDACTED]. Sergeant HIGGINS in turn advised Officer TREACY and Officer RAKE that [REDACTED] would not be used in a search warrant but to follow up [REDACTED] information by surveillances. (Attachment #4)

The report then stated that transport Officer Michael COLLINS Star 16346 was assigned to transport [REDACTED] to the female area lock up. Officer COLLINS asked [REDACTED] a series of questions pertaining to [REDACTED] well being prior to transporting [REDACTED]. At which time, [REDACTED] claimed that [REDACTED] had an [REDACTED] with her asthma. Sergeant HIGGINS was called to the processing room where [REDACTED] was kept due to [REDACTED] alleged ailment. Sergeant HIGGINS recalled that Officer COLLINS then related that [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] asthma was fine but that "the white cop touched my titties and pussy." (Attachment #4)

The report stated that Sergeant HIGGINS requested Sergeant CAScone Star 1202 be present during [REDACTED] alleged misconduct interview. [REDACTED] related [REDACTED] should be released on [REDACTED] charge reduced to a misdemeanor because of the information [REDACTED] gave regarding the narcotic sales. [REDACTED] was told that would not be possible due to [REDACTED] criminal background. Sergeant HIGGINS asked [REDACTED] about the allegation [REDACTED] made to Officer COLLINS. [REDACTED] stated that the officer that picked [REDACTED] up grabbed her breast and vagina, which scared her, she ran, and that she was innocent. Sergeant HIGGINS asked [REDACTED] for more details concerning the allegation, to which [REDACTED] gave none, and [REDACTED] continued to talk about how [REDACTED] should be released. The report concluded with no further pertinent information. (Attachment #4)

The undersigned queried the original case incident report, arrest report, and the CLEAR Data Warehouse Service Call Search for incidents related to [REDACTED] for 23 August 2012 filed under HV443894. These reports indicated that on 23 August 2012 there was a prostitution mission conducted by beat 763B, in that [REDACTED] was arrested and charged with prostitution. (Attachment #5, 6, and 7)

On 24 September 2012, the undersigned discovered that [REDACTED] was held at the Cook County Jail and entered into a work release program. (Attachment #8 and 9)

On 12 December 2012, [REDACTED] was detained at the DWIGHT Correctional Center-Intel Section. The undersigned spoke with Officer Chris SAMUELSON who coordinated and set the interview date and time with [REDACTED] at the correctional facility. (Attachment #10 and 11)

On 17 December 2012, the undersigned along with Sergeant Michael BARZ Star 2625 met with [REDACTED] at the Dwight Correctional Center. The interview of [REDACTED] is a summary of the interview, unless otherwise indicated. (Attachment #12)

[REDACTED] stated that sometime in mid-August 2012 at approximately 1600 to 1800 hours [REDACTED] was arrested at about 68th and Halsted. [REDACTED] stated a male white in his forty's with grey

short hair weighing about 215 pounds in civilian dress attire drove along side [redacted] on the Halsted side and asked [redacted] if [redacted] needed a ride. [redacted] related [redacted] agreed to the ride. [redacted] stated that [redacted] sat in the front passenger side. [redacted] stated [redacted] asked the driver if he was a cop, to which the male said no. [redacted] related that [redacted] saw a construction hat in the vehicle. [redacted] stated [redacted] entered the vehicle and the male driver was alone. [redacted] stated the male asked how much to hang out. [redacted] recalled a hundred dollars (\$100.00) was discussed for a "blowjob." [redacted] stated that [redacted] told the male driver, "if you're not touched [redacted] left breast and placed [redacted] hands down [redacted] vagina. [redacted] recalled that [redacted] wore a shirt with blue jean pants with a bra and no underpants. (Attachment #12)

[redacted] was asked if he placed his fingers into [redacted] vagina, to which [redacted] said no. [redacted] reenacted the alleged actions of the accused. The action shown was a rapid movement of a hand waving across the chest area and into the waistline of pants. (Attachment #12)

[redacted] stated that [redacted] was shown pictures of [redacted]. According to [redacted], [redacted] is a known local drug dealer and gangbanger. The undersigned asked [redacted] if [redacted] was used in a search warrant or presented to a judge, to which [redacted] responded no. (Attachment #12)

[redacted] further related that while under arrest, [redacted] was taken out of station to go look at [redacted] houses. [redacted] stated [redacted] was placed in a blue truck. [redacted] said [redacted] showed officers [redacted] dope spot and was taken back to the station. [redacted] stated that [redacted] did not see the accused again and never confronted the accused. (Attachment #12)

[redacted] stated [redacted] made a complaint to police Department while in the cell and to a supervisor. [redacted] did not recall the supervisor's name. During the interview [redacted] was asked to sign a Department Sworn Affidavit attesting to [redacted] allegation, in which [redacted] did. (Attachment #12)

[redacted] agreed to view a photoarray, in order for [redacted] to identify the accused. [redacted] signed a Lineup/Photoarray form prior to [redacted] viewing the photoarray. [redacted] was shown a photoarray, which included accused member Officer TREACY. [redacted] was not able to identify the accused, the array was negative. (Attachment #12)

The undersigned queried the Department's Attendance and Assignment (A&A) sheets for Sergeant HIGGINS, Sergeant CASCONI, Officer TREACY, Officer RAKE, Officer COLLINS, Officer CORTES, and Officer ESCOBEDO. These individuals were listed in the either in the original case incident report, arrest report, the Initiation report, or partners in the transport vehicle for the day of incident. (Attachment #13)

The undersigned queried the CLEAR Watch Information for Sergeant HIGGINS, Sergeant CASCONI, Officer TREACY, Officer RAKE, Officer COLLINS, and Officer CORTES, and Officer ESCOBEDO. These individuals were listed either in the original case incident report, arrest report, the Initiation report, or partners in the transport vehicle

for the day of incident, in which making these individuals potential witnesses.
(Attachment #14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20)

On 19 April 2013, the undersigned conducted an interview with Sergeant HIGGINS. The following is a summary of his statement.
(Attachment #21)

Sergeant HIGGINS recalled that on 23 August 2012, his team addressed vice conditions in the 7th District. Sergeant HIGGINS related that the wagon, beat 773R, brought to his attention a problem with [REDACTED] asthma. After speaking to Officer COLLINS, assigned to 773R, he went to the processing room to inquire about the problem. Officer COLLINS related that [REDACTED] asthma was fine but that [REDACTED] now said that the white cop touched my "titties and pussy." Sergeant HIGGINS asked Sergeant James CASCONE Star 1488 to accompany him in the interview of [REDACTED]. Sergeant HIGGINS remembered that during the interview he asked [REDACTED] about the allegation, and [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] should "be let go because [REDACTED] gave up a big dope house." Sergeant HIGGINS stated that [REDACTED] continued to say that [REDACTED] should be let go, we should help [REDACTED] because [REDACTED] helped us." Sergeant HIGGINS told [REDACTED] that was impossible and then [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] should get a misdemeanor. Sergeant HIGGINS asked [REDACTED] about the allegation that [REDACTED] related to Officer COLLINS, ISON said that the officer who picked [REDACTED] up grabbed [REDACTED] breast and vagina. Sergeant HIGGINS stated that he asked [REDACTED] for more details about the allegation, but that [REDACTED] gave none, only that [REDACTED] should be let go. Sergeant HIGGINS recalled that [REDACTED] stated that if [REDACTED] was not let go, [REDACTED] would tell the subject of [REDACTED] narcotic information that the police were watching his house.
(Attachment #21)

The undersigned referenced Sergeant HIGGINS' Initiation report where he mentioned that [REDACTED] was taken out of the station to clarify narcotic information. Sergeant HIGGINS remembered that [REDACTED] was a willing participant for the identification of the location and did not display any discomfort or unease being near Officer TREACY in the back seat of the transport vehicle. Sergeant HIGGINS stated that he was not aware of any promises made to [REDACTED] in regards to [REDACTED] release for the narcotic information. Sergeant HIGGINS could not recall if [REDACTED] was under any influence of drugs or alcohol but only that [REDACTED] was upset that [REDACTED] was not being released without charging.
(Attachment #21)

Sergeant HIGGINS stated that [REDACTED] demonstrated how [REDACTED] was allegedly touched by Officer TREACY. Sergeant HIGGINS stated that ISON ran her hands across [REDACTED] clothed chest.
(Attachment #21)

Sergeant HIGGINS recalled that Officer COLLINS was the first and only Officer who brought [REDACTED] allegation to his attention.
(Attachment #21)

Sergeant HIGGINS recalled that [REDACTED] was the only subject arrested in the prostitution mission conducted on 23 August 2012. Sergeant HIGGINS stated that he did not ask Officer TREACY if he touched [REDACTED] nor did Officer TREACY mention that during the mission he touched ISON.
(Attachment #21)

The undersigned requested statements from each respective person named as witnesses in Sergeant HIGGINS' Initiation report and Officers listed on reports related to RD#HV443894. Sergeant CASCONA, Officer RAKE, Officer COLLINS, Officer CORTES, and Officer ESCOBEDO were asked to answer pertinent questions of any details they would recall regarding the alleged misconduct. The Officers were also sent reports recorded under RD#HV443894 and their Assignment and Attendance sheets (A&A's) for the date of the allegation made by [REDACTED] (Attachment #22, 23, 24, 25, and 26)

Sergeant CASCONA responded to the questions that he did not recollect this incident nor did he have any memory of the events that occurred in this incident. (Attachment #22)

Officer RAKE's responses to the undersigned's questions are summarized as follows. Officer RAKE recalled being assigned to beat 763B and partnered with Officer TREACY the day of the incident, on 23 August 2012. Officer RAKE further stated that [REDACTED] was arrested during a prostitution mission. Officer RAKE recalled that during the prostitution mission, [REDACTED] waived down Officer TREACY. Officer RAKE related that he engaged in a foot pursuit with [REDACTED], in which [REDACTED] was subsequently placed into custody. Officer RAKE acknowledged that he, Sergeant HIGGINS, Officer TREACY, and [REDACTED] did travel together in order to identify a house associated with narcotic information rendered by [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] was a willing participant to said travel. Officer RAKE stated that [REDACTED] did not relate any allegations to him about alleged inappropriate touching of [REDACTED] breast, vagina, or any misconduct allegedly down by Officer TREACY. Officer RAKE further added that he did not witness any alleged touching of [REDACTED] breast or vagina by Officer TREACY. Officer RAKE stated that he did not recall if Officer TREACY told him that he touched [REDACTED]. Officer RAKE had no further information in regards to this incident or its allegations. (Attachment #23)

Officer COLLINS' responses to the undersigned's questions are summarized as follows. Officer COLLINS recalled that he was assigned as a transport officer on beat 773R along with Officer Jose CORTEZ Star 18443 on the incident date of 23 August 2012. Officer COLLINS stated the assignment was to transport [REDACTED] to the area for further processing. Officer COLLINS stated the only contact he had with [REDACTED] was at the lockup processing door inside the 7th District on the day of the incident. Officer COLLINS recalled that [REDACTED] was alone while in police custody. Officer COLLINS described [REDACTED] demeanor as not happy about the situation. Officer COLLINS stated that he asked [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] was sick or injured and she replied "yes, the white guy, raped me." Officer COLLINS recalled that he told Sergeant HIGGINS of the alleged incident. Officer COLLINS stated that to the best of his knowledge, [REDACTED] told him of the allegation, in the presence of Officer CORTEZ. Officer COLLINS stated that [REDACTED] did not give him the name of the officer who allegedly "touched her." Officer COLLINS related that he had no further contact or conversation with [REDACTED]. Officer COLLINS stated that he had no conversation with Officer TREACY about this incident. (Attachment #24)

Officer CORTES' responses to the undersigned's questions are summarized as follows. Officer CORTES responded in that he did not recall any incident or event that occurred in conjunction with allegation recorded under RD#HV443894. (Attachment #25)

Officer Frances ESCOBEDO Star 19445 responses to the undersigned's questions are summarized as follows. Officer ESCOBEDO was the female officer that searched [REDACTED] on the incident date of 23 August 2012. Officer ESCOBEDO recalled conducting a female search for Officer TREACY but does not recall the name of the [REDACTED] offender. Officer ESCOBEDO stated that [REDACTED] did not recall any allegations made against Officer TREACY by the [REDACTED] offender nor was [REDACTED] present when the female offender stated alleged allegations. Officer ESCOBEDO stated that [REDACTED] left the processing room where the [REDACTED] was held once [REDACTED] finished the search. Officer ESCOBEDO had no further information regarding the incident or its alleged allegations. (Attachment #26)

The undersigned queried Officer TREACY's A&A's. The undersigned found that Officer TREACY was marked code 84, which means that he was placed on the medical roll for an injury on duty (IOD). (Attachment #27)

On 02 January 2015, the undersigned called Officer TREACY to schedule a statement. The undersigned referenced the Department's CLEAR Watch Information for Officer TREACY's telephone number. The CLEAR Watch Information listed a home telephone number of [REDACTED]. No person answered the call, an automated voice recording stated that the person was not accepting calls at this time and to try again later, and then the call was disconnected without allowing the undersigned to leave a voice message. (Attachment #28)

On 02 January 2015, the undersigned called the Department's Medical Section to inquire about Officer TREACY's medical roll status. The undersigned spoke with Sergeant RISLEY of the Medical Section, who stated that Officer TREACY's next evaluation with the Medical Section would be done by telephone. Reason being that the telephone call will serve as a follow-up from a surgery that Officer TREACY will be undergoing in February 2015. The undersigned asked Sergeant RISLEY to verify Officer TREACY's contact telephone number. Sergeant RISLEY related that the telephone number on file for Officer TREACY was [REDACTED]. (Attachment #29)

On 02 January 2015, the undersigned dialed [REDACTED] in order to contact Officer TREACY to schedule the statement. Officer TREACY answered the telephone call. The undersigned explained to Officer TREACY that he was an accused to CL1056545 and that a formal statement from him was required. Officer TREACY informed the undersigned that he has a scheduled surgery in February and that any time prior to that would be fine. An agreement for 09 January 2015 at 1100 hours at the Public Safety Headquarters was set for the statement. The undersigned advised Officer TREACY to acknowledge the allegations to CL1056545 in the Department CLEAR System. (Attachment #30)

On 02 January 2015, the undersigned electronically notified Officer TREACY of his administrative allegations and proceeding rights. (Attachment #31)

On 09 January 2015, Officer TREACY contacted the undersigned to reschedule the formal statement. Officer TREACY and the undersigned agreed to re-schedule the statement date to 14 January 2015 at 1100 hours at the Public Safety Headquarters. The undersigned advised Officer TREACY to acknowledge the allegations to CL1056545 in the Department CLEAR System. (Attachment #32)

On 12 January 2015, the undersigned called Officer TREACY to reschedule the statement. The statement was re-scheduled to 1300 hours on 14 January 2015 at the Public Safety Headquarters. The undersigned again advised Officer TREACY to acknowledge the allegations to CL1056545 in the Department CLEAR System. (Attachment #32)

On 14 January 2015, the undersigned along with Sergeant Michael BARZ Star 2625 conducted the formal interview with Officer TREACY. Officer TREACY secured counsel with Will FAHY, who was present at the statement. (Attachment #33)

In the statement, Officer TREACY was shown a copy of the Original Case Incident Report to HV443894, the Arrest History report recorded under HV443894, and the A&A report of Officer TREACY for 23 August 2012. The following is a summary of the Officer TREACY's statement. (Attachment #33)

In the statement Officer TREACY recalled the following of the alleged incident date of 23 August 2012. Officer TREACY related that he was assigned to the tactical team working 763B on a prostitution mission on south Halsted Avenue along with Officer RAKE #7524. The undersigned asked Officer TREACY to recall his interaction with [REDACTED] on 23 August 2012. Officer TREACY stated he was alone in the Chicago Police Department covert vehicle when [REDACTED] flagged him down. Officer TREACY then curbed the vehicle and [REDACTED] approached his vehicle and the two engaged in a brief conversation. [REDACTED] then entered the vehicle and they continued to talk. Officer TREACY stated that [REDACTED] offered intercourse and oral sex for an hour for one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Officer TREACY related that he then accepted [REDACTED] offer and signaled to the enforcement officer that a deal for sex was made. The enforcement officer curbed the undercover vehicle and [REDACTED] exited and fled on foot. Officer TREACY stated that RAKE gave chase and placed [REDACTED] into custody at 7104 South Emerald. (Attachment #33)

The undersigned asked Officer TREACY if [REDACTED] asked him to touch [REDACTED] to which Officer TREACY denied having any physical contact of any kind with [REDACTED] on 23 August 2012. (Attachment #33)

The undersigned referenced an Initiation report from Sergeant HIGGINS in that the report stated that [REDACTED] traveled in a Department vehicle with Sergeant HIGGINS, Officer RAKE, and Officer TREACY relative to narcotic information provided by [REDACTED]. Officer TREACY stated that Sergeant HIGGINS signed [REDACTED] out and proceeded to the block where she identified the house where ISON said T Bone lived. Then they all

returned to the station, they allowed [REDACTED] to smoke a cigarette, and [REDACTED] was returned to [REDACTED] cell. The undersigned asked Officer TREACY if [REDACTED] ever said or displayed some discomfort with being near him in vehicle when they traveled to confirm the narcotic information. Officer TREACY stated not at all, that [REDACTED] was a willing participant in confirming the narcotic information. (Attachment #33)

Officer TREACY recalled that there were no promises made to [REDACTED] about [REDACTED] release if [REDACTED] gave information on illegal activity. Officer TREACY could not recall [REDACTED] was under the influence of any drug or alcohol. Officer TREACY did not recall [REDACTED] told any other Department member about her allegation. (Attachment #33)

Officer TREACY stated that he saw [REDACTED] when he went to court for [REDACTED] arrest. The undersigned asked Officer TREACY if [REDACTED] mentioned [REDACTED] allegations in court. Officer TREACY stated that he was never informed if [REDACTED] stated anything. (Attachment #33)

A copy of the Cook County Court Disposition report indicated [REDACTED] eventually plead guilty to felony prostitution on 20 September 2012. On 21 November 2012, [REDACTED] violated [REDACTED] probation from her charges and was consequently sentenced to the Dwight Correctional Center. (Attachment #34)

Based on the evidence compiled during the course of this investigation, the undersigned has determined at this time that the allegations are not factual, in that [REDACTED] alleged that Officer TREACY touched [REDACTED] bare left breast and vagina. [REDACTED] had discrepancies in that [REDACTED] described the allegation as "touch" and "rape." [REDACTED] made the allegations at the time when transport Officer COLLINS arrived to take [REDACTED] to a female holding area for further processing. Prior to Officer COLLINS' transport assignment, [REDACTED] was a willingly participant in divulging narcotic information. It was stated by Witnesses Sergeant HIGGINS and Officer RAKE that [REDACTED] held a comfortable and willing demeanor when [REDACTED] rode in a vehicle to confirm narcotic information provided by [REDACTED] with acc [REDACTED] Officer TREACY. The Witnesses stated that [REDACTED] made no mention of the alleged touching. [REDACTED] also did not mention the allegations to the female Officer who searched [REDACTED] prior to transport Officer COLLINS' arrival. [REDACTED] made the allegations as [REDACTED] was set to leave the district of arrest to a female holding facility where she would be held before [REDACTED] was presented to a judge for her felony arrest.

In addition, during [REDACTED] interview about her allegations, [REDACTED] main concern to Sergeant HIGGINS was that [REDACTED] should be let go for [REDACTED] narcotic information and not that [REDACTED] was truly victimized by Officer TREACY. [REDACTED] did not provide specific details about the allegation as requested. [REDACTED] told Sergeant HIGGINS [REDACTED] was "innocent," which was false because [REDACTED] pled guilty to this arrest.

It is also important to note, at no time during [REDACTED] court proceedings did [REDACTED] relate to her Attorney, the presiding JUDGE, or the Cook County State's Attorney Office that Officer TREACY did anything inappropriate to [REDACTED] during [REDACTED] arrest. Certainly if these allegations were true [REDACTED] would have informed someone involved in her court case of these serious allegations prior to pleading guilty. The Bureau of Internal Affairs was

never confronted by the Cook County State's Attorney Office about any allegations made by [REDACTED]

Furthermore, [REDACTED] initially plead not guilty in court but then plead guilty after the discovery. [REDACTED]'s actions show that [REDACTED] made attempts to evade felony prostitution charges by fleeing the arrest, the allegations she made against Officer TREACY just as [REDACTED] was set for transport for further processing and booking, and [REDACTED] initial plea of not guilty.

Lastly, [REDACTED] was unable to identify Officer TREACY in a photoarray as the male white dressed in civilian clothes who touched [REDACTED] left breast and vagina.

This investigation is closed as unfounded. The investigation uncovered discrepancies such as different terms used to describe the allegations, the lack of cooperation in [REDACTED] initial complaint to Sergeant HIGGINS, [REDACTED] comfortable and willing demeanor when she divulged narcotic information to the accused, [REDACTED] concern for release or the application for a lesser charge rather than the alleged inappropriate behavior, and failure to identify the accused during a photoarray.

Allegation #2: "UNFOUNDED" – The investigation revealed that there is no factual basis to support the allegation that accused Officer Brian TREACY Star 5181 touched [REDACTED] vagina.
